RACE COMMENTS				
Race 1	DUNSTAN SALUTE – HORSEFEED MAIDEN 1200			
ZENZERO GII	RL (J Chung) - Began awkwardly and was slow away.			
BULL PAKI (T straight.	Davies) - Was inclined to over-race in the early part and was steadied just prior to entering the home			

DOCTOR ASKAR (C Butler) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

AGENT BLACK HAND (C Grylls) - Bumped when shifting in under pressure near the 150 metres. When questioned into the disappointing run of AGENT BLACK HAND which dropped out after racing in a forward position throughout, C Grylls had no excuse.

Race 2

TARANAKI/WANGANUI BREEDERS MAIDEN 1400

ZARAVELA (K Hercock) - Over-raced in the early stages and passing the 1000 metres had to be checked when improving into a narrow run to the inside of ATMOSPHERIC which was dictated inwards marginally by RICH ATTITUDE which lay inwards.

RICH ATTITUDE (E Sole) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

GUYTON STREET (L Sutherland) – Raced wide throughout.

EMERALD FURY (C Barnes) – Finished some distance last. Rider had no excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 3 EQUIVETS NZ – SRVS 1400

VIOLETSRBLUE (E Sole) – Late scratching at 12.52 pm after a veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near foreleg. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing next.

DIVINE SPIRIT (L Sutherland) - Slow away.

LADY PERFORMER (L Hemi) – Got back at the start from its wide draw.

CONFETTI (H Grace) - Began awkwardly and got back. When questioned H Grace advised that after getting further back than intended at the start, his mount was unable to improve in the heavy going until late in the final stages.

PERSIFLAGE (J Doyle) - Rider J Doyle could offer no excuse for the run. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 4

MATTY NEIL BUILDING MAIDEN 1650

BARBIE DOLL (T Davies) – Raced ungenerously for some distance after the start and had to be continuously restrained.

MARKET SQUARE (J Doyle) – Improved onto heels having to be restrained near the 1400 metres. Made contact for several strides with ON SHAW when attempting a run rounding the home turn. J Doyle was advised to exercise care.

EL TAJIN (A Mudhoo) - Raced three wide without cover.

ON SHAW (L Douglas) – Raced greenly. Rider was of the opinion the gelding may benefit from the addition of blinkers at its next start.

BURGER RING (K Hercock) - Rider reported that the gelding tended to lay out under pressure in the home straight.

Race 5 ROPER AGRICULTURE 1650

BADGERINGDAWITNESS (E Sole) – Restrained when racing in restricted room shortly after the start. Tightened when making the first turn.

KATTEGAT (K Chowdhoory) – Raced keenly through the early stages.

ZACKERY (C Barnes) – Tightened into the first turn and made contact with the rail when BADGERINGDAWITNESS, KATTEGAT and FRANK THE TANK shifted in marginally near the 1400 metres.

BENEFACTOR (H Grace) - Bumped and became momentarily unbalanced shortly after entering the home straight when KATTEGAT was angled outwards into clear running. A short distance further BENEFACTOR shifted in making contact with KATTEGAT resulting in both runners jostling for several strides. K Chowdhoory was shown footage of his ride and issued with a warning and was advised that he is expected to straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.

K Chowdhoory (KATTEGAT) - Issued with a warning after angling his mount out jostling with BENEFACTOR in the home straight.

Following the running of Race 5, H Grace the rider of BENEFCTOR which finished fourth viewed video footage of the home straight but elected not to proceed with an objection against the third placed KATTEGAT.

Race 6AGPAC – SAM SOUTHCOMBE MAIDEN 2200RED NED (C Barnes) – Reared at the start and was slow away.

KEEN ON BUBBLES (J Doyle) - Began awkwardly shifting out bumping with HE'S ALL FABULOUS which settled back.

KING CABAL (J Chung) - Raced wide throughout and had little left at the finish. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

HE'S ALL FABULOUS (L Douglas) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

TOUCH O'PARADISE (T Davies) - Checked near the 250 metres.

MADAM PELE (E Sole) - Checked near the 250 metres.

B Rogerson (MISS BEE) - Admitted a charge in that she permitted her mount to shift outwards contacting TOUCH O'PARADISE near the 250 metres which in turn shifted out unbalancing MADAM PELE. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of B Rogerson's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 16 October up to and including racing on Sunday 27 October, 7 national riding days.

Race 7JOHNNY NEIL BUILDING 2200HARDTIMES (K Kalychurun) – Slow away.

AIN'T BAD (M Singh) - Put its head down and commenced to buck for a short distance after the start, losing considerable ground after the saddle had shifted backwards around the flank placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder of the race. Rider M Singh was advised that in future the preferred option would be to retire his mount when so far back rather than continue on as he did on this occasion.

SUBTLE TEASE (T Davies) - Held up near the 300 metres.
