GENERAL

Due to Trackside technical difficulties the start of the first race was delayed until 12:57pm, with all following races put back one race and, with the last race rescheduled to 5:37pm.

SUPPLEMENTARY

Otago Racing Club at Wingatui, Saturday 2 March 2024 Race 1 DAKOTA BUTIQUE + LIFESTYLE 820m

PERFECT GLORY (L Callaway) - Trainer Mr S Muniandy advised Stewards that PERFECT GLORY pulled up shin sore in the left foreleg and has now been sent for a spell.

Race 9 ODT SOUTHERN MILE FINAL 1600m

K Williams (THE GREY GOOSE) - The adjourned hearing was reconvened into rider K Williams allowing her mount THE GREY GOOSE to shift inwards passing the 50 metres crowding TURF WAR which was checked. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of K Williams' licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Thursday 14 March until the conclusion of racing on Friday 22 March, 4 national riding days.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 RICCARTON PARK FUNCTION CENTRE 1200m

DECEPTIO VISUS (T Comignaghi) - Slow to begin.

PLEASURE (T Moseley) - Began awkwardly making contact with CEDDY SMITH.

CEDDY SMITH (J Doyle) - Slow to begin and was then contacted.

MUMBO JUMBO (K Asano) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Lay inwards under pressure passing the 200 metres having to be corrected by its rider.

MININJAGIRL (S Toolooa) - Slow to begin.

FOREVER BABE (J Fawcett) - Raced keenly through the early stages. Lay outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

PATTON (K Williams) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

Race 2 SPEIGHT'S SUMMIT ULTRA ON TAP MAIDEN 1200m

YAK SHA (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly. Shifted in abruptly having to be corrected by its rider passing the 100 metres.

HOSHI (J Doyle) - Began awkwardly making contact with THUNDEROUS.

THUNDEROUS (D Cooper) - Began awkwardly making contact with HOSHI and when being corrected by its rider shifted inwards placing PINK CADILLAC in restricted room.

GRASSHOPPER (K Bakker) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

MOVIE GIRL (T Comignaghi) - Slow to begin.

QUEEN OF KINGS (G Jogoo) - Began awkwardly then commenced to race keenly through the early and middle stages.

PINK CADILLAC (S Toolooa) - Placed in restricted room shortly after the start having to be steadied and as a result lost ground.

SHINTO (T Moseley) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Had to be shifted outwards when becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 400 metres.

COOL IMPACT (W Kennedy) - Over raced through the early and middle stages. Raced greenly throughout the final straight. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. Following a veterinary inspection COOL IMPACT was confirmed to have bled. COOL IMPACT shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any race or trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian.

EL ULTIMO (U Holmquist) - When over racing had to be steadied after becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 900 metres.

Race 3 MARTIN COLLINS 1200m

CARAVELLA (K Asano) - Began awkwardly shifting outwards crowding STELLA SPLENDIDA. Raced greenly in the run home and was inclined to shift ground throughout the final straight.

STELLA SPLENDIDA (W Kennedy) - Slow to begin and was then crowded when CARAVELLA shifted outwards. Held up through the early stages of the final straight having to be angled outwards across heels to obtain clear running approaching the 200 metres.

MISS NICO BELLE (T Moseley) - Blundered at the start losing ground. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Near the 700 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of CARAVELLA having to steady.

GOLDEN HARVEST (K Williams) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

Race 4SAM KEENAN TENNIS COACH OPEN HANDICAP 1400mJEWEL OF PATCH (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin then ridden forward to lead.

SIR ALBERT (J Doyle) - Slow to begin.

DAZZLING MISS (Y Atchamah) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LORD DARCI (K Asano) - On a slow tempo commenced to over race having to be restrained off heels near the 950 metres. Held up early in the run home.

Race 5

TAB PUNTERS CHALLENGE 13 APRIL MAIDEN 1400m

THEE AULD MINX (C Barnes) - Declared a late scratching at 3:18pm on veterinary advice after being removed from its barrier when showing the presence of blood in a nostril. Underwent a subsequent veterinary inspection including an endoscopic examination revealing a minor laceration to the left nostril which confirmed the mare not to have bled.

HAPPY STORY (D Cooper) - Shifted outwards at the start crowding LUV ROSAY. Lay inwards under pressure throughout the final straight.

LUV ROSAY (G Jogoo) - Crowded at the start losing ground. Contacted 900 metres. Raced keenly for a distance passing the 900 meters.

AVIVA (K Kwo) - Slow to begin.

YOSHIME (J Fawcett) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

CONTEMPLATION BAY (U Holmquist) - Began awkwardly making contact with CLAIRIERE.

CLAIRIERE (K Bakker) - Contacted at the start.

EMPRESS SUIKO (S Wynne) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

ARCHIE BUNKER (C Campbell) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

JADE (K Asano) - Got its head up when being steadied off heels near the 900 metres when SEA BREEEZE (Y Atchamah) shifted in when not fully clear. Y Atchamah was advised to exercise greater care.

ON FILE (T Comignaghi) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

SEA BREEZE (Y Atchamah) - Lay in and away from ON FILE then making contact with LUV ROSAY approaching the 900 metres.

KEEP IT LOOSE (J Doyle) - When over racing near the 900 metres had to steady and shift outwards after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of CONTEMPLATION BAY and was then obliged to race three wide without cover for the remainder. Steadied off the heels of HAPPY STORY (D Cooper) which lay inwards under pressure passing the 150 metres. D Cooper was shown footage of his ride in the presence of the Riding Mentor and advised to exercise greater care and that he must straighten his mount sooner that he did on this occasion.

Following this race, the track was upgraded to Good 3.

Race 6 LINDAUER 2000m

WIND IN MY WINGS (K Chowdhoory) - - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

IFFIDIDIT (J Doyle) - From its wide barrier draw was restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

ARISTOCRAT (K Williams) - Raced three wide without cover through the early stages before being improved forward to lead passing the 1500 metres.

TYPHOON TIP (K Bakker) - When over racing near the 1500 metres was crowded to the inside of AMAZON GODDESS and was then contacted, with TYPHOON TIP reacting poorly and shifting out contacting AMAZON GODDESS, then becoming awkward in its stride and going back onto JAFFA which had to be heavily restrained.

AMAZON GODDESS (U Holmquist) - Placed in restricted room making contact with TYPHOON TIP near the 1500 metres then becoming briefly unbalanced when TYPHOON TIP overreacted and shifted out making contact with AMAZON GODDESS. Trainer K Moore advised Stewards AMAZON GODDESS received lacerations to both hind legs consistent with being galloped on which required veterinary treatment.

JAFFA (D Cooper) - Had to be heavily restrained off the heels of TYPHOON TIP resulting in IN VEGAS and PATSYS LASS being hampered near the 1400 metres. Raced three wide without cover from the 800 metres.

IN VEGAS (C Campbell) - Hampered 1400 metres. Held up rounding the final bend.

PATSYS LASS (T Moseley) - Hampered 1400 metres. Rider could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance other than the mare may have been feeling the effects of recent racing.

DEMAND RESPECT (W Kennedy) - Raced three wide without cover from the 1400 metres before being allowed to improve forward to sit outside the leader near the 800 metres.

K Williams (ARISTOCRAT) - Issued with a warning after allowing her mount ARISTOCRAT to shift inwards crowding AMAZON GODDESS and TYPHOON TIP passing the 1500 metres. When assessing this penalty Stewards took into account the racing manners of both TYPHOON TIP and AMAZON GODDESS.

Race 7

BOOK A SUITE FOR AUTUMN RACING MAIDEN 1600m

Co-trainers **M Walker & S Bergerson** (PLENTY O' STYLE) - Fined \$50 under the Minor Infringement Schedule after presenting their runner with unnotified gear (pre-race ear covers).

SMOKIN' JOSIE (B Murray) - Slow to begin.

SACAMBAYA (K Mudhoo) - Began very awkwardly losing ground.

PIERROGRINE (J Doyle) - Slow to begin then ridden with urgency to recover. Rider could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance.

AN MORRIGHAN (K Kwo) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Shifted out to avoid heels 700 metres.

TETBURY (S Wynne) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Hampered 700 metres.

DESCARO (C Campbell) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

CAPTAIN UPHAM (Y Atchamah) - Had to be steadied off heels when making the bend near the 700 metres awkwardly resulting in CAPTAIN UPHAM going back onto AN MORRIGHAN which was improving onto that runner's heels, with AN MORRIGHAN having to shifting outwards hampering the trailing TETBURY.

REGGIE RULER (K Asano) - Improved onto heels having to steady near the 350 metres.

Race 8 DAPHNE BANNAN MEMORIAL 1600m

Co-trainers **R McKay & A Harrington** (ROYCE ROCA) - Fined \$50 under the Minor Infringement Schedule for late notification of a gear change (removal of tongue tie).

DAME COUNTY (K Asano) - Stood flat footed as the start was effected and as a result lost ground.

THE ARCTIC BLAST (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SOMBRA DEAMOR (J Fawcett) - Got its head up when being restrained to obtain cover through the early stages. Held up rounding the final bend and was unable to obtain clear running until shifting inwards near the 200 metres.

TAVANASIA (J Doyle) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

CATALINA BAY (A Najib) - Shifted outwards approaching the 400 metres inconveniencing CAITLYN JAY and MISS INTERPRET. Lay inwards under pressure inconveniencing TAVANASIA passing the 250 metres. A Najib was shown footage of his ride in the presence of the Riding Mentor and was advised to exercise greater care.

FINAL SAVINGS (U Holmquist) - Shifted inwards under pressure making contact with LOMBARDI over the concluding stages.

LOMBARDI (T Comignaghi) - Contacted concluding stages.

Race 9RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE 1400mSOOO DUSTY (A Najib) - Began awkwardly losing ground and then ridden with urgency to recover.

OUR MILLY BEE (J Doyle) - Slow to begin. Held up for the majority of the final straight having to be angled outwards across heels to obtain clear running passing the 50 metres.

SAUVAGE (C Campbell) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. Held up rounding the final bend and through the early stages of the final straight and was only able to obtain clear running near the 300 metres.

AERIAL BLUE (J Fawcett) - Rider dropped the whip shortly after the start.

DIAGON ALLEY (U Holmquist) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

BELLO MIO (K Asano) - Briefly placed in restricted room approaching the 1000 metres and when being steadied got its head up.

PARAMOUNT PRINCE (K Kwo) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Improved onto heels having to steady near the 850 metres going back on BUGATTI which had to shift outwards to avoid that runner's heels.

BUGATTI (T Moseley) - Steadied to avoid heels 850 metres.

RUBICON REIGNS (C Barnes) - Contacted and unbalanced near the 350 metres when BOSS MAN (R Jaun) shifted outwards. R Jaun was shown footage of his ride in the presence of the Riding Mentor and advised to exercise greater care.

BOSS MAN (R Jaun) - Returned to the enclosure with injuries to both back legs consistent with having been galloped on during the running and was immediately attended to by the Veterinarian and transported by horse ambulance to Canterbury Equine Clinic for treatment. Stewards will follow up in coming days. Connections were advised that a Veterinary clearance is required prior to racing next.
