RACE COMMENTS**Race 1****CAMBRIDGE EQUINE HOSPITAL MAIDEN 1550**

FEAMABEEL (C Barnes) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Made the bend awkwardly when racing keenly near the 1400 metres shifting outwards hampering **BEAU ONDAGO**.

TRUST ALONE (C Grylls) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Held up throughout the final straight.

SHIMMERING (J Allen)- Knuckled at the start. Raced three wide without cover for a majority of the race.

BEAU ONDAGO (T Mitchell) – Hampered passing the 1400 metres.

PATCH (A Lawson-Carroll) - Over-raced through the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had over-raced through the early and middle stages when racing outside the leader which was detrimental to its chances.

MISTER MEANER (W Kennedy) – Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Held up until near the 300 metres. Raced in restricted room for a distance approaching the 100 metres.

SHATIN (L Satherley) - Raced three wide without cover from near the 1000 metres.

LUCKY BAY (W Pinn) - Shifted outwards making firm contact with **ALADDIN SANE** passing the 50 metres having to be straightened by its rider.

ALADDIN SANE (V Colgan) - Contacted and forced wider passing the 50 metres.

W Pinn (**LUCKY BAY**) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards when not fully clear of **ALADDIN SANE** which was firmly contacted passing the 50 metres.

Race 2**WAIKATO TRACTORS MAIDEN 3YO 1300**

RIDE THE WAVE (M McNab) – Began awkwardly.

JON WARRIOR (L Satherley) - Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.

SUNRAIN SAILING (W Kennedy) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

EMMY DAZZLER (S Spratt) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

BOUND TO BE (K Asano) - Held up entering the final straight.

TOMOE GOZEN (J Doyle) - Lay outwards rounding the final bend.

ELECTRIC ZOU (J Fawcett) – Lay out rounding the final bend and throughout the straight with the rider having to straighten the gelding on a number of occasions.

Race 3 | **SADDLERY WAREHOUSE MAIDEN 1300**

RESERVED (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

TEMPSFORD (M McNab) - Slow to begin then crowded shortly after. Lay outwards rounding the final bend inconveniencing HE'S SO FINE.

CLAIMED GIFT (L Satherley) – Crowded shortly after the start. Held up entering the final straight.

HE'S SO FINE (K Asano) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Inconvenienced near the 250 metres.

VITALITY (T Mitchell) - When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormality. Trainer D Wiles advised that the gelding would now be retired.

Race 4 | **WAIPA EARTHWORKS 1300**

MR UNIVERSE (M McNab) - Slow to begin.

STONYBRECK (T Melvin) - Slow to begin.

SIDE EYE (J Allen) - Briefly steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of WINNING FOR ALL near the 1100 metres. Lay outwards rounding the final bend inconveniencing BRANCIFORTI. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had made abnormal breathing noises during the race. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormality.

UP 'N' GONE (C Grylls) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

BRANCIFORTI (L Satherley) – Inconvenienced near the 250 metres.

Race 5 | **PRYDE'S EASIFEED MAIDEN 2YO 970**

FUN NEVER SETS (K Asano) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

SURE TO PLEASE (B Rogerson) – Began awkwardly then hampered shortly after losing ground. When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormality.

DALUMA DRAGON GIRL (C Grylls) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

ELEGANT JAZZ (J Fawcett) - Lay outwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

<p>GASGAL (T Mitchell) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>POKURU SHOW (K Asano) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p>MISS BEE (B Rogerson) - Contacted shortly after the start becoming unbalanced.</p> <p>MR FORTRUS (C Barnes) - Shifted inwards shortly after the start making contact with the hindquarters of MISS BEE. Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>FULL TILT (C Grylls) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p>

<p>MIGHTY BRIGHT (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin then crowded shortly after losing ground.</p> <p>ULTIMATE FOCUS (M McNab) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>FELIX FAURE (A Lawson-Carroll) - Held up throughout the final straight.</p>	
Race 8	OAKVUE LODGE/SERENITY PARK 2000
<p>TIZ LOUIE (C Grylls) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.</p> <p>YOULEDO (S Spratt) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground</p> <p>EMBER ATTACK (L Satherley) – Contacted shortly after the start becoming unbalanced. Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>WAIHI WARRIOR (T Mitchell) - Inconvenienced when placed in restricted room to the outside of HOARD THE BOURBON which had shifted out slightly near the 250 metres.</p> <p>CIAMBELLA (W Pinn) – Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of HAYATE and outside of SAYAN which both shifted ground passing the 200 metres dropping back onto BIEDERMEIER which had to be steadied. O Bosson was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.</p> <p>BIEDERMEIER (J Doyle) - Improved onto heels near the 200 metres having to be steadied.</p> <p>HAYATE (O Bosson) - Lay inwards under pressure placing CIAMBELLA in restricted room passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>SAYAN (A Lawson-Carroll) – Lay outwards rounding the final bend and continued to do so throughout the final straight. Lost the right hind plate during the running.</p> <p>A Lawson-Carroll (SAYAN) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards when insufficiently clear of CIAMBELLA which had to be steadied near the 200 metres.</p>
