**RACE COMMENTS** 

Race 1 **JACKSON STREET BAR 1000m** 

MEDIA MISS (K Hercock) - Slow away.

THE STONEY ONE (L Sutherland) - Came together and bumped with BELLE'S ECHO shortly after the start.

BELLE'S ECHO (L Hemi) - Came together and bumped with THE STONEY ONE shortly after the start.

**VALLEY PLUMBING 2YO 1000m** Race 2

**TARVOS** (L Sutherland) - Very slow away.

VANISH (J Chung) - Raced greenly around the final bend.

**CHARLIE GRANT MEMORIAL MAIDEN 1000m** Race 3

P Lock (DOGES OF VENICE) - Issued with a warning for presenting his runner without notified gear (side winkers).

**RABEGA** (J Chung) - Raced greenly throughout.

**FUN TEST** (L Hemi) - Raced greenly early in the home straight.

**ROZEL** (K Williams) - Lay inwards having to be straightened near the 700 metres.

**SNIPERS ALLEY** (L Allpress) - Finished well back. Trainer advised the mare would be freshened.

### Race 4 PUKEMANU BAR & EATERY 1600m

**FOURTY EIGHT** (L Sutherland) - Raced wide in the early stages.

**TIVACI PRINCESS** (L Allpress) - Finished towards the rear. When questioned L Allpress advised the mare was disappointing. Trainer advised TIVACI PRINCESS would undergo a veterinary examination, including bloods and report any anomalies to Stewards.

#### Race 5 TAB SATURDAY RACING BONUS BACK 2050m

**BILLY EASTON** (S O'Malley) - Restrained to the rear from its wide draw.

**HUNGRY** (L Hemi) - Restrained to the rear from its wide draw.

IVA MISSION (M Singh) - Over-raced, having to be steadied near the 1800 metres.

**PARISIAN POPPY** (J Chung) - Raced wide in the early stages so was taken forward on a slow pace near the 1200 metres to sit outside the leader and was then steadied which resulted in PERFECT TURN, which was over-racing having to ease and went back on to SAILOR JACK and COMEDY, which were both steadied. J Chung was shown footage of his ride in the presence of the Apprentice Mentor and reminded of his obligation when shifting ground. Stewards took into account the tendency of PERFECT TURN to over-race when assessing the interference.

**PERFECT TURN** (K Williams) - Over-raced having to ease near the 1200 metres.

SAILOR JACK (K Hercock) - Steadied 1200 metres.

COMEDY (J Riddell) - Steadied 1200 metres.

## Race 6 COTTER & STEVENS MAIDEN 2050m

**POROTENE STORM** (M Singh) - Slow away. Over-raced passing the 1800 metres, then raced wide from near the 1400 metres. Bumped with POROTENE STORM near the 350 metres.

NO BIZZ (K Hercock) - Over-raced passing the 1800 metres.

**BUBBAJOCK** (R Bishop) - Over-raced through the middle stages.

**IFFIDAPUNT** (K Williams) - Over-raced having to be steadied near the 1300 metres.

**PARADIS** (L Hemi) - Commenced to give ground near the 800 metres. When questioned rider L Hemi advised Stewards that the mare, which was racing in restricted room, was left flat-footed when the pace increased, but finished the race off well.

FERN FLATS (M Hudson) - Raced wide from the 600 metres.

**NOTHING UNUSUAL** (L Sutherland) - Bumped with POROTENE STORM near the 350 metres, resulting in NOTHING UNUSUAL becoming momentarily unbalanced.

**GROOMSMAN** (J Chung) - Finished towards the rear. A post-race veterinary examination was carried out with the gelding showing signs of soreness. Connections undertook to carry out x-rays with the results being forwarded to Stewards, with this also being followed up in the coming days.

#### Race 7 ROSIES FURNITURE REMOVALS 1300m

**BUENOS DIAS** (L Allpress) - Dislodged rider during the preliminary. L Allpress was uninjured. BUENOS DIAS underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared to run. When questioned L Allpress was of the opinion the gelding may have been feeling the firm track. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

ISLAND HOP (M Hudson) - Slow away.

**GURTLYN** (K Hercock) - Began awkwardly bumping SEVENAYES.

SEVENAYES (J Chung) - Bumped at the start.

**HAVARTI** (J Riddell) - Lay inwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

SHEEZ DOMINANT (M Singh) - Lay inwards near the 200 metres, making contact with the rail.

## Race 8 KURIPUNI SPORTS BAR & TAB MAIDEN 1300m

RUN FLASH RUN (M Hudson) - Began awkwardly bumping SAY I DO.

**SAY I DO** (K Williams) - Bumped at start, losing ground...

WAL (J Riddell) - Slow away. Lay inwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

MARTINA DIVA (M Singh) - Restrained to the rear from its wide draw.

**TAVITA MISS** (J Chung) – Over-raced shortly after the start having to be steadied. Raced wide in the middle stages.

**BUCKS NIGHT** (K Hercock) – Raced greenly near the 1000 metres, over-raced and taken forward to sit outside leader from 800 metres.

**CHERISHED LADY** (T Davies) – lay outwards rounding the final bend.
