GENERAL

N Hailey advised stewards the day before the meeting he was injured and would not be attending today's meeting. Replacements were made as per schedule above. N Hailey was advised he would be required to provide a medical clearance before riding again.

D Tait advised stewards on the morning of the races that she was injured and was unable to ride at today's meeting and was replaced on her 3 rides as per schedule above. Miss Tait was advised she would need a medical clearance prior to riding next.

Pre-race blood testing was carried out at today's meeting.

Race 7 – J Kamaruddin (EXCHANGE), S Wynne (ASTRADEEL) and J Doyle (VERISMO) were all given permission to ride +1kg.

Race 9 LIQUORLAND GORE GUINEAS (1335m)

TRADER (C Campbell) – Co-trainer Mr. S Anderton advised Stewards, TRADER underwent a dynamic endoscope which revealed the gelding to have a grade 4 wind issue. S Anderton further advised that TRADER has now been retired from racing.

Canterbury Racing 27th January 2024 – Race 2 INGLEWOOD STUD AT KARAKA 2024 1200 Metres

Due to the malfunction of the starting gates in this race with the cause still undetermined the Canterbury Jockey Club have decided that until Stereline staff can inspect the gates used on this day and conduct a full audit with scheduled maintenance also being done the alternate set of gates the club has available will be used for the next 2 meetings at least.

Race 8 SPEIGHT'S TIMARU STAKES 1400m

KAI (K Williams) – Te Akau Racing Manager Mr. R Trumper advised Stewards, the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of the mare, however, has now been retired from racing.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 LORRAIN ANDERTON MEMORIAL 1600m

SILVER CANNON (N Parmer) - Blundered at the start. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

CEDDY SMITH (J Doyle) - Slow to begin.

TOMYTURBO (T Comignaghi) - Slow to begin and was then hampered, losing ground. Rider reported the gelding had not been comfortable in today's soft track conditions.

MISS BELLE (J Kamaruddin) - Shifted inwards at the start hampering TOMYTURBO.

FINAL SAVINGS (R Beeharry) - Jumped away very awkwardly making contact with BELLANO, losing ground. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

BELLANO (K Asano) - Contacted at the start losing ground.

SMOOTH OPERATOR (K Chowdhury) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

HUGS (T Moseley) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

JUST MAYBE (K Williams) - Over-raced, getting its head up through the early stages when being restrained to obtain cover.

LUCIENNE (R Mudhoo) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

CHRISTOPHE VERMEER (D Montes de Oca) - Crowded when tiring by **SILVER CANNON** (N Parmar) which shifted inwards under pressure passing the 200 metres. N Parmar was advised to exercise greater care.

Track downgraded to Soft 7 retrospective to Race 1.

Race 2 | **GRAND CASINO MAIDEN 1400m**

CHUPALLA (T Comignaghi) - Slow to begin.

SUGAR TIME (J Kamaruddin) - Shifted outwards at the start having to be corrected by its rider and as a result lost ground.

IMPERATIVE (C Campbell) - Shifted outwards and away from **SUGAR TIME** at the start, crowding **SALAAM NAMASTEY**. Held up early in the run home, having to shift outwards across heels near the 300 metres to find clear racing room. Lay inwards over the concluding stages having to be straightened by the rider.

SALAAM NAMASTEY (A Najib) - Began awkwardly and was then crowded, losing ground. Over-raced into the bend near the 900 metres, having to be steadied for some distance to avoid heels of the runners in front. Rider weighed in 0.5kg light with the rider advising he had been to the toilet after weighing out. Stewards notified Mr Najib that he would be expected to be more careful in similar circumstances and that he just fell within the tolerance under the rules.

MISS ENZED (K Williams) - Slow to begin.

HAPPY STORY (B May) - Over-raced through the early and middle stages when racing wide without cover.

PEEKAY (J Doyle) - Raced three-wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

VICTORIAN CHARM (N Parmar) - Held up until passing the 250 metres.

SUNSET EXPRESS (B Murray) - Raced erratically in the early stages then wide throughout. Hung outwards rounding the final bend and was not persevered with throughout the home straight. When questioned regarding performance rider reported the gelding had hung throughout and been a difficult ride. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 3 | **PROPERTY BROKERS – RAY KEAN 1400m**

SERIOUSLY (J Doyle) - Slow to begin then shifted outwards hampering **SESTINA**.

SESTINA (S Wynne) - Slow to begin and was then hampered shortly after the start. Inclined to lay inwards in the run home having to be straightened on a number of occasions by the rider.

RUTHLESS ROYAL (N Parmar) - Slow to begin.

THE HANGOVER (K Williams) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

HASSTOBEYOU (B Murray) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

SEIKRID (T Comignaghi) - Lay inwards early in the run home and when being shifted across heels to find clear racing was crowded and had to steady by SESTINA (S Wynne), which shifted in under pressure before being straightened by its rider. Continued to lay inwards over the concluding stages.

SACRED ROSE (L Callaway) - Rider reported that the mare had been disappointing, however may not have been suited to being ridden in front.

S Wynne (SESTINA) - Issued with a warning for allowing her mount to shift inwards crowding SEIKRID near the 150 metres.

JIBBITY (D Montes de Oca) - Lost the off-hind plate during the running.

Race 4 | **GALLAGHER INSURANCE OPEN 1200m**

EMANON (A Najib) - Began awkwardly making contact with and crowding ADANNAYA and as a result lost ground. Was then ridden with urgency to recover. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

ADANNAYA (J Doyle) - Contacted and was then crowded shortly after the start when runners either side shifted ground, and as a result lost ground.

CHOKITO (S Wynne) - Slow to begin, then shifted inwards crowding ADANNAYA.

HENRY HUBBER (K Bakker) - Slow to begin.

ROCKLAND (S Weatherley) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

AMBERECHO (K Williams) - Rider reported that the mare was disappointing and less than genuine in her effort today.

Race 5 | **DUNEDIN CITY MOTORS DUNEDIN GUINEAS (Listed Race) 1500m**

SUGAR (S Weatherley) - Very slow to begin then commenced to buck losing considerable ground and was not persevered with for the remainder of the event. Connections were advised the filly would be required to barrier trial prior to racing next.

LUV ROSAY (D Montes de Oca) - Slow to begin.

MOGUL (K Asano) - Began awkwardly shifting out crowding outside runners, losing ground as a result.

COLLECT YOUR CASH (T Moseley) - Crowded at the start losing ground. Shifted outwards near the 350 metres when looking for clear racing room and had to be straightened when making contact with TRIKSTA.

SENSE OF TIMING (N Parmar) - Shifted ground outwards throughout the run home.

TRIKSTA (L Callaway) - Hampered near the 350 metres when COLLECT YOUR CASH (T Moseley) shifted outwards before being straightened by its rider. T Moseley was advised to exercise greater care.

QUINTABELLE (J Doyle) - Crowded and checked near the 50 metres.

OCEAN LIGHT (T Comignaghi) - Held up in the run home only gaining clear running near the 250 metres. Lay outwards over the concluding stages.

HAKADECREE (J Kamaruddin) - When questioned regarding performance J Kamaruddin advised he had had a good run throughout, however when placed under pressure the gelding had failed to respond and was disappointing.

N Parmar (SENSE OF TIMING) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted SENSE OF TIMING to shift outwards near the 50 metres when not sufficiently clear of QUINTABELLE, which was crowded and checked. After hearing submissions, the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Thursday, 7 March until the conclusion of racing on Sunday, 17 March, 7 national riding days and in addition imposed a fine of \$225.

Race 6 | **NELLIES RESTAURANT & BAR 2200m**

AEQUALIS (K Bakker) - Began awkwardly making contact with ZAMBEZI ZIPPER and as a result lost ground.

ZAMBEZI ZIPPER (B Rogerson) - Contacted at the start. Raced wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding the improved performance of ZAMBEZI ZIPPER, Trainer K Tyler advised the gelding had struck a track to suit today.

HEY MICKEY (J Fawcett) - Began awkwardly making contact with PONTARDAWE and as a result lost ground.

PONTARDAWE (T Comignaghi) - Contacted at the start.

ON THE RIVET (L Callaway) - Slow to begin. Jostled with DA VINCI GIRL for a short distance passing the 300 metres. Lay inwards passing the 175 metres inconveniencing DA VINCI GIRL.

WILLIAM JOHN (B May) - Under pressure rounding the final bend. Finished a distant last with the rider unable to offer any excuse. A post-race veterinary examination found no obvious abnormality, however connections advised they would be having the gelding scoped in coming days and will advise Stewards of any significant anomaly.

DA VINCI GIRL (J Doyle) - Steadied near the 600 metres when held up by a tiring runner. Jostled with ON THE RIVET for a short distance passing the 300 metres. Inconvenienced 175 metres.

Race 7 | **POSITIVE SIGNS + PRINT DUNEDIN GOLD CUP (Listed Race) 2400M**

LOCHNABERRY (B Rogerson) - Slow to begin.

THE TUI TOILER (B Murray) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

VERISMO (J Doyle) - Stood flat-footed as the start was effect, losing considerable ground.

NOBLE KNIGHT (K Asano) - Slow to begin.

SHOCKALLIA (J Fawcett) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

EXCHANGE (J Kamaruddin) - Began awkwardly, then commenced to race keenly through the early stages.

ELEGANT LADY (N Parmar) - Briefly held up rounding the final bend.

Race 8 | **STEVE ANDERTON MEMORIAL 65 1200m**

ATOMIC (B Rogerson) - Slow to begin. Lay inwards early in the run home and shifted inwards near the 200 metres, inconveniencing TAIL LIGHTS, before being straightened by the rider.

TAIL LIGHTS (T Comignaghi) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout. Inconvenienced 200 metres.

CHEYENNE DREAMS (R Mudhoo) - Crowded at the start when KITH 'N' KIN shifted outwards.

KITH 'N' KIN (N Parmar) - Began awkwardly shifting out contacting an outside runner.

JUSTANACE (A Najib) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

BOURBON CHIQUE (J Kamaruddin) - Clipped a heel and blundered badly passing the 500 metres, dislodging the rider, who was uninjured. After interviewing riders and reviewing replays, it was established BOURBON CHIQUE was navigating a tight run between runners, lay inwards as the field made the point of the bend, becoming awkwardly placed and clipping the heels of RU BRADAR, dislodging the rider. Stewards were satisfied no rider was at fault and took the matter no further. Lost the two front racing plates during the running.

Race 9 | **WHITE ROBE LODGE WEIGHT FOR AGE (G3) 1600m**

BURGIE (T Moseley) - Lost the use of his right iron on jumping, which had come loose after contacting the side of the barrier, with the rider becoming unbalanced and dislodged shortly after, and as a result hampering LORD DARCI. T Moseley was examined by St John paramedics and found to be uninjured.

LORD DARCI (J Kamaruddin) - Hampered shortly after the start. Over-raced when leading in the early middle stages, with the rider reporting that the addition of blinkers had made the gelding race keenly. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

MATSCOT (T Comignaghi) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

NOBELLEM (B Murray) - Blundered at the start losing ground. Rider reported that after blundering badly at the start the mare had never travelled well and had been disappointing. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality. NOBELLEM will undergo further veterinary examination after returning to the stable. Stewards will follow-up in coming days.

GO LOTTE (B Rogerson) - Slow to begin.

FIRODEN (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

Race 10 | **ODT SOUTHERN MILE QUALIFYING RACE 1600m**

AYREON (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin. Rider reported the gelding had not handled today's soft track conditions.

JESSIE'S ROCK (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin.

INDUSTRIALIST (S Wynne) - Slow to begin.

THE CLUSTER (J Doyle) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

SACRED DREAM (B Murray) - Began awkwardly, making contact with HAZEL MAY.

HAZEL MAY (B Rogerson) - Contacted at the start.

UNUSUAL AFFAIR (T Moseley) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

MONTE KHAN (D Bothamley) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

MISS PEARL (T Comignaghi) - Over-raced in the early stages having to be restrained away from heels on a number of occasions.
