RACE COMMENTS					
Race 1	WANGANUI INSURANCE BROKERS MAIDEN 1200m				
UCSA (M Singh)	- Raced keenly through the middle stages.				
INCOLN VALLEY	(J Riddell) - Made the final bend awkwardly.				

ROSALITA (L Sutherland) - Raced greenly over the concluding stages.

Race 2 JOLT COFFEE HOUSE 1200m

KANA (T Davies) - Began awkwardly. Commenced to over-race near the 1000 metres becoming awkwardly placed to the inside of AEQUUS, then blundering. Continued to over-race for a distance passing the 800 metres.

AEQUUS (C Grylls) - Raced wide throughout, making the final bend awkwardly.

MEHRTENS (L Kauri) - Lost the near-fore plate during the running.

C Butler (LILHOOVESGOTMOVES) was questioned in the presence of the Apprentice Mentor regarding her decision to restrain her mount which settled well back after beginning well. C Butler advised that her instructions were to ride the mare back in the field but agreed with Stewards she had got further back than intended when restraining her mount in the early stages and was left flat-footed when the pace increased significantly near the 600 metres. C Butler was shown footage of her ride and advised she is expected to exercise better judgment in future.

Race 3 MAD BUTCHER WANGANUI MAIDEN 1360m

HASBULLA (T Davies) - Checked near the 1100 metres then commenced to over-race and had little left at the finish. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

JOE ROMINO (C Barnes) - Raced wide throughout.

CRAFTSMAN (J Riddell) - Raced keenly near the 1100 metres.

L Kauri (TIPO) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted TIPO to shift inwards near the 1100 metres when not sufficiently clear of HASBULLA, which was checked. After hearing submissions, the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today, Thursday, 22 February until the conclusion of racing on Thursday, 29 February, 4 national riding days. Stewards directed Apprentice Jockey Kauri meet with a Rider Skills Review Panel for further tuition.

Race 4 WHANGANUI CHRONICLE 1360m

BOSTON STRONG BOY (C Grylls) - Restrained to the rear from its wide draw. When questioned rider advised he was of the opinion there may be something amiss the gelding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have bled. BOSTON STRONG BOY shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any Race or Trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian. Connections advised that BOSTON STRONG BOY will be retired from their stable.

PLATINUM SIXTY SIX (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly, contacting MEDIA MISS.

MEDIA MISS (K Hercock) - Contacted at the start. Raced wide throughout.

RUBY SEEKER (L Sutherland) - Over-raced through the early and middle stages when leading.

RICHTER (L Hemi) - Over-raced having to be steadied near the 900 metres.

NARINCE (C Barnes) - Held up in the early stages of the home straight.

Race 5 MR SWABBY WANTS A SAMPLE MAIDEN 1600m

NEVER NEVER (C Barnes) - Slow away. Commenced to over-race and hang through the early and middle stages placing the rider at a disadvantage when bumping SWEET ENVY several times passing the 1000 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality. When questioned C Barnes advised Stewards

the mare was in an agitated state prior to arriving at the start and in her opinion may have been feeling the effects of recent racing.

KAHLUA (K Asano) - Slow away.

PRIMO ATTITUDE (L Hemi) - Awkwardly placed between runners entering the back straight when NEVER NEVER lay outwards when over-racing.

SWEET ENVY (L Sutherland) - Bumped near the 1000 metres when NEVER NEVER hung outwards.

PRADASPHERE (M Singh) - Raced wide throughout.

JUSTIFY THAT (C Dell) - Lay inwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

JACK MORRISON (J Chung) - After racing prominently in the early and middle stages, capitulated from near the 700 metres, finishing a distant last. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have suffered cardiac arrhythmia. Trainer M Oulaghan was advised that JACK MORRISON will not be permitted to start in any race or trial until a veterinary certificate declaring the horse free of any cardiac arrhythmia following a gallop of 1000 metres.

NEW ORLEANS JAZZ (C Grylls) - Disappointed. Connections advised that NEW ORLEANS JAZZ is finished as a racing proposition from their stable.

C Dell (JUSTIFY THAT) - Admitted a charge of using the whip in two consecutive strides on his mount near the 150 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$150.

Race 6 TERRY BROTHERS 2060m

BLACK BETTY (K Hercock), FOURTY EIGHT (C Barnes) and WALKINTHEPARK (K Asano) bumped at the start.

BLACK BETTER (K Hercock), Bumped at the start.

FOURTY EIGHT (C Barnes) - Bumped at the start.

WALKINTHEPARK (K Asano) - Bumped at the start.

STRINGLINE (T Davies) -Improved on to heels going into the back straight, having to be steadied for some distance.

ANAROA (J Riddell) - When questioned into performance J Riddell advised his mount was unsuited to the stop/start pace in the early and middle stages and had to check sharply when improving on to heels near the 900 metres. J Riddell added the gelding raced greenly throughout and failed to finish the race off as expected.
