personnel and found to be uninjured. NO TEARS underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed lameness in the left hind leg, with a veterinary clearance now required prior to racing again.

N Downs (CHANCELLOR) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount CHANCELLOR to shift inwards when not fully clear of AULD JOCK approaching the 800 metres.

M Roustoby (HOME RULE) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount HOME RULE to shift inwards after jumping the first fence crowding CHANCELLOR.

Race 3 NORWOOD HAWERA "JIM WALKER" HURDLES 2800m

AL'S RED ZED (H McNeill) - Was inclined to race ungenerously in the early to middle stages.

VERRY FLASH (D Parker) - Lost the left front plate during the running.

Race 4

PCL WINEERA BROS "MAURICE CAMPBELL" STEEPLE CHASE 3400m

RENEGADE FIGHTER (N Downs) - Misjudged the second fence in the home straight on the first occasion.

INTERLLECTUS (D Parker) - Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 900 metres on the final occasion.

KHAFEEF (M Roustoby) - Retired from the race prior to the last two fences when well beaten. Rider was of the opinion something was amiss with the gelding. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have suffered cardiac arrhythmia. Trainer K Myers was advised that KHAFEEF will not be permitted to start in any race or trial until a veterinary certificate declaring the gelding free of any cardiac arrhythmia following a gallop of at least 1000 metres.

CALL ME JACK (S Karnicnik) - Badly misjudged the final fence almost dislodging its rider.

Trainer **H Wilson** (PASSWORD) – Attributed the improved performance of PASSWORD to the addition of a tongue tie after disappointing at its last start.

Race 5 FLAIR "DARRYL BRADLEY" AMATEUR MAIDEN 2100m

The start of this race was delayed approximately 5 minutes due to one of the barrier staff requiring medical attention.

SALVIN (N Smith) - Began awkwardly crowding REBAL AGENT, PLEASE SIR and JOLLY MOLLY.

REBAL AGENT (A Riddell) - Crowded leaving the barriers. Held up having to steady to avoid the heels of the weakening UHTRED near the 600 metres. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised her chances had not been helped when hampered near the 600 metres but would appreciate more rain affected conditions.

PLEASE SIR (C McKee) - Crowded leaving the barriers.

JOLLY MOLLY (A McIntyre) - Crowded leaving the barriers.

UHTRED (S Paswan) - Jumped away awkwardly hampering YUNGBLUD. Raced wide without cover. Came under pressure passing the 800 metres and commenced to give ground shortly after, not being persevered with in the final straight.

YUNGBLUD (A Scott) - Hampered on jumping.

WHOSAID (S MacNab) - Slow away.

Race 6 DERRYN @ GRANGEWILLIAM STUD "HAYDEN TINSLEY" 2100m

DANJURO (J Riddell) - Slow away then restrained to obtain cover.

IMPERIAL PARTY (J Doyle) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact with ASTERIAL.

ASTERIAL (L Sutherland) - Contacted leaving the barriers getting further back than the rider intended. L Sutherland advised in her opinion the mare would prefer more rain affected going.

CIVIL UNREST (M Sanson) - Slow away.

THE BAMBINO (C Barnes) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

The track was upgraded to Good 4 effective Race 6.

Race 7 HILAL @ GRANGEWILLIAM STUD "LISA ALLPRESS" 1400m

I DON'T (T Davies) - Crowded leaving the barriers getting back. Briefly held up near the 600 metres and had to be angled very wide to improve in the home straight.

OH NO NO NO (K Hercock) - Slow away. Over raced in the middle stages. Was inclined to hang out under pressure in the home straight.

MR FABULOUS (M Sanson) - Jumped away awkwardly.

JACKAROO (L Sutherland) - Jumped away awkwardly.

FREIHEITEN PFEIL (K Kalychurun) - Hung outwards in the home straight and when being corrected shifted inwards into the line of JACKAROO. K Kalychurun was advised to exercise greater care.

Race 8 TRANS AG CENTRE "KELLY & ROSIE MYERS" MAIDEN 1400m

NEVER NEVER (J Chung) - Slow away. Raced wide throughout.

SIR BRUCE (C Grylls) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact with COME TO TERMS.

COME TO TERMS (E Sole) - Contacted leaving the barriers.

MOSSRAAJ (L Sutherland) - Raced three wide without cover.

CLUTHA (J Doyle) - Fractious in the barrier after being loaded away. Raced ungenerously in the middle stages and shifted outwards abruptly making contact with BONNIE ISLAY passing the 1000 metres. Ducked outwards hampering NEVER NEVER near the 650 metres. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in its mouth. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed a mouth laceration consistent with the gelding having hit its head on the front of the gates.

Race 9 NU FARM/FARMLANDS "TERRY & DIANNE MOSELEY" 1600m

THE FIRST LINK (L Douglas) - Jumped away awkwardly then further hampered when crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied losing ground.

PINKERTON (L Allpress) - Jumped away awkwardly from the outside barrier then being restrained to obtain cover.

STOLEN SPIRIT (T Davies) - Over raced outside the leader through the middle stages.

HASSTOBEAWINNER (J Doyle) - When questioned regarding performance, the rider advised that after being taken on early was generally disappointing and had no other excuse. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 10 THE BOLD ONE @ GRANGEWILLIAM GREG CHILDS MAIDEN 1200m

BRUNO (J Riddell) - Slow away.

TROUVAILLE (C Grylls) - Shifted inwards under pressure near the 100 metres making contact with OUR SASSY ANNE which in turn then bumped EL JAYCEE.

EL JAYCEE (L Sutherland) - Contacted near the 100 metres.

OUR SASSY ANNE (L Allpress) - Contacted near the 100 metres.
