**DIABLO BLANCO (A Goindasamy)** – Trainer Mr. R Didham reported to Stewards, that upon return to the stable the filly was examined by the stable veterinarian, which confirmed DIABLO BLANCO'S heart rate had returned as normal, and the filly underwent an endoscopic examination and blood tests with no abnormalities being detected. R Didham further advised it is his intention to carry on with the filly's current preparation and may look to nominate DIABLO BLANCO for the Ashburton RC meeting on 12 October.

#### **RACE COMMENTS**

# Race 1 THOMAS GREEN (1600m)

**VAGUE** (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**LOCHNABERRY** (B Rogerson) - Slow to begin.

**SACRED DREAM** (R Muniandy) - Over-raced through the middle stages.

### Race 2 ADVANCE AGRICULTURE MAIDEN (1400m)

**HAAST RULER** (K Bakker) - Rider was dislodged in the birdcage and after being checked by the on-course Paramedics K Bakker was stood down for the remainder of the day. HAAST RULER was subsequently declared a late scratching at 12.41pm. Miss Bakker was advised a Medical Clearance would be required prior to her riding next.

**TIPSY TART** (B Rogerson) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after blood was found to be present in its mouth around at the start area and was cleared to race. Began awkwardly losing ground.

**BEAVER FEVER** (K Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**LOOSE KNICKERS** (T Moseley) - Slow to begin. Blundered passing the 500 metres.

**HASSTOBEREEL** (A Goindasamy) - Over-raced in the early-stages and got its head up when being steadied to take a trailing position near the 1000 metres. Rider reported the gelding had held its breath during the running.

**MY GIRL CANDY** (S Wynne) - When asked to comment on the performance rider advised that the mare had failed to see out the distance of today's race.

Following Race 2 the track conditions were upgraded to Soft 5.

### Race 3 GORE ELITE PLUMBING (1400m)

Trainer **J Dalton** was fined \$50 under the Minor Infringement Schedule after presenting MONTE KHAN with the incorrect saddle cloth number.

**MONTE KHAN** (S Wynne) - After initially being slow to begin was taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover.

**BLEAKHOUSE BURTIE** (K Mudhoo – Raced three wide without cover in the early stages. Lay in throughout the run home and could not be ridden to full advantage.

**ANAFTERNOONDELIGHT** (T Ladouceur) - Over-raced in the early stages and near the 1000 metres had to be restrained off the heels of MORNING STAR.

SUNSET EXPRESS (R Jaun) - Raced three wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

**MORNING STAR** (K Williams) - Steadied passing the 1000 metres to take a trailing position. When asked to comment on the performance of the favoured runner rider advised she felt the back legs had been galloped on during the running with this having been detrimental to the horse's chances. A post-race veterinary examination confirmed the mare to have superficial abrasions on the right hind leg consistent with having been galloped on.

**PEGAU** (B May) - When asked to comment on the performance rider advised that the mare had been taken on while leading through the early to middle stages which had been detrimental to the horse's chances.

**STOP YELLING** (L Callaway) - When asked to comment on the seemingly improved performance rider advised that the gelding had benefitted from the drop back in class of today's race and the better track conditions.

### Race 4 JJ'S GORE (1400m)

**SEVEN TWENTY** (B May) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after blood was found to be present in its mouth around at the start area and was cleared to race.

BALZANO (T Moseley) - Shifted out at the start making contact with WHERE'S WALLY.

**SESTINA** (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly losing ground. When asked to comment on the performance rider advised that the mare had worked hard during the running and would take natural benefit from its first run back from a spell.

THREE NINETY (Y Atchamah) - Slow to begin.

**WHERE'S WALLY** (K Williams) - Contacted on jumping. Over-raced in the early stages getting its head up when being restrained passing the 1200 metres and then continued to over-race for a distance. Steadled passing the 300 metres when SEVEN TWENTY shifted out looking for clear racing room.

**COCKAHOOP** (B Rogerson) - Over-raced through the early to middle stages.

**INDUSTRIALIST** (R Muniandy) - Raced wide for the majority of the event.

**JIMMY FIVE** (C Campbell) - Held up for clear running rounding the final bend and early in the home straight until passing the 200 metres.

**B May** (SEVEN TWENTY) - Issued with a warning after allowing his mount SEVEN TWENTY to shift ground outwards passing the 300 metres crowding WHERE'S WALLY which had to be steadied.

# Race 5 HOKONUI SUSUKI MAIDEN (1200m)

**TRALEE BAY** (S Wynne) - Bounded at the start losing ground.

**ICE COLD GOLD** (D Tait) - Slow to begin. Raced wide through the early stages before improving forward to lead near the 700 metres.

**THE ARCHITECT** (K Mudhoo) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

BEAUJOLAIS (B May) - Taken back from a wide draw shortly after the start.

**POMALO** (R Jaun) - Failed to hit out in the early stages becoming detached from the body of the field. When questioned regarding this the rider advised that the mare had knuckled shortly after the start and attempted to buck for several strides losing ground. Mr Jaun added that when pulling up he felt something to be amiss with the mare. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormality. Connections also advised that the mare may not have been comfortable in today's firmer track conditions.

**DEGIORGIO** (K Williams) - Raced wide for the majority of the event with the rider reporting the gelding had raced greenly throughout.

BONSAI BOB (B Rogerson) - Steadied when improving quickly on to heels near the 600 metres.

**ENTERPRISE** (R Muniandy) - Rider was reminded of his obligations to ensure he rides his mounts out fully to the finish line when circumstances permit.

### Race 6 GRANT FARMING PARTNERSHIP (1200m)

**GAME DUKE** (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up for several strides passing the 250 metres.

**HAZEL MAY** (B Rogerson) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start. Lay out rounding the final bend shifting wider on the track and was not persevered with in the home straight when laying outwards badly. When asked to comment on the performance rider advised that the mare had hung outwards from the 500 metres and proved a very difficult steer. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormality. Connections were advised the mare must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next. Trainer L Vaughan reported she would be making gear alterations prior to trialling or racing.

**RADIANT ROSIE** (B May) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

#### Race 7 HOWL AT THE MOON (1200m)

MIDNIGHT RUNNER (R Muniandy) - Slow to begin.

HENRY HUBBER (D Tait) - Slow to begin.

**LOUIE LOUIE** (A Goindasamy) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start. Lay out rounding the final bend.

MISS HARLEY QUINN (Y Atchamah) - Raced three wide without cover through the early stages.

**MIDNIGHT JANE** (B Rogerson) - Over-raced for a distance passing the 900 metres and again had to be steadied when over-racing passing the 650 metres.

# Race 8 AB LIME (2100m)

**VINO VALENTINO** (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin.

TAKE THE DEEL (S Wynne) - Slow to begin.

CHASE 'N' GOLD (B Rogerson) - Slow to begin.

**CLAIRE'S PAL** (L Callaway) - Had to be steadied away from heels in the early stages when over-racing and making the bend near the 1700 metres awkwardly, then continued to over-race for a distance.

**HE'S TUNZA GRUNT** (R Muniandy) - Raced wide through the early stages before improving forward to sit outside the leader passing the 1400 metres.

**CASTLEBRAE** (K Mudhoo) - Under pressure passing the 500 metres and gave ground with the rider reporting the gelding may be better suited to tracks with more moisture content. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormality.

**KOYAMA** (D Tait) - Held up briefly passing the 200 metres having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear racing room.

HIDALGO (Y Atchamah) - Held up for a marginal run passing the 50 metres having to be restrained off heels.

**TAKE THAT** (K Williams) - When asked to comment on the performance rider advised she was disappointed.
