LULO ROSE (K Williams) - Trainer Mr A Carston advised Stewards he was satisfied with the post-race condition of LULO ROSE, however has now been sent for a spell.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | **RURAL MERCHANTS PALMERSTON MAIDEN 1200m**

HAPPY STORY (J Kamaruddin) - After becoming fractious in its barrier, rearing and getting its leg stuck, was removed from its stall to undergo a veterinary inspection and cleared to race. As a result this race ran three minutes late.

HEY NOW (C Barnes) - Blundered and shifted out abruptly at the start crowding and contacting outside runners.

TOWER OF GOLD (D Tait) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

EL ULTIMO (J Fawcett) - Contacted and unbalanced at the start.

TUMUCH (R Beeharry) - Contacted and unbalanced at the start.

QUICK TAP (K Kwo) - Slow to begin.

SPOT ON TIME (K Williams) - Began awkwardly. Lost the near hind plate passing the 500 metres.

EMPRESS SUIKO (R Muniandy) - Raced wide into the first bend.

MACCEDES (Y Atchamah) - Raced very wide throughout.

PEEKAY (C Campbell) - Raced very wide throughout.

Race 2 | **PROPERTY BROKERS 1200m**

DIVINE REGULUS (L Callaway) - Fractious in its barrier and began awkwardly losing some ground.

PARAMOUNT PRINCE (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin.

O'JESSICA (R Mudhoo) - Contacted and briefly unbalanced near the 125 metres when racing in tight quarters to the inside of FIFITA which lay in briefly before being straightened by its rider. Lay outwards over the concluding stages.

FIFITA (T Comignaghi) - Lay inwards in the run home and briefly made contact with O'JESSICA near the 125 metres. Dictated wider on the track over the concluding stages.

SHE'S AN ACE (R Muniandy) - Became awkwardly placed on heels near the 125 metres having to be steadied and shift ground outwards.

Race 3 | **CARGILL CONTRACTING MAIDEN 1600m**

AUSPICIOUSOCCASION (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin.

THE WILD COLONIAL (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin.

IMABUSTER (C Barnes) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

CHERRYVILLE (T Comignaghi) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

EPILOGUE (N Hailey) - Improved onto the heels of the runner in front near the 1150 metres having to be steadied. Made the bend near the 400 metres awkwardly.

MABEL (C Campbell) - Held up early in the run home and had to shift ground outwards passing the 150 metres to find clear racing room.

Race 4 | **MEENANS, OTAGO TYRES & BARNYARD MAINFEED'S 1400m**

ADANNAYA (K Chowdhoo) - Very slow to begin (4L).

JEWEL OF PATCH (D Tait) - Got its head up when over racing passing the 1100 metres. Held up through the middle part of the run home having to shift ground outwards to find clear racing room.

Race 5 | **COOK HOWLISON HYUNDAI MAIDEN 1400m**

PATRAINE (C Campbell) - Proved difficult to load delaying the start. Connections were advised that PATRAINE was on a barrier manners warning.

RAY'S AWAKE (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

GENE WEEN (B Murray) - Slow to begin.

CHANNA (N Hailey) - Over raced for a distance passing the 1200 metres having to be steadied.

LUCIENNE (R Muniandy) - Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

YOSHIME (J Fawcett) - Had some trouble obtaining clear running for the majority of the run home, going to the line not fully tested by its rider.

MISS ENZED (L Callaway) - Lay inwards throughout the run home.

BORNHOLM (T Comignaghi) - Rider reported the gelding had held its breath during the running.

Race 6 | **BRENT LUCAS BUILDERS 1400m**

HE'S TUNZA GRUNT (S Toolooa) - Slow to begin.

THE MOTIVATOR (K Kwo) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

FINAL SAVINGS (N Hailey) - Over raced in the early stages.

DECEPTIO VISUS (T Comignaghi) - Over raced in the early stages and had to be steadied off heels near the 1050 metres when **AERIAL BLUE** (C Barnes) shifted in when not quite fully clear. C Barnes was advised to exercise greater care. Rider reported the gelding had held its breath during the running.

AERIAL BLUE (C Barnes) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Saddle displaced backwards in the run home, with the rider dismounting on pulling up for safety reasons.

JUST MAYBE (K Williams) - Crowded near the 1300 metres when **BOURBON CHIQUE** lay inwards.

ANGE DE REVE (K Chowdhoo) - Had some trouble obtaining clear running early in the run home. Placed in restricted room over the concluding stages when **LADY BANKSIDE** (B May) lay outwards. B May was advised to exercise greater care.

SACRED DREAM (B Murray) - Crowded and checked near the 50 metres.

C Campbell (**BOURBON CHIQUE**) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount **BOURBON CHIQUE** to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of **SACRED DREAM** which was crowded and checked passing the 50 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of C Campbell's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 20 January until the conclusion of racing on Saturday 27 January, 4 national riding days.

Following the running of this race B Murray was stood down from his engagement in Race 7 by Paramedics, suffering cramping and dehydration, to enable him to take food and water.

Race 7 | **WAE WAIKOUAITI CUP 2200m**

THE TUI TOILER - K Kwo replaced B Murray (dehydrated).

LEAVE IT TO ME (D Tait) - Slow to begin.

MR INTELLIGENCE (R Mudhoo) - Raced three wide without cover through the early stages.

CAPO DELL IMPERO (C Campbell) - Held up early in the run home.

QUICK STORY (J Fawcett) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home.

HUMBUCKER (K Williams) - When asked to comment on performance, the rider advised that the gelding had travelled well throughout but when placed under pressure in the final straight failed to respond and had been disappointing.

Following the running of this race the track was upgraded to Good 3.

Race 8	ODT SOUTHERN MILE QUALIFIER 1600m

CALL ME AL (B Murray) - Slow to begin.

THE GREY GOOSE (R Mudhoo) - Slow to begin. Held up in the middle stages of the run home.

IFFIDIDIT (L Callaway) - Slow to begin. Had to be steadied for a distance to avoid heels passing the 1200 metres. Placed in restricted room near the 300 metres when ARCTIC GLOW lay inwards, then held up for clear running until inside the final 100 metres.

WILLIS (K Kwo) - Over raced in the early stages and then allowed to stride forward three wide through the early to middle stages before taking the lead near the 700 metres.

JAFFA (D Tait) - Raced wide without cover from the 800 metres.

SAY SATONO (B May) - Lay inwards passing the 250 metres having to be straightened by its rider. Briefly inconvenienced near the 100 metres when inside runner shifted out.

Race 9	ODT SOUTHERN MILE QUALIFIER 1600m

SPROCKET ROCKET (R Mudhoo) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after rearing and falling in the birdcage and was cleared to race. R Mudhoo was uninjured in this incident.

COSMETIC VIRTUE (K Williams) - Shifted out at the start crowding SILK 'N' DALE.

SILK 'N' DALE (C Barnes) - Crowded at the start losing ground. Improved wide from the 800 metres.

ZADANE (D Wilson) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start. Improved very wide from the 600 metres.

UNUSUAL AFFAIR (R Muniandy) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Held up early in the run home. Again held up passing the 200 metres and when shifting out jostled with SPROCKET ROCKET for a distance, with these two runners making contact on at least two more occasions over the concluding stages. R Muniandy was shown a replay of his ride in the run home with the assistance of the riding mentor and advised he must exercise more care when shifting ground.

MISS PEARL (T Comignaghi) - Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race. Rider reported she had some issues with the mare's tractability during the running.

RICHARD STOMPER (B May) - Shifted out abruptly near the 50 metres hampering THE CLUSTER.

THE CLUSTER (B Murray) - Hampered passing the 50 metres.
