Race 1 MARTY & DI'S CATERING MAIDEN 1600m

VERRY ROYAL (D Parker) - Slow to begin. D Parker advised the mare had been left flat-footed near the 800 metres when the tempo increased off a slow early pace.

UNCLE CHARLIE (K Wiles) - Slow to begin.

DAWN SHADOW (P Matthews) - Slow to begin then raced wide without cover in the early stages.

SIR GODFREY (A Roustoby) - Raced three-wide without cover for the majority of the event.

BLACKCOMB (C Wiles) - Raced keenly through the early to middle stages.

D Mcdonagh (SANDY LANE) -Issued with a warning after striking his mount SANDY LANE with an action where his arm was raised above shoulder height on two occasions.

Race 2 SB JOINERY 1600m

RHODESIAN (D Mcdonagh) - Slow to begin.

HESACITIBOY (M Gibbs-Manssen) - Slow to begin. Raced four-wide without cover throughout.

PINKERTON (P Matthews) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

MR BEANS THE NAME (C Wiles) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

GEORGIAN WARRIOR (K Wiles) - Steadied to avoid heels near the 1300 metres with the trailing I'M RONALDO also having to be steadied as a consequence. Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home, continuing to be held up until the 100 metres.

I'M RONALDO (S Fannin) - Steadied near the 1300 metres. Held up rounding the final bend only gaining clear racing room passing the 250 metres.

D Parker (ROCABURY) - Issued with a warning when allowing his mount to shift inwards near the 1300 metres when not fully clear of GEORGIAN WARRIOR, which had to be steadied.

Race 3 DOO YOU WANT ME SYNDICATE MAIDEN 1200m

LADY DERRYN (L Hemi) - Slow to begin and further hampered when inside runners shifted outwards shortly after the start.

SUMOSAURUS (K Hercock) - Raced wide and keenly through the early stages.

JUST BEN (M Singh) -Improved wide from the 700 metres.

KEEN ON BUBBLES (E Sole) - Steadied when improving onto the heels of GOOD CRAIC near the 600 metres. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the home straight and was again held up near the 150 metres when improving onto the heels of SAINT OLIVER.

SUMOSAURUS (K Hercock) - Lay outwards on the bend near the 400 metres then raced greenly early in the run home.

GOOD CRAIC (C Dell) - Rider C Dell expressed disappointment with the filly today, but added GOOD CRAIC may not have backed up from its most recent start.

Race 4 OULAGHAN RACING MAIDEN 3YO 1400m

HELLO CUPID (K Asano) - Slow to begin.

BEE HAVEN (L Hemi) - Restrained shortly after the start to obtain cover.

Race 5 ENTAIN – NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE MAIDEN 1400m

KEEPING TIME (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow to begin.

JETALAL (S O'Malley) - Slow to begin.

LET'S GET LOOSE (C Lindsay) - Saddle displaced early in the running, causing the rider some difficulty and the filly was not persevered with in the run home, with the rider dismounting prior to the winning post and leading LET'S GET LOOSE back to the birdcage.

ON ALERT (M Singh) - Shifted inwards near the 300 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of PRADASPHERE, having to briefly steady and shift inwards to find clear running.

HEAD FIRST (L Allpress) - Shifted inwards under pressure passing the 100 metres, having to be straightened by the rider.

ZEDDIANI (C Barnes) - Lay outwards under pressure over the concluding stages, making contact with CRY BABY just prior to the winning post.

CRY BABY (T Davies) - Briefly contacted near the finish.

Race 6 NIALL & EMMA QUINN PRE-TRAINING 1400m

KICK START (K Asano) - Began awkwardly, losing considerable ground. Connections were advised a further warning has been placed against the gelding's barrier manners. K Asano was of the opinion the gelding would benefit with the addition of a barrier blanket. Trainer A Meadows advised he would give consideration to making alterations to the gear of KICK START, including the addition of a barrier blanket.

SPIRIT OF BEXLEY (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.

GUESSING GAME (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin, then raced three-wide without cover throughout.

REV IT UP RUSTY (A Lawson-Carroll) - Crowded at the start, losing ground when SCRIPT shifted inwards. Shifted outwards looking for clear racing room near the 400 metres. Held up near the 100 metres when LADY PERFORMER (L Hemi) shifted outwards under pressure and as a result went to the line not fully tested by its rider. L Hemi was advised to exercise greater care and straighten her mount soon than she did on this occasion.

HEMI RIDAPEST (J Allen) - Inclined to shift ground outwards throughout the run home.

BEAN A PLEASURE (L Allpress) - Steadied to avoid the heels of REV IT UP RUSTY passing the 400 metres when that runner shifted outwards looking for clear racing room. Held up early in the run home, having to shift across heels near the 200 metres to find clear racing room.

MOONLIGHT HUSTLER (K Hercock) - Dictated wider 400 metres.

RAGAMUFFIN (J Doyle) - Dictated wider 400 metres.

A Lawson-Carroll (REV IT UP RUSTY) - Issued with a warning after allowing his mount to shift outwards passing the 400 metres when not fully clear of BEAN A PLEASURE, which had to steady. Also affected were MOONLIGHT HUSTLER and RAGAMUFFIN, which were dictated wider.

Race 7ROLY & PHILLIPA ELLIS 2100mCHAMPAGNE SUNDAY (C Dell) - Fractious in its barrier and bounded at the start losing ground.

SIR MIKKI (J Riddell) - Slow to begin.

DIVINE SPIRIT (K Asano) - Taken back from a wide draw shortly after the start to obtain cover.

LINCOLN STAR (A Lawson-Carroll) - Raced three-wide without cover in the early stages.

HUNGRY (C Barnes) - Raced keenly in the early stages and had to be steadied near the winning post on the first occasion when TRAMORE shifted inwards.

TORQUE TIME (C Lindsay) - Raced keenly when sitting outside the leader through the early to middle stages of the race.

MAKKALDEE (K Hercock) - Raced three-wide without cover from the 1400 metres.

A Mudhoo (TRAMORE) - Issued with a warning after allowing his mount to shift inwards when not fully clear of HUNGRY passing the winning post on the first occasion.

Race 8 FRED PRATT/CAITLIN JOHNSON RACING MAIDEN 2100m

RIDE THE TIDE (L Kauri) - Fractious in the barriers prior to the start.

GREY INVADOR (J Chung) - Bounded at the start losing some ground.

KENTUCKY BOY (J Allen) - Slow to begin.

LAZY (C Lindsay) - Slow to begin. Raced very wide into the first bend and three-wide without cover throughout.

CHERISHED LADY (T Davies) - Raced three-wide without cover through the early to middle stages.

VICKEZZMARGAUX (C Butler) - Briefly held up passing a tiring runner near the 350 metres.

ZEBADAYA (K Hercock) - When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no tangible excuse.
