RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 STALLION TENDER NOW OPEN MAIDEN 2200m

RACCOURCI (Y Atchamah) - Began awkwardly making contact with PINX.

PINX (T Jonker) - Contacted at the start and forced inwards.

JADE (D Tait) - Obliged to race wide in the early stages before settling outside the leader. Under pressure in the run home finishing a distant last.

VERRY ROYAL (A Goindasamy) - Held up rounding the bend near the 450 metres.

T Jonker (PINX) - Admitted a charge in that she struck her mount PINX 9 times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of T Jonker's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 10 August until the conclusion of racing on Friday 23 August, 6 national riding days.

Race 2 ELMWOOD TRADING CO MAIDEN 1200m

PRETENDING (L Allpress) - Slow to begin then ridden with urgency to lead shortly after the start. Broke down and fell to the track when free of interference after the race, dislodging the rider. The on-course Veterinarian and horse ambulance were immediately deployed, with the filly found to have suffered a catastrophic injury to the right foreleg and was humanely euthanised. L Allpress was attended to by St John Paramedics and transferred to hospital for further evaluation. Rider replacements were made as per above Summary.

HIGH EXPECTATIONS (R Jaun) - Over raced in the early stages having to be restrained by its rider.

LEAR JET (B May) - Obliged to race three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

NOT STRAIGHT LACED (L Sutherland) - Held up early in the run home only gaining clear racing room passing the 300 metres.

INSPIRATION (Y Atchamah) - Briefly held up passing the 450 metres.

Race 3 3F AT WEST FITZROY APARTMENTS MAIDEN 1600m

The start of this race was delayed approximately 13 minutes due to the on-course ambulance being required to assist with the transport of L Allpress to hospital for observation.

IFF I GET PAAID (A Balloo) - Slow to begin.

CLYDE BARROW (D Cooper) - Slow to begin and then raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

BLUE BAY (A Najib) - Slow to begin.

PATCH (R Jaun) - Steadied off heels passing the 1000 metres. Held up passing the 400 metres having to shift outwards to find clear running.

BRUSSET (K Williams) - Rider could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance.

Following the running of this race Apprentice **R Jaun** advised Stewards he was feeling unwell and was stood down from his one remaining ride in Race 10. R Jaun was advised that a medical clearance is required prior to racing next.

Race 4 BETAVET MAIDEN 1400m

The start of this race was rescheduled to 1:19pm due to the delay in the previous race.

MANZAPPEAL (D Tait) - Very slow to begin losing ground. Over raced getting its head up on a number of occasions passing the 1000 metres, with the rider reporting the gelding had been a difficult ride throughout.

HEADING TO NOOSA (T Moseley) - Bounded on jumping shifting in hampering inside runner. Had some trouble obtaining clear racing early in the run home.

LONE SPIRIT (W Kennedy) - Contacted and crowded at the start.

CALLMEGINGER (Y Atchamah) - Slow to begin.

ROYAL BERNE (J Chung) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

ROYAL TSARINA (C Barnes) - Over raced in the early stages.

MOON ROCKET (C Grylls) - Held up from the 450 metres, gaining clear racing room passing the 300 metres.

Race 5 NAUTICAL INSURANCE GRAND NATIONAL AMATEUR CHAMPS 2200m

KING OF THE DANCE (M Dunne) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout.

HAYATE (C McKee) - Slow to begin.

JETHRO (C Rennie) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover through the early stages.

REGGIE RULER (R Rae) - Slow to begin.

BAD FLAMINGO (M Northcott) - Improved wide from the 550 metres.

Race 6 HAASE MARSHALL DRAINAGE OPEN HANDICAP 2200m

STEVE AUSTIN (D Tait) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced three wide without cover rounding the first bend.

TOMYTURBO (W Kennedy) - Bounded on jumping losing ground. Lay out rounding the final bend having to be continually straightened by its rider.

Race 7 BREAKFREE ON CASHEL 1400m

AMATHUSIA (A Balloo) - Slow to begin then restrained to obtain cover shortly after the start.

PEGAU (Y Atchamah) - Began awkwardly skying its head.

BRACERO (L Sutherland) - Obliged to race three wide without cover in the early stages.

GIANNIS (W Kennedy) - Over raced getting its head up on a number of occasions near the 1000 metres. When asked to comment on the performance of this favoured runner, rider could offer no tangible excuse and had been disappointed with the performance.

JUSTANACE (L Callaway) - Over raced having to be restrained off heels passing the 1000 metres and continued to race keenly through the middle stages.

ASTERIAL (T Newman) - When asked to comment on the performance of this runner which finished a distant last, rider advised in her opinion the mare had not been suited to racing on the synthetic track.

Race 8 RIPPLE CREEK EQUINE POLYTRACK \$100,000 1200m

K Mudhoo (MORE THAN WORDS) - Admitted a charge in that he was unable to make the contracted weight for MORE THAN WORDS and was replaced by S Wynne. K Mudhoo was fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule.

STRIKE FORCE (L Callaway) - Very slow to load delaying the start. Connections were advised that a barrier manners warning would be placed against the gelding's record. Slow away losing ground. Crowded and buffeted being dictated inwards passing the 1000 metres

MAGNETO (J Doyle) - Shifted out at the start crowding MOTIONTIME.

MOTIONTIME (L Sutherland) - Crowded at the start.

KANA (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly shifting inwards contacting MUMBO JUMBO and DELPHILLIUS.

MUMBO JUMBO (B May) - Hampered on jumping when runners either side shifted ground and as a result lost ground.

DELPHILLIUS (K Bakker) - Contacted at the start. Commenced to race fiercely when being restrained passing the 1100 metres becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of SORCHA and shifting in abruptly despite the efforts of the rider making firm contact with STRIKE FORCE which was taken in onto LINCOLN'S KRUZ and THATS CHARMING. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. After interviewing riders and viewing replays, Stewards were of the opinion the racing manners of DELPHILLIUS had been the major contributor to this incident.

SHOWBASTIAN COE (J Chung) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Rider could offer no excuse for the disappointing performance.

THATS CHARMING (T Moseley) - Crowded and buffeted and forced into the running rail passing the 1000 metres losing ground as a result.

LINCOLN'S KRUZ (J Riddell) - Crowded and buffeted passing the 1000 metres.

MORE THAN WORDS (S Wynne) - Got its head up in the early stages when being restrained to take cover. Had to change ground passing the 300 metres to find clear racing room.

MISS NICO BELLE (C Barnes) - Held up rounding the home bend gaining clear racing room inside the final 250 metres.

SORCHA (C Grylls) - Rider could offer no excuse for the disappointing performance.

ZOULANDER (K Williams) - Briefly steadied passing the 400 metres when KANA (W Kennedy) shifted out looking for clear racing room. W Kennedy was advised to exercise greater care.

Following the running of this race **K Mudhoo** was attended to by St John Paramedics and found to be suffering from dehydration and was stood down from his remaining ride in Race 10.

Race 9 HOTELIERS CHALLENGE 1200m

ANGELS WINGS (A Goindasamy) - Began awkwardly and was further hampered losing ground when RED VIENNA shifted in at the start.

HE'S SO FINE (Y Atchamah) - Began awkwardly.

ALMINETTE (C Grylls) - Crowded at the start when VOICE OVER (D Cooper) shifted in. D Cooper was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

ANALYST (T Newman) - Crowded and buffeted at the start losing ground, resulting in that runner then being restrained and shifting inwards to obtain cover.

BERBIZIER (C Barnes) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LA CERVEZA (J Doyle) - Got its head up when being steadied and making the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres.

VOICE OVER (D Cooper) - Held up early in the run home having to shift inwards near the 300 metres to find clear racing room.

HOT COCO (K Williams) - Rider expressed disappointment with today's effort. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 10 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE 1600m

TIME IS KING (C Grylls) - Declared a late scratching at the barriers on Veterinary advice after rearing in the gates and getting its leg up over the stall. Connections were advised that a barrier manners warning would be placed on the gelding's record.

HEY HEY HEY (J Chung) - Slow to begin.

ANNELIESE (W Kennedy) - Restrained from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

FAYTINA (K Bakker) - Raced wide without cover through the early to middle stages.

SPROCKET ROCKET (D Cooper) - Raced wide without cover from the 1100 metres. Inclined to shift ground inwards over the concluding stages when under pressure.
