Stewards exercised discretion when assessing the late declaration of riders due to the lack of jumping riders available.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 MERRYLEES HOTEL MAIDEN HURDLE (3000m)

KID WARRIOR (K Wiles) - Shifted out at the start crowding outside runner.

UNCLE CHARLIE (M Roustoby) - Crowded at the start losing ground. Put in a poor leap at the fourth fence dislodging its rider who was uninjured.

RED NED (E Farr) - Over-raced in the early stages and had to be severely restrained away from heels near the 2200 metres.

RAKANUI (D Parker) - Over-raced on a moderate tempo through the early and middle stages.

GREYSTONE (S Karnicnik) - Under pressure from the 800 metres and gave ground from this point finishing in last placing.

Following the running of this race the track conditions were upgraded to Heavy 9.

Race 2 TOM CASTLES – CELEBRATING 80 YEARS MAIDEN HURDLE (3000m)

TIMBA (K Wiles) - Got its head up when being restrained in the early stages and continued to over-race for a distance. Raced wide through the middle stages.

ALL IN BLACKBERRY (M Roustoby) - Crowded mid-air when jumping the second fence by runners either side which shifted ground.

HEY HEY HEY (S Karnicnik) - Mixed its jumping throughout. Lost the near hind plate during the running.

YOLO (D Parker) - Put in an awkward leap at the last fence. Rider dropped his whip passing the 100 metres.

K Wiles (TIMBA) - Spoken to advisedly in regard to his use of the whip on a runner out of contention.

Race 3 TOLL FREE TARARUA HURDLE (3000m)

JUSTICE (K Wiles) - Put in a poor leap at the fourth last fence losing some ground.

OBRIGADO (S Karnicnik) - Mixed its jumping throughout.

Race 4 FLAIR AMATEUR SERIES FINAL (2200m)

DOCTOR IRIS (N Smith) - Reared in its stall getting its feet caught over the front of the gate and was removed to undergo a veterinary inspection before being declared a late scratching at 2.57pm. Connections were advised the gelding must barrier trial prior to racing next.

CARIGNAN (C McKee) - Removed from its barrier and underwent a veterinary inspection after getting hooked in the front of the gate and was cleared to start.

BRUCIE (A McIntyre) - Very slow to begin.

RISE THE TIDE (M Simons) - Crowded and contacted the running rail passing the 1800 metres, shifting out abruptly forcing GO BUTCH outwards on to TRAMORE which was buffeted and unbalanced. After interviewing riders and viewing replays its was established that RISE THE TIDE had improved into a tight run and was three quarters of a length back inside runners as the field made the bend out of the straight with slight inwards movement from TRAMORE. Both M Simons and A Scott (TRAMORE) were shown replays of the incident and advised to exercise greater care when in similar circumstances.

GO BUTCH (O Helagi) - Raced in restricted room near the 1800 metres and was forced out on to the hind quarters of TRAMORE.

TRAMORE (A Scott) - Buffeted and unbalanced near the 1800 metres.

SAINT BERNARD (N Jenkins) - Held up by a tiring runner near the 400 metres. Lay in throughout the run home.

NOTABADBAR (V Peebles) - Rider was dislodged going over the crossing when pulling up after the race and was uninjured.

Race 5 DAVID & ELLEN OLIVER MAIDEN STEEPLECHASE (4000m)

ZAC FLASH (S Karnicnik) - Slow into stride. Mixed its jumping throughout.

PONTARDAWE (M Roustoby) - Briefly steadied to avoid the heels of BROTHER MAX passing the 3600 metres. Ran down the last fence.

CATCH AND RELEASE (H McNeill) - Over-raced in the early stages.

BROTHER MAX (T Moki) - Put in a bad jump near the 600 metres and lost considerable ground. Rider was reminded of her obligations in regard to her use of the whip on a horse that was out of contention.

MUSE (K Wiles) - Dipped on landing after jumping the fourth last fence.

T Moki (BROTHER MAX) - Issued with a warning after allowing her mount BROTHER MAX to shift in near the 3600 metres resulting in PONTARDAWE having to be steadied to avoid that runner's heels.

Race 6 PROPERTY BROKERS PAHIATUA/WOODVILLE+- STEEPLECHASE (4000m)

AFTERALLTHISTIME (D Parker) - Slow to begin.

TORQUE TIME (M Roustoby) - Jumped the first fence awkwardly.

THE ANARCHIST (E Farr) - Landed awkwardly after jumping the fence near the 2000 metres. Jumped the second last fence awkwardly.

CALL ME JACK (L Douglas) - Became detached from the field in the run down the back straight on the first occasion and was retired from the event passing the 1200 metres. Rider reported the gelding had jumped indifferently and was reluctant to hit out adding he had no excuse. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Connections advised the gelding would now be sent for a spell.

LA JUNGLES (T Moki) - Underwent a veterinary inspection around at the start area at the request of the rider and was cleared to race. Retired from the race prior to jumping the second last fence.

K Wiles (JAKAMA KRYSTAL) - Spoken to advisedly in regard to his use of the whip on a horse that was clearly winning.

Race 7 MAHONEY CONTRACTORS MAIDEN (1200m)

DOLLYBIRD (K Hercock) - Began awkwardly losing some ground.

BEETLEGEUSE (C Dell) - Crowded at the start losing ground. Checked near the 200 metres having to shift ground inwards to find clear racing room.

CRAFTSMAN (J Riddell) - Slow to begin.

FELUCCA (T Davies) - Inclined to lay inwards in the run home.

Following the race C Dell, the rider of the 4th placed BEETLEGEUSE lodged a Protest under Rule 642(1) against 3rd placing being awarded to LATER BOY alleging interference near the 200 metres. After hearing from all parties and

viewing replays the Adjudicative Committee upheld the Protest with the revised placings now 1st DOLLYBIRD, 2nd ROSA, 3rd BEETLEGEUSE, 4th LATER BOY.

C Lindsay (LATER BOY) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she allowed her mount LATER BOY to shift ground outwards near the 200 metres checking BEETLEGEUSE. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of Miss Lindsay's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 2 October until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 9 October, 5 national days.

Race 8 RUAHINE LINE DANCERS WOODVILLE MAIDEN (1400m)

WICKHAM (J Chung) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

FIVE BELLS (A Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

SAFE AZ DOUTE (E Sole) - Slow to begin.

RADIANT LASS (C Butler) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Race 9 K B FORD (1400m)

SHEZ SHAMUS (A Riddell) - Bucked shortly after the start and then veered left abruptly, dislodging the rider who was uninjured. Connections were advised the mare must barrier trial prior to racing next.

KA YING LUCKY (L Kauri) - The saddle shifted forward passing the 1100 metres with the rider electing to allow his mount to stride forward to sit outside the leader near the 800 metres.

SEVENAYES (J Chung) - Shifted out in the home straight and finished wide on the track.

Race 10 THICKET COFFEE & FLOWERS PAHIATUA MAIDEN (1600m)

THIRSTY (J Riddell) - Slow to begin.

HANK SMITH (L Sutherland) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

LET'S GET LOOSE (E Sole) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

LAZY (C Lindsay) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.
