DIVINE STORY (A Goindasamy) - Passing the 1250 metres had to shift outwards when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of LUCY'S MAGIC and in doing so shifted outwards forcing CALLMEGINGER outwards into the line of PIERROGRINE which had to be steadied to avoid heels. Checked when crowded approaching the 700 metres.

PIERROGRINE (Y Atchamah) - Had to be steadied away from heels near the 1200 metres.

LEAR JET (K Bakker) - Was unable to obtain clear running throughout the final straight.

A Balloo (CALLMEGINGER) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount CALLMEGINGER to shift inwards approaching the 700 metres when not sufficiently clear of DIVINE STORY which was checked. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of A Balloo's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 14 September until the conclusion of racing on Sunday 22 September, 5 national riding days.

Race 2 CLEAN UP CANTERBURY MAIDEN 1600m

CHRISTABELLA (M Hashizume) - Delayed the start after being reluctant to load. Hung inwards throughout the running. Trainer advised Stewards the mare is now retired as a racing proposition.

EL FUEGO (K Mudhoo) - Slow away.

PATCH (R Jaun) - Jumped away awkwardly getting its head up then being restrained to the rear.

MAP OF JAPAN (B Murray) - Raced in restricted room passing the 500 metres when CHRISTABELLA lay inwards. Badly held up behind the weakening CHRISTABELLA early in the straight and did not obtain clear running until the 200 metres.

Race 3ENTAIN/NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES 1600mPEGAU (Y Atchamah) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground. Held up early in the final straight.

EPILOGUE (K Mudhoo) - Slow away. Crowded between BELLA ROSE and IDEAL DREAMS passing the 250 metres when both those runners shifted ground marginally.

BELLA ROSE (T Comignaghi) - Underwent a post-race veterinary examination after the rider advised that the mare had been making abnormal breathing noises, which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 4 SPEIGHT'S SUMMIT ULTRA ON TAP 1400m

PONZI PONY (M Hashizume) - Jumped away awkwardly and got back.

RED VIENNA (K Mudhoo) - Jumped away awkwardly and got back.

FIREGLOW (L Callaway) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Placed in restricted room passing the 1000 metres when PARAGON (S Wynne) improved forward at this point. S Wynne was advised to exercise greater care.

CRUISE (Y Atchamah) - Raced in restricted room for a short distance passing the 1000 metres having to be briefly steadied.

MOON ROCKET (T Comignaghi) - Held up entering the final straight gaining clear racing room passing the 250 metres.

IN AWE (D Cooper) - Held up in the run home when attempting to take a very marginal run to the inside of TOUGH TIME. D Cooper was shown a replay of his ride in the home straight in the presence of the apprentice riding mentor for educational purposes.

ROBDONTESS (J Doyle) - Briefly steadied to avoid the heels of MOON ROCKET when that runner in turn became awkwardly placed on the heels of HEY NOW passing the 200 metres.

Race 5 CHRISTCHURCH CASINO 29TH SOUTH ISLAND AWARDS 2200m

MADISON ROSE (D Tait) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact with the side of its barrier stall losing ground.

RAARDY RAAR (A Balloo) - Slow away.

HEY MICKEY (T Comignaghi) - Over raced in the early stages getting its head up. Raced three wide without cover through the middle stages.

WAIHORA MIST (J Doyle) - Held up rounding the final bend and in the run home.

COSMETIC VIRTUE (D Cooper) - Held up entering the final straight and continued to have difficulty finding clear running throughout the run home.

BAD FLAMINGO (K Wiliams) - Under pressure rounding the home turn and gave ground from the 400 metres and was not persevered with over the concluding stages. BAD FLAMINGO underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which found the gelding to have suffered an episode of Epistaxis. BAD FLAMINGO shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any race or trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian. Connections advised they would be reassessing the racing future of BAD FLAMINGO.

Race 6 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE 1200m

MISS SAILOR (D Tait) – Fractious in its stall prior to the start and as the gates opened reared dislodging its rider who was uninjured in this incident. Connections were advised that MISS SAILOR is required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next.

PUZZLE SOLVED (L Hemi) - Slow away.

MUMBO JUMBO (B May) - Slow away. Rider could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance.

LA CERVEZA (R Jaun) - Raced keenly in the early stages and wide throughout. Briefly raced in restricted room near the 250 metres when GIANNIS (K Williams) shifted in under pressure. K Williams was advised to exercise greater care.

BLINK OF AN EYE (J Doyle) - Became awkwardly placed on heels near the 250 metres having to shift outwards.
