Race 8 BOB & COLLEEN DONALDSON MEMORIAL 1600m

OUTER FOCUS (R Elliot) – Trainer A Sharrock reported to Stewards upon return to the stable OUTER FOCUS underwent farrier attention where the off-hind plate was removed which revealed slight bruising to the sole. A Sharrock further advised it is his intention to continue on with the gelding's current preparation once the bruising subsides and may look to nominate at the New Plymouth Raceway meeting on 17 August.

Race 2 GARTSHORE CONSTRUCTION 1400m

KEY LARGO (J Nishizuka) – Trainer P Gerard reported to Stewards she was satisfied with the post-race condition of KEY LARGO and it is her intention to carry on with the gelding's current preparation.

Race 3 CONTRIBUTER STANDING AT MAPPERLEY STUD 1400m

SILVER JAVELIN (S Mxothwa) – Co-trainer A Scott advised Stewards the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of the mare, and it is their intention to carry on with SILVER JAVELIN'S current preparation, where they may look to nominate her for the Waikato TR meeting at Te Rapa on 10 August.

RACE COMMENTS**Race 1 CAMBRIDGE EQUINE HOSPITAL MAIDEN 1550**

FALCON WARRIOR (C Barnes) – Slow to begin.

JON WARRIOR (L Douglas) - Began awkwardly. Over-raced through the early and middle stages. Improved onto heels having to be steadied near the 1100 metres.

THE YES GIRL (M Cartwright) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the mare never travelled throughout the running.

ASPARK PARK (W Kennedy) – Slow to begin. Raced keenly through the early stages.

LAGOBEE (N Hailey) – Raced keenly through the early stages making contact with the running rail near the 1300 metres.

Race 2 WAIPA EARTHWORKS 1550

LORD WEYBURN (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early stages. Lay inwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

GELDOF (W Kennedy) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Commenced to race ungenerously for a distance near the 1300 metres.

MILLENNIUM DAWN (M Hashizume) - Lay outwards rounding the final bend.

PONTE VECCHIO (M Cartwright) - Rider dropped his right rein near the 100 metres.

LEMON CURD (K Myers) – When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the mare may be feeling the effects of recent racing.

Race 3 FORSMAN RACING MAIDEN 1300

WAINUI BAY (B Jacobson) - Became fractious in the barriers. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the mare's barrier manners. Briefly steadied when improving onto heels near the 1000 metres.

OUR BLUE BELLE (K Myers) – Restrained at the start to obtain cover from the outside barrier.

ALICANTE (J Doyle) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from a wide barrier.

OBAN (J Fawcett) – Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

SUPER DAILO (R Elliot) – Over-raced through the early and middle stages. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay inwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

FILIUS (V Colgan) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding would derive benefit from today's experience.

Race 4 | **HORSE TRANSPORT LTD MAIDEN 970**

BOLSTER (J Doyle) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Over-raced through the middle stages having to be heavily restrained off heels near the 600 metres.

MAGIC TYCOON (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly. Rider reported that the gelding hung outwards throughout.

VIGOR HAPPINESS (V Colgan) – Over-raced through the early stages. Lay outwards rounding the final bend and continued to do so when placed under pressure in the final straight.

BALLON D'OR (C Grylls) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

TOMOE GOZEN (B Rogerson) - Lay outwards rounding the final bend and continued to do so when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Race 5 | **MARSH RACING 970**

FELIX FAURE (A Lawson-Carroll) – Began awkwardly.

JOSHUA BROWN (L Satherley) - Crowded at the start losing ground. Raced wide without cover throughout.

TOA HAKA (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly.

SEAMSEW (V Colgan) – Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Held up for clear running until passing the 200 metres.

MARCELLA (K Myers) - Improved onto heels having to be steadied near the 700 metres.

MARKET PLACE (T Moodley) – Lay outwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Race 6 | **NEW ZEALAND HORSE AMBULANCE TRUST 2000**

BIEDERMEIER (J Doyle) - Slow to begin.

HOARD THE BOURBON (C Grylls) – Crowded at the start. Had to be steadied off the heels of POSTER BOY which was weakening approaching the 700 metres. Lay outwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

ISLEBEFINE (W Kennedy) - Crowded at the start.

FREE SPIRIT (T Mitchell) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

POSTER BOY (K Myers) - Commenced to give ground near the 700 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have suffered cardiac arrhythmia. Trainer R Manning was advised that POSTER BOY will not be permitted to start in any race or trial until a veterinary certificate declaring the horse free of any cardiac arrhythmia following a gallop of at least 1000 metres.

UP 'N' GONE (T Melvin) – Lay outwards rounding the final bend.

SPECTRIER (V Colgan) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing.

ROCKET LAD (T Moodley) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from a wide barrier.

JIMMY DEAN (C Barnes) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from the outside barrier.

OPAWA JACK (W Kennedy) – Lay outwards rounding the final bend and continued to do so in the final straight. Rider reported that the gelding had hung outwards throughout.
