EYEGEEGEE (K Myers) – Co-trainer L Zydenbos advised Stewards the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of the gelding, however, EYEGEEGEE has now been retired from racing.

Race 1	CAMBRIDGE EQUINE HOSPITAL MAIDEN 1550
<p>PIRATES 'N' GOLD (C Grylls) – Slow away.</p> <p>MR ACABELLO (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow away.</p> <p>LORD GOLIATH (T Moodley) - Slow away. Steadied off the heels of NAVY ICON passing the 1000 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding was unsuited to the synthetic surface.</p> <p>CALIFORNIA GOLD (M Hashizume) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>NAVY ICON (J Doyle) – Held up rounding the bend from the 600 metres until passing the 400 metres. Was inclined to lay inwards under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>T Moodley (LORD GOLIATH) - Spoken to in the presence of the riding mentor and reprimanded for his actions behind the barriers prior to the start.</p>	
Race 2	COOKIES KITCHEN 1550
<p>HIT THE SWITCH (S Mxothwa) - Jumped away awkwardly then being further hampered by WHATS THE ONE CODE.</p> <p>WHATS THE ONE CODE (T Mitchell) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact with HIT THE SWITCH.</p> <p>ROZEL (W Pinn) - Rider dismounted from the mare prior to returning to the birdcage due to aggravating a back injury during the race. The horse escaped from its rider however was quickly recaptured.</p> <p>W Pinn (ROZEL) - Was shown the replays and reminded of his obligations to ensure he rides his mounts out fully to the end of the race when circumstances permit.</p> <p>S Mxothwa (HIT THE SWITCH) - Was shown the replays in the presence of the riding mentor and reminded of his obligations to ensure he rides his mounts out fully to the end of the race when circumstances permit.</p> <p>Following this race W Pinn was examined by St John Ambulance personnel and stood down from his remaining engagements due to aggravating a back injury suffered at the trials on Tuesday, 1 October.</p>	
Race 3	WAIPA EARTHWORKS MAIDEN 3YO 1300
<p>BIG EXIT (D Mansour) - Raced greenly under pressure in the straight ducking outwards abruptly approaching the 100 metres.</p> <p>MONEYPENNY (V Colgan) - Checked near the 100 metres.</p> <p>ASPEN VOLTAGE (R Elliot) - Had to be steadied to avoid heels over the concluding stages.</p> <p>O Bosson (PUZZLE MASTER) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of MONEYPENNY which was checked near the 100 metres then continued to shift inwards resulting in ASPEN VOLTAGE having to be steadied to avoid heels over the concluding stages. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of O Bosson's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 13 October up to and including racing on Monday 28 October, 9 national riding days.</p>	
Race 4	SADDLERY WAREHOUSE 1300
<p>LIVING IN HOPE (J Fawcett) – Reared as the start was effected.</p>	

PRIVY GARDEN (M Hashizume) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

DYNAMIS (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly. Eased down over the final 150 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities. Co-trainer P McKay advised that the gelding would not be persevered with as a racing proposition from his stable.

OH NO NO NO (S Spratt) - Slow away. Improved onto heels when racing keenly having to be steadied near the 1100 metres. Held up rounding the final bend and early in the straight.

MISS ROCKETTE (S Weatherley) - Held up for a distance rounding the final bend. Lay outwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Race 5

PRYDE'S EASIFEED 1300

SIDE EYE (T Mitchell) - Jumped away awkwardly. Held up near the 250 metres having to shift outward across heels to obtain clear running near the 100 metres. Stewards questioned T Mitchell in the presence of the riding mentor in relation to her ride early in the final straight. T Mitchell explained that her mount was not travelling well enough to improve into a run between COLORADO SILVER and MARKET PLACE near the 250 metres and felt her best option was to shift outwards to obtain clear running. However, in hindsight T Mitchell agreed with Stewards that a better option would have been to show more patience as a run quickly presented passing the 250 metres. Stewards noted T Mitchell's explanation.

NOVAK (O Bosson) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from the outside barrier. Shifted inwards just short of the finish inconveniencing PENNY ROYAL.

PENNY ROYAL (A Riddell) - Raced wide without cover for most of the race. Inconvenienced just short of the finish when NOVAK shifted inwards. Apprentice A Riddell was shown footage of her ride in the presence of the riding mentor with Stewards concerns that after being in a position with cover early in the race, she had opted to shift outwards then racing progressively wider from the middle stages. A Riddell was advised that she would be expected to display better judgement with her riding in future.

COLORADO SILVER (R Elliot) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that he was disappointed with the mare's effort and could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities. Stewards will follow up on the post-race condition of the mare with trainer H Wynyard in the coming days.

PLEASE SIR (T Moodley) - Slow away.

WAITERIMU (S Weatherley) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact with the hindquarters of PINKY PIE, losing ground.

PINKY PIE (C Grylls) - Contacted leaving the barriers.

Race 7

NEMS MEDICAL MAIDEN 2000

RICHARD FARRELL (O Bosson) – Declared a late scratching at 3.58 pm after an incorrect horse was presented to race.

GOLDEN (S Weatherley) – Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover from an outside barrier. Held up for a distance rounding the final bend.

DANCIN IN THE DARK (R Goyaram) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

PRINCESS JASMINE (S Spratt) - Contacted by CRYSTAL FALLS near the 250 metres. Checked to avoid the heels of CRYSTAL FALLS which shifted inwards near the 100 metres.

V Colgan (CRYSTAL FALLS) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of PRINCESS JASMINE which was checked near the 100 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of V Colgan's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 5 October up to and including racing on Sunday 13 October, 5 national riding days.

S Ritchie & C Murray (RICHARD FARRELL) - Admitted a charge in that the incorrect horse was presented to race. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$1,000.
