## RACE COMMENTS

## Race 1 DOO YOU WANT ME SYNDICATE MAIDEN 2100m

UNCLE CHARLIE (N Downs) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

TIMBA (K Wiles) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start. Hampered near the 1100 metres when UNCLE CHARLIE shifted out to improve forward.

HOME RULE (D Parker) - Made the first bend awkwardly before improving to lead.

REBAL AGENT (S O'Malley) - Held up rounding the final bend having to be restrained off heels of a tiring runner passing the 425 metres and continued to be held up early in the run home until passing the 300 metres.

WHOSAID (H McNeill) - Held up rounding the final bend.

CATCH AND RELEASE (K Macnab) - Shifted inwards under pressure in the run home.

N Downs (UNCLE CHARLIE) - Issued with a warning after allowing his mount to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of TIMBA, which was hampered passing the 1100 metres.

K Myers (WHOSAID) - Issued with a warning for presenting WHOSAID without the notified blinkers.

## Race 2 ROLY \& PHILLIPA ELLIS 2200m

DONARDO (H McNeill) - Slow to begin.

INVISIBLE SPIRIT (D Parker) - Began awkwardly, shifting outwards at the start. Held up rounding the final bend, gaining clear racing passing the 275 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no tangible excuse other than that his mount had been disappointing.

LORD SPENCER (S O’Malley) - Crowded at the start losing ground when inside runners shifted outwards.

KAJINO (N Downs) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

HURRY CANE (A Roustoby) - Raced four-wide from the 800 metres.

BERRY THE CASH (P Matthews) - Held up in the final straight until passing the 200 metres.

ALL IN BLACKBERRY (K Macnab) - Held up rounding the final bend gaining clear racing room inside the final 300 metres.

P Mathews (BERRY THE CASH) - Fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule when unable to claim down to her riding weight.

## Race 3

ROHAN MUDHOO TRUST MAIDEN 1200m

VELTON (K Hercock) - Shifted inwards abruptly at the start, making heavy contact with FELUCCA. Crowded shortly after the start, losing further ground.

FELUCCA (T Davies) - Contacted at the start and shortly afterwards was crowded losing ground.

KAPALUA (C Grylls) - Shifted outwards at the start crowding outside runners.

SAILOR GIRL (K Asano) - Lay outwards on the final bend. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a wound to the right hind coronet with mild lameness in the left foreleg. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance is required prior to SAILOR GIRL racing next.

ENDUED (M McNab) - Rider dropped his whip passing the 150 metres.

## Race 4 MARIE LEATHEM NEE DIAMOND MEMORIAL MAIDEN 1200m

There was a delay to the start of this event due to ONE SPLIT SECOND proving very difficult to load. Connections were advised the filly is on a barrier manners warning.

WHOOSHKA (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow to begin then got its head up when being restrained in the early stages to gain cover from a wide draw. Improved into a marginal run to the outside of ONLYWORDS TO TRADE passing the 400 metres and was forced outwards on to LADY DERRYN and LINCOLN TOWERS, which were both hampered and forced wider on the turn near the 350 metres. A Lawson-Carroll was shown a replay of the incident in the presence of the Apprentice Mentor and advised he should not anticipate runs until they have fully developed.

LADY DERRYN (L Hemi) - Hampered and forced wider on the turn near the 350 metres.

LINCOLN TOWERS (J Riddell) - Slow to begin. Hampered and forced wider on the turn near the 350 metres.

LINARA (J Mudhoo) - Raced three-wide without cover for the majority of the event.

ALMALANE (T Davies) - Briefly steadied near the 900 metres to avoid the heels of LADY DERRYN (L Hemi). L Hemi was advised to exercise greater care.

## Race 5 HAPPY BIRTHDAY LEMON MAIDEN 1400m

BUTTON YA LIP (L Hemi) - Very slow to begin. Lay outwards under pressure throughout the run home and had to be straightened pass the 150 metres.

LET'S GET LOOSE (C Lindsay) - Raced three-wide without cover.

PERFECT POSY (T Allan) - Slow to begin. Lost the off-side front plate during the running.

SLICE O' PARADISE (T Davies) - Began awkwardly shifting out crowding ARANUI LASS.

ARANUI LASS (K Myers) - Crowded at the start.

THE BICESTER (J Riddell) - Raced in restricted room shortly after the start when inside runners shifted out.

THE PROPHET (M McNab) - Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

SUMOSAURUS (K Hercock) - Held up rounding the final turn and had some difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 200 metres.

DOCTOR ASKAR (C Grylls) - Held up rounding the final bend and had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the run home.

HEADLINE NEWS (K Asano) - Became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 75 metres, having to be steadied, losing momentum.

## Race 6 DAVID \& ELLEN OLIVER 1400m

REIGN IT IN (J Chung) - Began awkwardly, losing ground.

MANOLO (C Lindsay) - Bounded at the start, losing ground.

HACKSAW RIDGE (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.

MEGLIO DI FALCREST (K Myers) - Over-raced when three-wide without cover throughout.

DUNCAN CREEK (J Allen) - Shifted outwards under pressure over the concluding stages, having to be straightened by the rider.

BOW HILL (C Grylls) - Finished well back. When questioned rider had no excuse.

J Allen (DUNCAN CREEK) - Issued with a warning when striking her mount on one occasion in the run home with her arm above shoulder height and also advised to straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion.

S Gordon (DUNEAGLE) - Fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule when declaring the rider for DUNEAGLE on the morning of the races.

## Race 7

## MACDOUGALLS MAIDEN 1600 m

SHOCKIFF (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.

FINAL CHAPTER (C Dell) - Slow to begin. Shifted inwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

DEADORNODEAL (L Hemi) - Shifted outwards at the start making contact with SUBTLE IMAGE with both runners losing some ground.

SUBTLE IMAGE (C Barnes) - Contacted at the start, losing some ground. Held up early in the run home and had to be shifted outwards across heels passing the 175 metres to find clear running.

HASSTOBEREEL (K Asano) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

OUR ALI (M Singh) - Raced in restricted room passing the 900 metres. Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages when HELLO CUPID was taken inwards by FINAL CHAPTER (C Dell) which shifted ground inwards under pressure. C Dell was shown a replay and advised to exercise greater care and straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.

LURCH (J Allen) - Held up rounding the final bend.

LOVE TANIA (A Lawson-Carroll) - Held up in the middle stages of the run home.

MANZAPPEAL (C Grylls) - Finished well back. Rider could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance.

L Kauri (RIDE THE TIDE) - Issued with a warning when striking his mount on one occasion in the run home with his arm above shoulder height.

## Race 8 OULAGHAN RACING 2100m

DIVINE SPIRIT (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.

LE GRAZIE (A Lawson-Carroll) - Began awkwardly losing ground and was further hampered when RUFFHOUSE ROSIE shifted outwards at the start. Finished some distance last. Attended to by the on-course veterinarian immediately after the race and found to have injured a front suspensory ligament. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance is required prior to LE GRAZIE racing again.

SIR MIKKI (J Riddell) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover.

RUFFHOUSEROSIE (T Davies) - Began awkwardly shifting outwards, crowding outside runners.

TAKE ON (S O'Malley) - Raced three-wide without cover for the majority of the event and keenly through the middle stages.

SMART ATTIRE (A Mudhoo) - Improved wide from the 800 metres.
