Race 7 - NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK CANTERBURY BELLE STAKES 1200m

GREAT TIME (T Comignaghi) - Trainer Mr R Dennis reported to Stewards that GREAT TIME was sent to the Canterbury Equine Clinic to determine the extent of the injury from the lacerations to the right hind leg. R Dennis advised that the results from the examination showed severe tendon damage and GREAT TIME will remain in the care of the Canterbury Equine Clinic until the veterinarians are satisfied the filly is stable enough to be released. Stewards will follow up in the next few weeks.

Race 1 MARGARET & PAUL GALLAGHER MEMORIAL MAIDEN 1200m

BLUSHING (J Fawcett) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

TIMEISRUNNINGOUT (W Pinn) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact losing ground. Raced three wide without cover.

ALLEATO (K Bakker) - Contacted leaving the barriers losing ground. Raced four wide without cover in the early to middle stages.

CAPITAL LISTING (S Weatherley) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover. Rider reported the filly had some breathing issues.

SHEAINTSOPEACHY (A Goindasamy) - Steadied to avoid the heels of PIVOTAL TEN (S Wynne) which shifted inwards when not fully clear near the 900 metres. S Wynne was advised to exercise greater care.

THE BLUE DIAMOND (T Comignaghi) - Rider reported the filly had raced greenly in its first up run today.

Race 2 SEAHORSE SUPPLEMENTS MAIDEN 3YO 1200m

THE COOL ONE (T Moseley) - Slow away (5L). Connections were advised that a barrier manners warning would be placed on the gelding's record.

TEMBO (K Bakker) - Slow away.

RED STAR BELLA (A Goindasamy) - Slow away. Checked near the 1000 metres.

GRANE (Y Atchamah) - Crowded and forced inwards near the 1000 metres.

RED LABEL (D Cooper) - Checked near the 1000 metres.

BLUE GODDESS (S Wynne) - Checked near the 1000 metres.

KAISEDA (J Fawcett) - Dictated inwards near the 1000 metres.

B Murray (HOLDEM) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount HOLDEN to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of KAISEDA which was dictated inwards crowding GRANE onto RED LABEL which were both checked approaching the 1000 metres, with BLUE GODDESS and RED STAR BELLA also being checked as a consequence. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of B Murray's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Friday 4 October until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 16 October, 7 national riding days.

Following this race the track was upgraded to Good 4.

Race 3 NZB MEGA MAIDEN SERIES 1200m

BEALEY VALLEY (J Fawcett) - Restrained to obtain cover after jumping from the outside barrier.

ICE COLD GOLD (D Cooper) - Slow away. Raced three wide without cover from the 700 metres.

MATAKANA PERKYNANA (T Moseley) - Jumped away awkwardly.

JETSTREAM (S Weatherley) - Jumped away awkwardly.

CHARM MANHATTAN (A Goindasamy) - Raced three wide without cover until the 700 metres.

LISE PAREE (T Comignaghi) - Crowded and had to steady passing the 350 metres.

THUNDERFIST (T Ladouceur) - Had to be angled across heels passing the 200 metres to find clear racing room.

L Hemi (FULL MOON FEVER) - Issued with a warning after allowing her mount to shift inwards near the 350 metres crowding LISE PAREE which had to be steadied.

Race 4 KELMAN'S ON TRACK RATING 65 1200m

THATS CHARMING (B May) - Slow away.

AORANGI ASSASSIN (K Bakker) - Slow away. Raced three wide without cover. Raced in restricted room and buffeted just short of the winning post when FREEDOM REINS (Y Atchamah) improved into a marginal run at this point. Y Atchamah was shown a replay of this incident and advised to exercise greater care.

GAME DUKE (L Callaway) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

HIGH STEP (K Mudhoo) - Raced in restricted room passing the 200 metres.

FREEDOM REINS (Y Atchamah) - Raced in restricted room near the 100 metres and then improved into a marginal run near the 50 metres making contact with AORANGI ASSASSIN.

Race 5 JON SNOW @ CLEARVIEW PARK 1600m

MININJAGIRL (L Callaway) - Slow away.

ORSOME DUDE (K Mudhoo) - Jumped away awkwardly.

DIAMOND RIVIERE (A Balloo) - Raced in restricted room to the inside of BLANCHE which was briefly taken inwards by MININJAGIRL (L Callaway) near the 1250 metres. L Callaway was advised to exercise greater care.

BLANCHE (S Weatherley) – Steadied in the shadows of the post when awkwardly placed on heels.

Race 6 PALAMOUNTAINS SCIENTIFIC ANIMAL NUTRITION MAIDEN 1600m

CLASSIC COUNTRY (C Campbell) - Blundered leaving the barriers. Raced very wide into the first bend and three wide without cover for the majority of the race. Lay inwards in the run home.

ICE EMPRESS (T Jonker) - Jumped away awkwardly.

RAGHALLAIGH (B May) - Slow away.

LOREN (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

EL FUEGO (T Comignaghi) - Over raced in the middle stages having to be steadied away from heels near the 1000 metres. Had to be steadied passing the 250 metres then held up until passing the 100 metres.

CAPTAIN UPHAM (K Kwo) - Lay outwards in the run home and near the winning post was dictated further outwards.

PETE'S PRIDE (R Muniandy) - Shifted outwards under pressure passing the 250 metres dictating TE KANAWA outwards onto EL FUEGO which had to be steadied.

CHEQUERED (D Cooper) - Lay outwards throughout the run home and shifted ground outwards under pressure over the concluding stages dictating CAPTAIN UPHAM outwards, with RAGHALLAIGH being briefly inconvenienced near the winning post. D Cooper was shown a replay of this incident and advised he must straighten his mount earlier than he had on this occasion.

Following this race the jockey of the second placed horse **RAGHALLAIGH** viewed video footage of the concluding stages before electing not to proceed with a protest.

R Muniandy (PETE'S PRIDE) - Issued with a warning after allowing his mount PETE'S PRIDE to shift outwards dictating TE KANAWA outwards into the line of EL FUEGO which had to be steadied and change ground passing the 250 metres.

Race 7 LOVE RACING & REMEMBERING GREY WAY OPEN 1600m

VAGUE (S Wynne) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

CHAPINTEEL (L Hemi) - Hampered leaving the barriers having to be steadied. Crowded when in restricted room near the 250 metres.

SMOOTH OPERATOR (T Moseley) - Slow away.

LADY TELENA (D Tait) - Raced in restricted room passing the 250 metres having to be steadied when between FAYTINA (J Fawcett) which shifted outwards slightly and CHAPINTEEL which was racing in restricted room to the inside of SMOOTH OPERATOR (T Moseley) which was laying inwards. Also contributing to this incident was some movement from IN VEGAS which lay outwards. Both T Moseley and J Fawcett were advised to exercise greater care.

IN VEGAS (A Balloo) - Rider dropped his whip near the 150 metres.

Race 8 ECHOES OF HEAVEN RATING 65 1600m

BLUE BAY (A Najib) - Slow away.

ANAFTERNOONDELIGHT (T Ladouceur) - Restrained to obtain cover after jumping from the outside barrier.

HIGHLAND FLING (K Bakker) - Raced very wide in the early stages before improving forward to sit outside the leader passing the 800 metres.

EL CHAPEAU (L Hemi) - Race three wide without cover from the 800 metres.

PEACHY KEEN (A Goindasamy) - Held up early in the run home until passing the 250 metres. Lay inwards near the 200 metres and made firm contact with PARAGON when both runners shifted ground. Accidentally struck over the head by the whip of T Comignaghi (PARAGON) passing the 200 metres.

PARAGON (T Comignaghi) - Lay outwards in the run home having to be straightened passing the 200 metres and shortly after made contact with PEACHY KEEN.

D Cooper (BLEAKHOUSE BURTIE) - Defended a charge of careless riding alleging that he permitted his mount BLEAKHOUSE BURTIE to shift inwards shortly after the start when not sufficiently clear of MISS INTERPRET which was checked, with BLUE BAY being hampered as a result. After hearing evidence and considering submissions the Adjudicator upheld the charge and imposed a suspension of D Cooper's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 28 September until the conclusion of racing on Friday 11 October, 7 national riding days.

Race 9 EQUINE VETERINARY SERVICES MAIDEN 2200m

DECLARE (S Toolooa) - Began awkwardly losing some ground. Raced three wide without cover and keenly through the early stages.

ELLDECREE (K Bakker) - Slow to begin.

CLARA MONCRIEFF (A Balloo) - Slow to begin.

DIVINE STORY (A Goindasamy) - Briefly steadied near the 1800 metres to avoid heels then made the bend near the 1700 metres awkwardly. Lay outwards and away from an inside runner near the 400 metres, with YUNGBLUD briefly awkwardly placed on that runner's heels.

YUNGBLUD (B May) - Steadied away from the heels of DIVINE STORY (A Goindasamy) near the 1800 metres when that runner shifted outwards. A Goindasamy was advised to exercise greater care. Then over raced through the early stages.

Race 10 BRANDED KIWI & SEE YOU NEXT FRIDAY 2200m

TAKE THE DEEL (Y Atchamah) - Slow away. Made the turn near the 750 metres awkwardly going off-stride briefly.

EKSTREMEMISS (S Toolooa) - Slow away. Over raced in the early stages.
