DISTRICT NINE (K Hercock) - Steadied to avoid the heels of DOMPERION (Y Atchamah) passing the 1100 metres. Y Atchamah was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground. Hung outwards rounding the final bend.

MORRIE (L Hemi) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home, only gaining clear racing room passing the 250 metres.

CHARM MANHATTAN (T Moseley) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear racing room early in the run home.

PERICOLOSO (D Tait) - Became awkwardly placed on heels near the 250 metres having to be briefly steadied and shift ground inwards.

Race 3 | **ZILCO & SOUTH CANTERBURY SADDLERY 1200m**

GAME DUKE (Y Atchamah) - Very slow to begin losing considerable ground. Connections were advised that GAME DUKE is required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next.

MOGUL (J Doyle) - Slow to begin. Rider reported that after being slow to begin he got further back than he had hoped, with the gelding making ground fairly over the concluding stages.

HIGH STEP (K Bakker) - Slow to begin. The near side stirrup iron broke passing the 750 metres causing the rider difficulty for the remainder of the race.

RADIANT ROSIE (D Tait) - Raced three wide without cover.

KINDRED SPIRIT (K Hercock) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home gaining clear racing room passing the 300 metres.

TOWN BELT (A Najib) - Contacted by ANNIA AURELIA which shifted inwards abruptly despite the efforts of the rider just short of the winning post.

AVITUS (K Kwo) - Lay outwards rounding the final bend shifting wider on the track and continued to lay out in the run home having to be straightened on a number of occasions.

Race 4 | **LEG UP OILSEED GOODNESS 1200m**

BLUEY'S CHANCE (T Jonker) - Slow to begin.

RICHARD STOMPER (B May) - Shifted outwards abruptly on jumping.

MIDNIGHT JANE (A Najib) - Placed in restricted room losing ground shortly after the start when runners either side shifted ground. Briefly held up passing the 300 metres having to shift ground inwards.

TENGIZ (K Hercock) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

KING COUGAR (T Moseley) - Made the bend near the 950 metres awkwardly

NATURAL MOMENTUM (T Ladouceur) - Rider advised he had been instructed to lead but had been taken on during the running and when placed under pressure in the final straight the gelding had failed to respond to his riding and had been disappointing.

Race 5 | **NEW WORLD TIMARU 1600m**

DIAMOND RIVIERE (S Wynne) - Slow to begin.

PEARL OPULENCE (L Hemi) - Slow to begin.

IN AWE (K Bakker) - Got its tongue over the bit in the early stages. Lay inwards in the back straight proving a difficult ride and near the 1100 metres shifted inwards placing DELMONICO in restricted room. Continued to lay inwards until gaining a position adjacent to the rail near the 900 metres. Rider K Bakker in the presence of the Apprentice Riding Mentor was shown replays of this incident for educational purposes.

DELMONICO (J Doyle) - Placed in restricted room near the 1100 metres having to steady.

SEFTON (B May) - Held up rounding the final bend until obtaining clear racing passing the 200 metres.

RUBY SUNRISE (D Tait) - When asked to comment on performance, trainer P Robson advised that the mare was having its first start from her stable and the change in training regime had helped with an improved performance not unexpected today.

BLANCHE (A Najib) - Lay outwards when placed under pressure over the concluding stages and near the winning post shifted onto the heels of RUBY SUNRISE having to be steadied and shifted inwards to avoid those heels.

Race 6 | **CHEERS TO 55 YEARS – THANKS JENNY MCNICHOLL MAIDEN 1600m**

PIERROGRINE (S Wynne) - Slow to begin and then further hampered when runners either side shifted ground.

DASH OF RED (B Murray) - Slow to begin. Over raced through the middle stages.

MCCLINTOCK (L Callaway) - Over raced in the early stages. Got its head up when being steadied to take a trailing position passing the 1400 metres.

BEAVER FEVER (D Tait) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

FRIENDOFTHEDEVIL (T Comignaghi) - Held up early in the run home and when attempting a run to the inside of TE KANAWA became held up when that runner shifted ground slightly. Continued to have trouble obtaining clear running until the final 100 metres then becoming briefly awkward in its stride when shying and laying outwards over the concluding stages, again becoming awkwardly placed on heels having to be steadied near the winning post. Shortly after the winning post was crowded with the rider becoming unbalanced and being steadied to avoid heels.

THE TATTLER (K Hercock) - Rider advised she had a good run throughout, with the filly only battling over the concluding stages and disappointing.

RAGHALLAIGH (B May) - Rider could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance.

Race 7 | **ECHOES OF HEAVEN & JON SNOW@CLEARVIEW MAIDEN 2200m**

ICE EMPRESS (T Jonker) - Bounded at the start shifting in contacting an inside runner and losing ground.

CLYDE BARROW (K Hercock) - Slow to begin. Rider could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance.

ELLDECREE (T Comignaghi) - Began awkwardly.

LOREN (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly.

DRUMISLE (Y Atchamah) - Began awkwardly. Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home.

DIVINE STORY (D Tait) - Finished a distant last. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed a slow recovery rate. Stewards will follow up with connections in coming days.

Race 8 | **LOVERACING.NZ & CELEBRATING PHAR LAP 2200m**

KOYAMA (Y Atchamah) - Slow to begin.

EKSTREMEMISS (B May) - Raced three wide without cover from the 1100 metres and gave ground from the 600 metres finishing a distant last. Rider advised that the mare had been less than genuine in its efforts today.

ARISTOCRAT (D Tait) - When asked to comment on performance, the rider could offer no tangible excuse.

FRANNI CACCINI (T Comignaghi) - Rider reported the mare was not entirely comfortable in today's track conditions.
