CAPTAINS RUN (N Downs) - Trainer D O'Leary reported to Stewards upon return to the stables, CAPTAINS RUN received farrier attention to the right hind foot and given anti-inflammatory medication. D O'Leary further advised the gelding has now been sent for a spell.

Race 1	TAUPO VET CENTRE MAIDEN 1800
<p>MOOD PAINTER (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly shifting outwards.</p> <p>ASPARK PARK (W Kennedy) - Hampered shortly after the start. Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages when being steadied. Lay out when placed under pressure near the 200 metres having to be corrected by its rider.</p> <p>MISS BEE (B Rogerson) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.</p> <p>OVERTRICK (J Doyle) - Crowded shortly after the start then clipped a heel and blundered, losing ground. Improved onto heels having to be steadied near the 800 metres.</p> <p>SATOMI (C Grylls) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>LAE ZEE (C Butler) - Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages. Improved onto heels approaching the 800 metres shifting outwards abruptly then raced wide without cover for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>BUSTER SHAW (J Fawcett) - Raced wide throughout. Lay inwards entering the final straight.</p> <p>TIME TRAVELLER (M Hashizume) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding had failed to respond when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>T Newman (OVERTRICK) - Issued with a Minor Infringement and fined \$200 after breaking a riding engagement.</p>	
Race 2	ENTAIN/NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN 1400
<p>FLUTTERBELLE (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>AVORIAZ (M Hashizume) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>SWEET AND SASSY (J Nishizuka) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>ASTARTE (S Spratt) – Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>D Sweeney (BONNIE GEM) - Issued with a Minor Infringement and fined \$50 after presenting BONNIE GEM to race with the incorrect saddlecloth.</p> <p>A Request for a Ruling was filed with the Adjudicator under the provisions of [Rule 632(1)] as to whether FLUTTERBELLE had been denied a fair start. After viewing relevant film footage and hearing submissions the Adjudicator found that although FLUTTERBELLE had become fractious and attempted to rear, a barrier attendant still had hold of the rein when the start was effected and ruled that FLUTTERBELLE be declared a non-starter.</p>	
Race 3	INGLIS READY2RACE SALE 15th OCT 2024 1400
<p>MI AMIGO (T Newman) - Slow to begin. Rider reported that the gelding had felt lame. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to be mildly lame in the right foreleg. Trainer S Ralph was advised the gelding must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next along with a veterinary clearance being required.</p> <p>APACHE BOY (A Lawson-Carroll) - Had to be steadied when racing in restricted room to the inside of PARISIAN passing the 200 metres.</p>	

BETABEQUIK (W Kennedy) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding would benefit with wetter track conditions.

Race 4 | **FORSMAN RACING MAIDEN 1300**

MAGNA MEMORY (N Hailey) – Slow to begin. N Hailey was spoken to advisedly in the presence of N Harris for the use of his whip on a runner out of contention.

SUBIACO (S Spratt) – Slow to begin.

LISTENING (W Kennedy) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the filly lay inwards throughout and had failed to respond when placed under pressure.

HEZA SHARP ONE (W Pinn) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Had to be steadied approaching the 200 metres when racing to the outside of **SMART LOVE** (M Cartwright) which lay outwards when placed under pressure. M Cartwright was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

BRILLIANT BATTLE (L Satherley) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages when leading.

SMART LOVE (M Cartwright) - Rider reported that the filly raced greenly on debut when placed under pressure near the 200 metres.

Race 5 | **NZB MEGA MAIDEN SERIES MAIDEN 1200**

MISTA STITCH (N Hailey) - Slow to begin.

LOVE SYMBOL (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly.

SETHITO (M Cartwright) - Began awkwardly then hampered shortly after the start. Hampered losing ground near the 700 metres. Lay outwards when placed under pressure over the concluding stages.

SABIK (D Mansour) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Had to be steadied approaching the 200 metres when racing to the outside of **SETHITO** (M Cartwright) which shifted outwards when placed under pressure. M Cartwright was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground. Steadied off heels over the concluding stages.

TRISTAR (C Grylls) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover from a wide barrier.

EASTANDWEST (J Doyle) - Made the bend awkwardly and shifted outwards near the 700 metres hampering **SETHITO** then continued to lay out rounding the final bend.

Race 6 | **CHRIS JOLLY OUTDOORS MAIDEN 1200**

SOUGHT AFTER (M Hashizume) - Slow to begin. Hampered passing the 800 metres.

HAUGHTY (R Elliot) – Raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 750 metres. Held up rounding the final bend.

GIOIA MAGICA (S Spratt) – Raced keenly through the middle stages having to be steadied off the heels of **ROCKY BALBOA** (K Myers) which shifted inwards when not fully clear passing the 800 metres. K Myers was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground. As a result, **GIOIA MAGICA** then shifted inwards placing **PICCULU** in restricted room which in turn was steadied away from heels hampering **BALLON D’OR** and **SOUGHT AFTER**.

PICCULU (J Nishizuka) - Placed in restricted room passing the 800 metres.

BALLON D'OR (C Grylls) - Hampered passing the 800 metres.

ON THE TOWN (J Doyle) - Held up until approaching the 100 metres.

Race 7

THE BELLE FAMILY 1100

MERLOTTI (V Colgan) – Slow to begin.

POUKAWA (C Grylls) - Slow to begin.

EGYPTIAN QUEEN (N Hailey) - Began awkwardly. Raced in restricted room for a distance entering the final straight. Raced in restricted room to the inside of STRANGE LOVE passing the 200 metres.

QUARTZ QUEEN (A Lawson-Carroll) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages having to be steadied off heels near the 700 metres.

STRANGE LOVE (S Spratt) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

VALLARTA (W Kennedy) – Lay outwards when placed under pressure in the final straight having to be corrected by its rider.

Race 8

YOU BID YOU BUY (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up for the majority of the final straight.

VESPHIRE (K Myers) - Slow to begin.

SISTER CYNANE (M Hashizume) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover from a wide barrier.

PIECES OF EIGHT (V Colgan) – Commenced to buck shortly after the start settling at the rear of the field. Connections were advised that the filly would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

CATOCA (S Spratt) - Raced keenly through the middle stages.

Race 9

DPA CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS 1800

FINAL IMPACT (C Grylls) - Slow to begin.

BARCELONA (M Sanson) - Made the first bend awkwardly running wide.

AFTER PARTY (S Spratt) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

IRISH MISS (C Barnes) – Raced keenly through the early stages. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the mare had failed to respond when placed under pressure in the final straight.

KORO'S PRINCESS (L Kauri) - Raced keenly through the middle stages. Improved onto heels having to be steadied near the 700 metres.

ROSINA (J Doyle) - Returned to the enclosure with blood in the left nostril. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a laceration inside the left nostril.
