JIBBITY (S Wynne) - Trainer J Dalton advised Stewards on 7 April that JIBBITY was found to be heavily in season following its disappointing run.

Race 1	EDITOR'S CUT SPORTS BAR HANDICAP (1200m)
<p>HASSTOBEYOU (K Bakker) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly through the early stages. Held up until shifting ground outwards passing the 150 metres to find clear racing room.</p> <p>THE GOOD SHEPHERD (G Jogoo) - Got back shortly after the start.</p>	
Race 2	THE AVE SPORTS BAR MAIDEN (1200m)
<p>Trainer S Kirkland (TOMASINA) - Issued with a warning after presenting TOMASINA without the notified pre-race ear covers.</p> <p>MOUTIS (S Wynne) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>DE RUSSIAN ROCKET (Y Atchamah) - Slow to begin. Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>THE PRINCIE ONE (D Cooper) - Over-raced in the middle stages.</p> <p>ICE COLD GOLD (K Bakker) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>ELIZABETH MARY (R Muniandy) - Shifted ground inwards passing the 150 metres having to be straightened by its rider.</p> <p>HIVARI (B Murray) - Had to be shifted across heels passing the 150 metres to find clear racing room.</p>	
Race 3	ASCOT SPORTS BAR HANDICAP (1200m)
<p>TOWN BELT (B May) - Began awkwardly and was contacted shortly after. Shifted out passing the 300 metres making contact with ZAC BLACK and as a result became unbalanced losing some momentum. B May was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>SMALL TOWN BELLE (K Chowdhoo) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>EARL OF ORKNEY (R Muniandy) - Shifted in shortly after the start making contact with TOWN BELT. Raced three-wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>BALZANO (C Campbell) - Taken back from a wide draw shortly after the start and tailed the field throughout. Rider could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance adding that in his opinion the gelding may need the blinkers reapplied.</p> <p>MEDINA (S Wynne) - Rider was of the opinion the mare was looking for more distance at this stage of its preparation.</p> <p>ZAC BLACK (K Mudhoo) - Contacted and briefly unbalanced passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>QUICK TAP (T Moseley) - Held up in the middle stages of the run home having to shift outwards across heels passing the 150 metres to find clear racing room.</p>	
Race 4	ASHFORD MOTOR LODGE MAIDEN (2200m)
<p>MR GEE (C Campbell) - Knuckled at the start. Rider reported the gelding was unsuited by the muddling pace of today's race.</p>	

RELENTLESS KAYDEN (T Moseley) - Slow to begin. Over-raced passing the 1500 metres and was allowed to improve forward to lead near the 1300 metres.

BRICKIE'S MOJO (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin. Over-raced passing the 1400 metres and was allowed to stride forward to lead passing the 1100 metres.

MIDNIGHT BELLE (R Muniandy) - Raced wide from the 1300 metres then commenced to give ground from the 600 metres.

SANPERION (L Callaway) - Over-raced on a slow tempo through the middle stages.

IN VOGUE (K Bakker) - When asked to comment on the apparent improved performance trainer K Shearing advised the mare had been suited to the step up in distance today and benefited from the addition of blinkers.

WILD JAKKAL (K Chowdhoo) - Lost the off-hind plate during the running.

Race 5	WAIKIWI TAVERN & THE FOUNDRY RESTAURANT HANDICAP (2200m)
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SACRED DREAM (S Wynne) - Blundered leaving the barriers losing some momentum. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the mare had disappointed after racing outside the leader on a fast tempo.

TWILIGHT GEM (S Toolooa) - Slow to begin.

CHOUX IN (K Kwo) - Got back shortly after the start.

LEAVE IT TO ME (T Moseley) - After initially being slow to begin was taken back from its wide draw to obtain cover.

MEGALOMANIAC (B Murray) - Raced keenly while leading through the early and middle stages. Gave ground from the 800 metres.

HENLEY (K Bakker) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

Race 6	ILT CENTERPOINT & SOUTHCITY LIQUORLAND MAIDEN (1400m)
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KING PALM (K Williams) - Blundered leaving the barriers.

CHANCE (T Moseley) - Slow to begin.

CHUGGATAI (K Chowdhoo) - Underwent a pre-race Veterinary examination after being kicked when assembling behind the barriers and was cleared to start. Slow to begin.

SUNSET EXPRESS (K Bakker) - Raced keenly for a short distance passing the 900 metres. Had to shift ground inwards passing the 175 metres to find clear racing room.

MISSONI (K Kwo) - Held up rounding the final bend and again through the middle stages of the run home, having to be restrained off heels passing the 100 metres and shift ground inwards to find clear racing room.

Race 7	WAXY'S IRISH PUB HANDICAP (1400m)
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B Murray (CLAUDIUS MAXIMUSS) - Admitted a charge under Rule 346(3) in that he failed to make the declared weight for his ride on CLAUDIUS MAXIMUSS and was fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule. B Murray was replaced by T Moseley.

SEA SHEPHERD (C Campbell) - After initially being slow to begin was taken back to obtain cover.

RUBY ROYALE (L Callaway) - Over raced in the early stages getting its head up on a number of occasions.

CALL ME AL (S Wynne) - Had to be restrained to avoid the heels of STOP YELLING (G Jogoo) as the field made the junction near the 1200 metres. G Jogoo was advised to exercise greater care.

THE HANGOVER (K Williams) - Raced wide without cover from the 800 metres and was reported by its rider to have hung outwards throughout the running.

B May (PANDDE) – Fined \$200 under the Minor Infringement Schedule under Rule 648(5) after weighing in 0.8kg above his weigh out weight.

Race 8

NORTHERN SPORTS BAR & TAB HANDICAP (1600m)

MONTE KHAN (S Wynne) - Slow to begin.

BLEAKHOUSE BURTIE (S Toolooa) - Slow to begin. Raced wide from the 800 metres.

FINBARR (K Williams) - Got back shortly after the start.

THEODEN (C Campbell) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Held up rounding the final bend.

ANAFTERNOONDELIGHT (G Jogoo) - Raced very wide through the early stages and three-wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

MOLLY SHAW (L Callaway) - Gave ground from the 600 metres. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed the mare to have suffered cardiac arrhythmia. Trainer B Laking was advised that MOLLY SHAW will not be permitted to start in any race or trial until a Veterinary certificate is supplied declaring the horse free of any cardiac arrhythmia following a gallop of at least 1000 metres.
