Race 6 CAMPBELL INFRASTRUCTURE 2200m

DANZINO (J Doyle) – Trainer Mr. S Phelan reported to Stewards, that on Monday 29 July, DANZINO, underwent a veterinarian examination and a chiropractor examination with no abnormalities being detected. S Phelan further advised the gelding had a few days of light work and it is his intention to continue on with DANZINO'S current preparation.

INNOCENT VICTIM (J Fawcett) – Trainer Mr. S Cole reported to Stewards, that on Tuesday 30 July, INNOCENT VICTIM, underwent a veterinarian examination which included x-rays with results showing a bone chip to the knee of the right foreleg. Surgery to remove the bone chip was performed on Wednesday 31 July. S Cole further advised INNOCENT VICTIM will be sent to spell to recover.

RACE COMMENTS**Race 1 THE HOMESTEAD SPORTS BAR & BISTRO 1100m**

The start of Race 1 was delayed approximately 3 minutes due to SIMSALA initially refusing to parade to the start.

HORRIE (J Fawcett) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced in restricted room approaching the 200 metres. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had raced greenly throughout and in her opinion would derive benefit out of today's performance.

SIMSALA (A Lawson-Carroll) - Connections were advised that a warning would be placed on the filly's pre-race manners after it proved difficult to mount. Slow to begin.

I'M ALL IN (S Spratt) - Reared at the start losing ground.

CHICAGO JACK (T Moodley) - Over-raced through the early stages when being restrained. Improved into restricted room having to steady near the 500 metres. Held up until near the 300 metres.

THE PEN IS MIGHTY (M Sanson) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

MIDNIGHT EDITION (M Hashizume) - Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly, shifting outwards. Lay outwards rounding the final bend and continued to do so when placed under pressure in the straight.

T Moodley (CHICAGO JACK) - Admitted a charge after striking his mount once in the vicinity of the head near the 100 metres. After hearing submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$750.

Race 2 GREG THORP BLASTING & KERIKERI TILE DIRECT 1300m

LA RUCHE (A Lawson-Carroll) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from the outside barriers.

ZLATNA (J Fawcett) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from a wide barrier.

MAHOE (T Mitchell) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

VANTAANA (M Sanson) - Improved on to heels having to be steadied passing the 1000 metres, then continued to race ungenerously for a distance making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight. Rider reported that the mare had lay inwards throughout the race.

NEW YORK JAZZ (J Nishizuka) - Forced wider near the 800 metres when VANTAANA shifted outwards.

YARI (B Rogerson) - Lay outwards rounding the final bend then shifted outwards making contact with QUARTZ QUEEN with both runners becoming unbalanced and continued to lay outwards for the remainder of the race, making contact with QUARTZ QUEEN on several occasions passing the 200 metres.

QUARTZ QUEEN (M Hashizume) - Contacted and unbalanced passing the 400 metres, then came together with YARI passing the 200 metres on several occasions, being inclined to lay inwards after contact had been made.

Race 3 ALIBABA'S FLYING CARPETS STRETCH & TRIM 2100m

CIMARRON (T Newman) - Slow to begin.

FLY MY WEY (J Fawcett) - Raced keenly through the early stages.

LEITRIM LAD (A Lawson-Carroll) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

MALFY ROSA (M Hashizume) - Hampered near the 300 metres when ENCHANTED ELLE shifted outwards.

ENCHANTED ELLE (R Goyaram) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until shifting outwards near the 300 metres forcing MALFY ROSA wider. R Goyaram was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

CHEVRON (T Moodley) - Briefly raced in restricted room to the inside of BOSCH, which was laying inwards near the 200 metres.

BOSCH (S Spratt) - Lay inwards when placed under pressure near the 200 metres.

Race 4 | **TRUWELD ENGINEERING 1600m**

GRACE 'N' GLORY (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow to begin. Improved on to heels over the concluding stages, having to be steadied.

NO AGENDA NIGEL (M Sanson) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SULABELLA (S Spratt) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages when being restrained.

AFTER PARTY (R Goyaram) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

Track Downgraded to Heavy 8 retrospective to Race 4.

Race 5 | **KAINUI PACK & COOL MAIDEN 1600m**

FOR HONOR (S Mxothwa) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

KERRYANNA (T Mitchell) - Improved on to heels having to be steadied approaching the 1400 metres.

LIGHT SLEEPA (B Rogerson) - Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1400 metres. Commenced to give ground from near the 1000 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality. Connections were advised that the mare would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

COMPLIMENTERRY (M Sanson) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Improved on to heels having to be firmly restrained near the 1200 metres.

Race 6 | **AOTEA ELECTRIC IN WAIPAPA MAIDEN 1200m**

BALLS OF FIRE (J Nishizuka) - Reared at the start losing ground. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

PROPAGANDA (T Moodley) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

FAMILY STRENGTH (R Goyaram) - Slow to begin.

WHAT SHE WANTS (T Newman) - Slow to begin.

Race 7 | **ALIBABA'S FLYING CARPETS KERIKERI CUP 1100m**

PIPPY (M Hashizume) - Slow to begin.

BEEBEEP (R Goyaram) - Began awkwardly.

MASTER FAY (A Lawson-Carroll) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover. Shifted inwards slightly near the 50 metres simultaneously as CROCETTI shifted outwards, brushing with that runner.

CROCETTI (T Moodley) - Lay outwards when placed under pressure in the final straight, shifting outwards near the 50 metres simultaneously as MASTER FAY shifted inwards slightly, brushing with that runner.

Connections of the 2nd placed MASTER FAY viewed Stewards' footage before electing not to proceed with a protest.

Race 8

17 AUG-CAMBRIDGE STUD NORTHLAND BREEDERS' STAKES 2100m

SKAI JACKI (M Sanson) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

MISCHIEF MANAGED (A Lawson-Carroll) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from the outside barrier.

TURNMEON (N Hailey) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from a wide barrier.

CHASE 'N' GOLD (J Allen) - Slow to begin. Lay inwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

HEART OF ALLADIN (J Fawcett) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

BRUCEY LEE (B Rogerson) - Improved on to heels having to steady near the 1100 metres.

NO PLAN BE (S Spratt) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare failed to handle today's Heavy track conditions.
