RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | **WAIKATO DRAUGHT MAIDEN 2100**

OUR EASY STREET (A Lawson-Carroll) – Restrained at the start to obtain cover from a wide barrier.

HOOTIE JOHNSON (S Spratt) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from the outside barrier.

BEAU ONDAGO (S Brown) – Raced keenly through the early stages.

DENZEL (L Kauri) - Raced keenly through the early stages. Raced in restricted room passing the 450 metres having to be steadied.

TE AROHA BOY (T Moodley) - Raced keenly through the early stages. Steadied when placed in restricted room to the outside of DENZEL and inside of VIRAGO TEASE near the 1900 metres.

SHE'S IDEAL (J Nishizuka) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Race 2 SKYCITY HAMILTON MAIDEN 1400

MISTA STITCH (N Hailey) - Slow to begin.

TURNAROUND (W Kennedy) – Raced keenly through the early stages.

MARCOS (J Fawcett) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SWEET AND SASSY (J Nishizuka) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

KERBLINE (J Doyle) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider was of the opinion that the gelding may not have handled the left-handed way of going. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 3 NZ HORSE AMBULANCE TRUST MAIDEN 1400

LIGHT OF PLUTUS (C Grylls) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

GIBRALTAR RISING (B Rogerson) - Over-raced through the early and middle stages.

MOELLE (A Lawson-Carroll) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 250 metres.

TIME TRAVELLER (M Hashizume) – Lay inwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

R Elliot (PRESUMING) – Issued with a warning for raising his arm above shoulder height when using the whip over the concluding stages.

Race 4 FULTON HOGAN 1200

TURN THE ACE (N Hailey) - Began awkwardly.

JOHNY JOHNY (R Goyaram) - Began awkwardly.

DURHAM LAD (J Doyle) – Restrained at the start to obtain cover from the outside barrier.

CAITLYNS WISH (M Sanson) – Raced keenly through the early stages. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that in her opinion the mare had been unsuited by today's track conditions which she described as holding.

Race 5 WAIKATO STUD FOXBRIDGE PLATE DAY 24/8 1400

STERLING EXPRESS (W Kennedy) - Slow to begin.

LA DOLCE VITA (R Goyaram) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from a wide barrier.

ELECTRIC TIME (J Allen) - Rider dropped her whip near the 150 metres.

Race 6 FAIRVIEW MOTORS 1200

HANAIEI STAR (B Rogerson) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced keenly through the early stages.

ROSETOWN PRINCESS (B Jacobson) - Slow to begin.

BLONDIE (J Doyle) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the mare had over-raced through the early and middle stages which had been detrimental to its chances.

RUNNINWITHTHEDEVIL (C Grylls) – Commenced to race ungenerously for a distance when being restrained passing the 1000 metres.

HEY HEY BABY (R Goyaram) - Lay out under pressure over the concluding stages.

Race 7 | **TE AKAU - NZ'S CHAMPION STABLE MILE 1600**

WHISKEY N' RYE (N Hailey) - Slow to begin.

SILVER JAVELIN (W Kennedy) - Slow to begin.

VINO VALENTINO (C Butler) – Restrained at the start to obtain cover from the outside barrier.

PACIFICO (T Moodley) – Lay outwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

TE ATATU DREAM (B Jacobson) - Shifted outwards passing the 400 metres making firm contact with WHISKEY N' RYE becoming unbalanced, losing ground. B Jacobson was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

REVUELTO (R Elliot) - Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

M Cartwright (AGERA) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount AGERA eight times prior to the 100 metre mark with the Adjudicator imposing a fine of \$500.

Race 8 | **DUNSTAN HORSEFEEDS 2100**

MIDDLE KHAN (M Sanson) - Began awkwardly making contact with LEICALOT.

IN A PICKLE (W Kennedy) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from a wide barrier.

ROC UP RALPH (A Lawson-Carroll) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from a wide barrier.

EL NYMPH (T Moodley) – Raced keenly through the early stages when being restrained.

KAHMA SUITSYA (J Fawcett) - Raced wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the mare had failed to respond when placed under pressure. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

WHAT A CHARMA (T Newman) – Raced keenly through the middle stages.

LEICALOT (C Grylls) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.
