### SUPPLEMENTARY

#### Otago Racing Club at Wingatui - Saturday 3 February 2024

##### Race 9 - WHITE ROBE LODGE WEIGHT FOR AGE (G3) 1600m

**NOBELLEM** (B Murray) - Trainer Mr T Kennedy advised Stewards he was satisfied with the post-race condition of the mare and it his intention to carry on with **NOBELLEM'S** current preparation.

#### Wanganui Jockey Club at Wanganui - Friday 9 February 2024

##### Race 9 - WANGANUI GREYHOUND CLUB RACING TONIGHT 1600m

**T Mitchell** (KHAFRE) - Issued with a warning after striking her mount KHAFRE six times prior to the 100 metres and a further five times inside the final 100 metres.

#### RACE COMMENTS

##### Race 1 | RICcarton Park Function Centre Maiden 1600m

**CAPTAIN UPHAM** (S Toolooa) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Hung outwards rounding the final bend. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed on CAPTAIN UPHAM 's racing manners.

**ZLATNA** (C Campbell) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

**HARRIET** (K Kwo) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay in on a number of occasions in the run home.

**BELLUTTA** (R Jaun) - Improved onto heels near the 900 metres having to be steadied, with that runner then going back onto LIGAR LASS which also had to be steadied. Held up rounding the final bend and near the 450 metres improved into a narrow run making slight contact with CHANNA. Rider R Jaun was shown replays of this incident in the presence of the Apprentice Riding Mentor and advised he must not anticipate runs until they have fully developed.

**LIGAR LASS** (T Moseley) - Steadied near the 900 metres. Held up rounding the final bend and through the early stages of the final straight.

**CHANNA** (T Comignaghi) - Placed in restricted room near the 400 metres when BELLUTTA shifted out looking for clear running, and GETALONGHOME which when contacted by CHANNA over-reacted and lay inwards badly having to be straightened by its rider. Rider dropped her whip near the 150 metres.

**GETALONGHOME** (B May) - Contacted and turned inwards near the 400 metres.

**EPILOGUE** (L Sutherland) - Crowded and had to steady near the 300 metres when HARRIET shifted in and away from an outside runner. Crowded again passing the 200 metres when HARRIET again lay in despite the efforts of its rider.

**ATLANTIC CITY** (K Williams) - Crowded and buffeted passing the 200 metres when EPILOGUE was taken in by HARRIET.

##### Race 2 | FIONA STUART MEMORIAL MAIDEN 1600m

**OH SO SWIFT** (L Hemi) - Slow to begin.

**SMOKIN' JOSIE** (T Moseley) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**HOME SWEET HOME** (A Balloo) - Crowded shortly after the start losing some ground. Had to be shifted outwards across heels near the 900 metres when AN MORRIGHAN was being steadied, dictating ZOOM wider on the track.

**AN MORRIGHAN** (K Kwo) - Raced keenly in the early stages and near the 1100 metres had to be checked. Continued to race keenly through the middle stages proving difficult for the rider. Steadied away from heels near the 150 metres.

**RICHIE'S DREAM** (D Wilson) - Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

**ZOOM** (T Comignaghi) - Dictated wider on the track near the 900 metres.

**EMBELLIER** (K Chowdhoooy) - Inclined to shift ground throughout the run home, shifting inwards crowding runners passing the 250 metres and then shifting outwards near the 150 metres.

**HAPPY STORY** (B Rogerson) - Buffeted and unbalanced near the 250 metres by PEARL OPULENCE which lay inwards and away from an outside runner.

**K Chowdhoooy** (EMBELLIER) – Issued with a warning after permitting his mount EMBELLIER to shift outwards near the 150 metres crowding AN MORRIGHAN which had to be steadied away from heels.

**K Chowdhoooy** (EMBELLIER) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount EMBELLIER to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of AN MORRIGHAN which was crowded and checked passing the 1100 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of K Chowdhoooy's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 17 February until the conclusion of racing on Saturday 24 February - 5 national riding days.

**Race 3** | **ALISTAIR GRAY MEMORIAL MAIDEN 1400m**

**ROYAL BERNE** (D Tait) - Proved reluctant to load. Began awkwardly. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**PATRAINE** (C Campbell) - Shifted outwards shortly after the start dictating outside runners wider on the track. Had to shift outwards to find clear racing room near the 400 metres.

**STAR FORMULA** (D Montes de Oca) - Dictated outwards shortly after the start.

**SHES NO ANGEL** (B May) - Dictated wider shortly after the start and then had to be firmly restrained off the heels of HEY NOW losing ground as a result.

**KINDLING SPARK** (K Williams) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Held up in the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 150 metres.

**YAK SHA** (D Cooper) - Dictated wider crowding PERSONA when PATRAINE (C Campbell) shifted out near the 400 metres when looking for clear racing room. C Campbell was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

**PERSONA** (S Wynne) - Crowded when tiring passing the 150 metres when inside runners shifted out.

**ALMANAC** (L Sutherland) - Rider reported the gelding had been out-paced throughout the running and had been disappointing, adding she had suggested gear changes to the connections.

**D Tait** (ROYAL BERNE) - Spoken to advisedly for her whip use on a runner out of contention.

**Race 4** | **ENTAIN – NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1000m**

**TWOZIE** (B May) - Slow to begin. Tailed the field throughout and was not persevered with approaching the 200 metres to finish a distant last. Rider reported the gelding had raced greenly throughout.

**CAPITAL LISTING** (K Williams) - Lay inwards throughout the run home.

**Race 5** | **RANGIORA EQUINE SERVICES MAIDEN 1200m**

**JADE** (D Montes de Oca) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**LONE SPIRIT** (N Parmar) - Slow to begin.

**HIVARI** (T Jonker) - Slow to begin.

**THE CHROME NUN** (B Rogerson) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**COSMOS** (A Balloo) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**LA CERVEZA** (L Hemi) - When over racing improved onto heels getting its head up when being restrained. near the 900 metres.

**SHINTO** (T Moseley) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

**HOT COCO** (K Williams) - Dictated inwards over the concluding stages by MOTIONTIME (K Chowdhoo) which shifted in under pressure. K Chowdhoo was advised to exercise greater care.

**MOTIONTIME** (K Chowdhoo) - Shifted ground under pressure over the concluding stages.

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>GM ACCOUNTING &amp; CONSULTING 1200m</b>

**RED VIENNA** (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin. Held up through the early stages of the final straight having to be shifted outwards to obtain clear running approaching the 200 metres and then denied a marginal run until near the 100 metres when gaining clear racing room.

**MUMBO JUMBO** (B May) - Slow to begin.

**MISS BRITTANY** (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin.

**SUPERBLY WRITTEN** (N Parmar) - Began awkwardly losing some ground.

**AVITUS** (D Wilson) - Began awkwardly. Over raced through the early and middle stages.

**WESTWOOD** (D Tait) - Began awkwardly.

**TUMUCH** (R Beeharry) - Rider could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance.

**MAGNETO** (K Williams) - Rider dropped the near side rein passing the 100 metres which was regathered quickly.

**D Montes de Oca** (UNLEASHED) - Rider was spoken to advisedly in regard to using his whip above shoulder height.

**SUPERBLY WRITTEN** (N Parmar) - Collapsed post-race in the stalls area and was attended to by the on-course Veterinarian, with the horse ambulance deployed and the filly transported to the Canterbury Equine Veterinary Clinic for further assessment. Stewards will follow up with connections in coming days.

<b>Race 7</b>	<b>C S STEVENS MEMORIAL BANKS PENINSULA CUP 1100m</b>

**GOLDEN HARVEST** (K Chowdhoo) - Began awkwardly.

**FOLLOW YOUR DREAMS** (D Wilson) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**ZOULANDER** (K Williams) - Placed in restricted room having to steady shortly after the start.

**EPTIMUM** (L Sutherland) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

**OUR ECHO** (S Wynne) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Had some trouble gaining clear racing room early in the run home and was again held up passing the 200 metres having to shift ground near the 125 metres to find clear racing room.

**ROCKLAND** (L Hemi) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home.

**FIFITA** (T Comignaghi) - Rider could offer no excuse for the disappointing performance.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>TAB SOUTHERN ALPS GOLDEN TICKET 1400m</b>

**MYSTIC PARK** (T Comignaghi) - Began awkwardly making contact with **STOLEN DECREE**. Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home and had to shift outwards across heels passing the 300 metres to find clear racing room.

**STOLEN DECREE** (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin and then contacted. Rider could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance.

**JEWEL OF PATCH** (A Balloo) - Slow to begin.

**STREET FIGHTIN MAN** (L Hemi) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout.

**PHELAN THE POWER** (D Wilson) - Slow to begin.

**DIVINE SAVA** (B May) - Began awkwardly. Got its head up when being steadied passing the 1200 metres then over-reacted shifting out crowding **FELLINI** which had to be steadied and when doing so contacted **POWERFUL MOSS** which was briefly hampered and taken out across heels. Continued to race keenly through the early stages. Rider dropped his whip passing the 200 metres.

**POWERFUL MOSS** (D Montes de Oca) - Contacted and briefly hampered, being taken across heels near the 1200 metres and then raced keenly for a short distance.

**TRADITION** (D Cooper) - Ridden with urgency in the early stages and became awkwardly placed being trapped inside the heels of **INFLAMED** near the 1000 metres having to be steadied. D Cooper was shown a replay of this incident for educational purposes in the presence of the Apprentice Rider Mentor.

**STRIKE FORCE** (A Goindasamy) - Over raced through the early and middle stages.

**JUNE BUG** (D Tait) - Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

**N Parmar** - Following the running of this race N Parmar was stood down from his remaining ride in Race 9 by the on-course paramedic due to suffering from dehydration.

<b>Race 9</b>	<b>RURAL LIVESTOCK 2000m</b>

**IT'S BELSANTO** - **D Montes de Oca** replaced N Parmar. Slow to begin and tailed the field throughout, with the rider unable to offer any tangible excuse for the disappointing performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a high heart rate and slow recovery rate.

**MAYOR OF NORWOOD** (C Campbell) - Slow to begin.

**BAUBLE** (B Rogerson) - When being restrained to obtain cover in the early stages commenced to race keenly and continued to do so for the majority of the race.

**JAFFA** (D Tait) - Slow to begin. Over raced through the early and middle stages.

**AMAZON GODDESS** (T Jonker) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

**PONTARDAWE** (L Sutherland) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Rider dropped her whip near the 250 metres.

**PATSY LASS** (T Moseley) - Held up early in the run home.

**STAR BALLOT** (T Comignaghi) - Rider advised that the gelding had had a good run throughout however failed to finish the race off as expected.

**TELLING TALES** (L Callaway) - Rider reported he was disappointed with the gelding's effort and in his opinion TELLING TALES had not seen out the distance of today's race.

**L Hemi** (CHAPINTEEL) - Issued with a warning after she struck her mount 6 times prior to the 100 metre mark, with a further 5 strikes inside the 100 metres.

**LADY BANKSIDE** (B May) - Began awkwardly losing ground and was then ridden with urgency to recover.

**THE ROARING TIGER** (T Moseley) - Shifted outwards at the start crowding and dictating outside runners wider on the track.

**ROYCE ROCA** (S Wynne) - Dictated wider at the start contacting VAUDEVIRE and was then crowded losing ground.

**VAUDEVIRE** (L Sutherland) - Contacted and dictated wider at the start losing ground.

**HEREIGOAGAIN** (G Jogoo) - Began awkwardly. Steadied passing the 50 metres when SPROCKET ROCKET (R Mudhoo) shifted inwards under pressure. R Mudhoo was advised to exercise greater care.

**LADYSWEY** (D Wilson) - Jumped away very awkwardly losing ground.

**IT'S THE VIBE** (D Montes de Oca) - Slow to begin. Raced wide from the 1000 metres.

**COLOSSAL** (K Bakker) - Raced wide for the majority of the race.

**BUGATTI** (D Cooper) - When asked to comment on performance, the rider advised he had been obliged to get back from a wide draw which had been detrimental to his chances.
