# SUPPLEMENTARY

Waikato Thoroughbred Racing at Te Rapa – Saturday, 27 April 2024

Race 6 - HUTTON CONTRACTING 1400

**W Pinn** (KARMAN LINE) - Issued with a warning after striking his mount in two consecutive strides just prior to the winning post.

#### **RACE COMMENTS**

Race 1 RUAKAKA – NZ'S BEST BET IN WINTER MAIDEN 2100

**LI LI** (W Kennedy) - Slow to begin. Lay outwards rounding the final bend and continued to do so when placed under pressure in the final straight.

**PURE DELIGHT** (L Satherley) - Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained. Lay out when making the bend near the 1400 metres running wide. Held up until near the 250 metres.

VERDI'S OPERA (B Jacobson) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay out rounding the final bend.

### Race 2 TRUWELD ENGINEERING MAIDEN 1400

MONTE CIVETTA (A Lawson-Carroll) – Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover from a wide barrier.

**FLAMBOYANCE** (L Satherley) – Lay outwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

#### Race 3 THE HOMESTEAD SPORTS BAR & BISTRO MAIDEN 1200

**INCANTO GOLD** (S Spratt) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight. Lay outwards over the concluding stages making brief contact with SONNET.

LA PARISIENNE (A Lawson-Carroll) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Held up entering the final straight.

**BEALEY VALLEY** (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin. Made the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres. When questioned regarding performance the rider reported that the filly was outpaced over 1200 metres and would benefit from a step up in distance.

**WHISKEY LULLABY** (N Hailey) – Ran off rounding the first bend. Connections were advised that the gelding would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

**EIGHT LUCKY PRAWNS** (M McNab) - Improved onto the heels of SONNET having to be briefly steadied near the 400 metres.

**SONNET** (J Doyle) – Briefly contacted over the concluding stages.

A Lawson-Carroll (LA PARISIENNE) - Was spoken to advisedly regarding his whip use over the concluding stages.

### Race 4 ENTAIN/NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN 1200

**BOCOTE** (M McNab) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormality.

SURF QUEEN (C Grylls) - Slow to begin.

SWEET AND SASSY (B Jacobson) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Made the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres.

**BOUND TO BE** (K Asano) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Rider dropped his whip near the 200 metres.

SHOWME DA MOOLAH (S Spratt) - Made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly when racing keenly.

BEE ON TIME (T Moodley) - Lay outwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

PHARAOH'S DREAM (W Pinn) - Rider reported that the filly had hung outwards throughout the final straight.

**J Mahoney** (FERNANDEZ) – Issued with a warning for presenting FERNANDEZ to race without the notified side winkers.

Race 5 LION RED 2100

MISCHIEF MANAGED (J Fawcett) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Hampered near the 1400 metres.

**CIMARRON** (W Kennedy) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Hampered having to be steadied near the 1400 metres.

**HIWA** (K Asano) - Made contact with the running rail becoming briefly unbalanced shifting outwards hampering NO PLAN BE, MISCHIEF MANAGED, BRIAN LAMONT, CIMARRON and ALL SHOOK UP near the 1400 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormality. Co-trainer S Clotworthy advised that the mare would now be retired from racing.

NO PLAN BE (K Myers) - Hampered near the 1400 metres.

BRIAN LAMONT (B Jacobson) - Hampered near the 1400 metres.

ALL SHOOK UP (N Hailey) - Hampered near the 1400 metres.

**XRATED** (V Colgan) - Placed in restricted room when weakening to the inside of ALL SHOOK UP and outside of A MANDARIN approaching the 100 metres.

A MANDARIN (T Moodley) - Lay outwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

## Race 6 PORTHOUSE BAR & EATERY 1300

**LATRELLE** (M McNab) – Slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight before shifting outwards passing the 200 metres making contact with RISING TIDE for a short distance then improved onto heels over the concluding stages having to be steadied.

ANNA TAIT (L Satherley) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay outwards rounding the final bend.

SUPER TIME (J Doyle) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

**RISING TIDE** (V Colgan) – Contacted for a short distance passing the 200 metres.

**SHOCKATILLATAP** (K Myers) – Inconvenienced near the 150 metres when PIPPY shifted out. M Cameron was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

**REVERBERATIONS** (T Moodley) - When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormality.

## Race 7 8 JUNE BREAM BAY BUSINESS DAY 1400

NO AGENDA NIGEL (B Jacobson) - Slow to begin then crowded shortly after, losing ground.

PERSIFLAGE (M McNab) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Held up until near the 350 metres.

**SWERVE** (V Colgan) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding was disappointing but could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormality.

KIND THOUGHTS (M Cameron) - Slow to begin.

**GOLDEN HUE** (B Rogerson) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

AQUA MAN (A Lawson-Carroll) - Held up until near the 250 metres.

**SAYAN** (T Moodley) - Held up for the majority of the final straight. T Moodley was questioned in the presence of his employer D Walker regarding his ride in the early stages of the run home and in particular his decision to shift outside of CON ARTIST. T Moodley explained that he felt that CON ARTIST was not going to roll off the fence and that a run was starting to develop inside MIDNIGHT SCANDAL entering the final straight, however that run did not eventuate. SAYAN was then forward of the heels of CON ARTIST and was unable to shift back inwards resulting in the gelding being unable to improve for the remainder of the straight. Stewards noted T Moodley's explanation.

# Race 8 MID WESTERN LIONS GERALD MANNION MEMORIAL RACE MAIDEN 1600

HALLER (K Myers) - Slow to begin,

**VITA AMOROSA** (L Satherley) - Began awkwardly losing ground then raced ungenerously for a distance in the early stages.

**MISTER MEANER** (J Doyle) - Slow to begin. Over-raced in the middle stages. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding over-racing through the middle stages had been detrimental to its chances. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormality.

**HOT LINE BLING** (M McNab) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**AWHINA** (T Moodley) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Reacted poorly shifting inwards when placed in restricted room near the 50 metres.

**KISZKAH** (M Cameron) - Steadied near the 50 metres when placed in restricted room to the outside of ELECTRON which was laying outwards and inside of AWHINA which had shifted in and away slightly from HOT LINE BLING.

**ELECTRON** (B Grylls) - Lay outwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

**B Grylls** (ELECTRON) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift outwards when not fully clear of KISZKAH which had to be steadied near the 50 metres.
