**South Canterbury Racing Club @ Phar Lap Raceway Timaru - Tuesday 8 October 24**

**Race 7 - ECHOES OF HEAVEN & JON SNOW@CLEARVIEW MAIDEN 2200m**

**DIVINE STORY** (D Tait) - Trainer Mr R Didham reported to Stewards that he was satisfied with the post-race condition of the mare, however **DIVINE STORY** has now been retired from racing.

**Ashburton Racing Club @ Ashburton Raceway - Saturday 12 October 24**

**Race 6 - MCCREA PAINTERS & DECORATORS ASHBURTON CUP 1600m**

**NORTIBUTNICE (K Williams)** - Trainer Mr J Bullard reported to Stewards that upon return to the stable the mare underwent blood tests with no abnormalities being detected. J Bullard further advised it is his intention to continue with NORTIBUTNICE'S current preparation.

**THE BUFFER (Y Atchamah)** - Trainer Ms K Williams advised Stewards that upon return to the stable THE BUFFER underwent a veterinarian examination including blood tests which revealed the gelding to have a viral infection and was treated with appropriate medication. K Williams further advised that THE BUFFER has now been sent for a 10 day spell.

#### RACE COMMENTS

##### Race 1 ENTAIN/NZB PEARL SERIES MAIDEN F&M 1600m

**AMUSING (T Moseley)** - Broke through the front of the stalls prior to the start but was quickly pulled up and returned to the start area and cleared to race after undergoing a veterinary inspection. Rider advised he had recommended gear changes after racing greenly throughout.

**PIN SEEKER (R Muniandy)** - Slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear racing room in the early stages of the run home.

**TIPSY TART (A Goindasamy)** - Restrained from a wide draw to obtain cover.

**TAIMATE STAAR (S Weatherley)** - Slow to begin. The saddle shifted backwards during the running placing the rider in difficulty.

**I'M NO PRINCESS (A Lawson-Carroll)** - Raced keenly while leading through the early stages and then gave ground from the 500 metres.

##### Race 2 NELLIES RESTAURANT & BAR MAIDEN 1500m

**L Callaway (PETE'S PRIDE)** - Admitted a charge after presenting the wrong horse, namely EMPRESS SUIKO, to race instead of PETE'S PRIDE, with the Adjudicator imposing a fine of \$500.

Due to the incident with TEE JAY this race ran 7 minutes late.

**TEE JAY (A Lawson-Carroll)** - Rider dislodged at the start area, with the horse being recaptured and undergoing a pre-race veterinary inspection before being cleared to race. A Lawson-Carroll was attended to by on-course paramedics and cleared to ride. Blundered at the start beginning awkwardly. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Raced greenly in the run home and near the 150 metres shifted in abruptly.

**GENE WEEN (T Moseley)** - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover from the 800 metres.

**LINED SATIN (A Goindasamy)** - Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with ZABORACI. Lay inwards in the run home having to be straightened near the 100 metres.

**ZABORACI (D Bothamley)** - Contacted at the start.

**PULL THE PIN (R Muniandy)** - Held up rounding the final bend having to be restrained away from heels. Held up over the concluding stages.

**YOO HOO JOY (S Weatherley)** - Lay inwards through the early stages of the run home having to be corrected.

**PETE'S PRIDE** (L Callaway) - Crowded and had to steady near the 350 metres when LINED SATIN shifted out slightly, with the rider advising that the gelding had lay inwards at this point.

**THE ARCHITECT** (K Mudhoo) - Had to be shifted outwards across heels to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.

**S Weatherley** (YOO HOO JOY) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount YOO HOO JOY 7 times prior to the 100 metre mark with 5 more strikes inside the final 100 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of S Weatherley's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Monday 28 October until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 6 November, 5 national riding days.

**Race 3** | **CENTRAL CITY CAR PAINTERS MAIDEN 3YO 1200m**

The start of this race was delayed approximately 3 minutes due to several runners proving difficult to load.

**PERFECT GLORY** (D Subramaniam) - Proved very difficult to load, with the connections advised that a barrier manners warning would be placed against the filly's racing record. Gave ground over the concluding stages, with the rider advising he believed something was amiss with the filly. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed a potential issue with the left foreleg, possibly unresolved from the original injury. Connections were advised that a full veterinary clearance that meets the approval of the head veterinarian of the Racing Integrity Board is required prior to racing next.

**COURTE XENA** (T Comignaghi) - Slow to begin. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**CRITERIA** (D Cooper) - Got its head up when over racing through the early stages.

**MORE SASS** (B May) - Rider reported that the filly had raced greenly and lay in throughout the run home.

**Race 4** | **GRAND CASINO MAIDEN 1200m**

**ARCHIE GUY** (K Kwo) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was cleared to start after being fractious in the back parade ring and making contact with a fence on a number of occasions. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**EMPRESS SUIKO** (S Wynne) - Shifted outwards at the start hampering VANDERDONK.

**VANDERDONK** (D Subramaniam) - Hampered at the start. Raced four wide without cover throughout.

**PAZATAKY DIVA** (S Khetoo) - Slow to begin. Gave ground from the 500 metres finishing a distant last. Connections were advised that a racing manners warning would be placed on the mare's record for its competitiveness.

**MABEL** (S Weatherley) - Restrained from a wide draw to obtain cover at the start.

**CLUEDO LANE** (B Murray) - Lay in through the middle stages of the run home having to be corrected.

**BEAUJOLAIS** (B May) - Rider reported the mare had lay in throughout the run home and had to be straightened on a number of occasions.

**POMALO** (T Moseley) - Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages and made contact with ICE COLD GOLD on two occasions.

**Race 5** | **WHITE ROBE LODGE 75 2200m**

**CLAIRE'S PAL** (L Callaway) - The start was delayed due to CLAIRE'S PAL dislodging its rider in the preliminary and being quickly recaptured before undergoing a pre-race veterinary inspection and being cleared to start. Rider L Callaway

was uninjured in this incident. Raced keenly in the early stages and near the 1600 metres had to be steadied to avoid the heels of CAPTAIN OUMUAMUA who improved forward to lead.

**THE ADVISOR** (D Tait) - Began awkwardly making contact with FIVE PRINCES. Contacted VINO VALENTINO passing the 600 metres becoming briefly unbalanced.

**FIVE PRINCES** (A Balloo) - Contacted at the start.

**CEE ARE EL** (T Moseley) - Slow to begin.

**VINO VALENTINO** (A Goindasamy) - Restrained to obtain cover shortly after the start.

**CAPTAIN OUMUAMUA** (B Murray) - Raced wide into the first bend before improving forward to lead.

**MAGIC ACE** (S Brown) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**PAR TEE** (R Muniandy) - Lay in passing the 200 metres having to be straightened by its rider.

**Race 6** | **KB CONTRACTORS OPEN 1400m**

Trainer **S Woodsford** (STREET FIGHTIN MAN & LOUIE LOUIE) - Issued with a warning after presenting both runners late into the birdcage.

**SECOND THOUGHT** (T Comignaghi) - Required a gear adjustment at the barriers delaying the start.

**HASSTOBEYOU** (S Brown) - Bounded at the start losing ground and was then ridden forward with urgency to recover, improving quickly onto the heels of FIERY RED having to be heavily restrained and shifting out hampering MIDNIGHT RUNNER passing the 1200 metres. S Brown in the presence of the Apprentice Riding Mentor was shown a replay of this incident for educational purposes.

**EPEE BEEL** (A Najib) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout.

**MIDNIGHT RUNNER** (R Muniandy) - Hampered passing the 1200 metres.

**JIMMY FIVE** (S Wynne) - Raced five wide without cover from the 800 metres.

**FIERY RED** (L Callaway) - Lost the off-hind plate near the 1200 metres. Treated post-race after both hind legs were galloped on.

**Race 7** | **PROPERTY BROKERS – RAN KEAN 75 1200m**

**IN DISGUISE** (T Comignaghi) - Slow to begin.

**TIMES UP** (R Muniandy) - Slow to begin.

**EXPRESS COUP** (A Lawson-Carroll) - Bounded at the start losing ground. Had to be shifted inwards off heels passing the 200 metres when held up.

**PAPAGENA** (S Toolooa) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

**WHERE'S WALLY** (Y Atchamah) - Briefly raced in restricted room to the inside of PAPAGENA which made the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres.

**MIDNIGHT JANE** (A Najib) - Had some trouble obtaining clear running early in the run home having to shift ground outwards near the 200 metres to find clear racing room.

**BUOYANT** (C Campbell) - Lay inwards near the 200 metres having to be straightened by its rider.

**Race 8** | **POSITIVE SIGNS + PRINT 65 1200m**

**SHE'S AN ACE** (D Subramaniam) - The start of this race was delayed after the bridle on SHE'S AN ACE broke and was replaced.

**GIVEALITTLE** (T Comignaghi) - Very slow to begin (5L).

**BELLANO** (N Parmar) - Slow to begin. Lay inwards over the concluding stages.

**EYE SPY** (A Goindasamy) - Restrained from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

**HERE I AM** (S Weatherley) - Restrained from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start. Not persevered with over the final stages, with the rider reporting something was amiss with the gelding. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Stewards will follow up with connections in coming days.

**BOOBOO BOOGIE** (R Muniandy) - Raced keenly in the early stages and got its head up when being restrained passing the 1000 metres.

**IDEAL DREAMS** (S Wynne) - Raced wide through the early stages before improving forward to sit outside the leader.

**RUTHLESS ROYAL** (T Moseley) - Raced wide throughout.

**HAGGLE** (C Campbell) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home, having to shift ground passing the 125 metres.

**S Wynne** (IDEAL DREAMS) - Issued with a warning after weighing-in .5 kg in excess of her weigh-out weight.

**N Parmar** (BELLANO) - Issued with a warning after shifting ground inwards and crowding BOOBOO BOOGIE which had to steady in the shadows of the post.

**Race 9** | **SPEIGHT'S 65 1600m**

**DANZA** (K Bakker) - Reared at the start losing ground.

**ANTICIPATE** (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**IMABUSTER** (D Montes de Oca) - Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

**BELLA ROSE** (S Brown) - Denied a marginal run to the inside of GANGSTA GRANNY near the 100 metres having to be steadied and going to the line not fully tested by its rider.

**MISSONI** (A Goindasamy) - Lay inwards over the concluding stages and near the 50 metres briefly inconvenienced VAMOS.

**VAMOS** (D Cooper) - Briefly inconvenienced near the 50 metres.

**HE'S TUNZA GRUNT** (T Comignaghi) - Briefly held up having to shift ground to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.

**K Bakker (DANZA)** - Issued with a warning after weighing-in .5 kg in excess of her weigh-out weight.

<b>Race 10</b>	<b>OTAGO PAINTING SOLUTIONS 65 1600m</b>
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**BLUE BAY** (A Balloo) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**THE IMMIGRANT** (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin.

**HUGS** (R Muniandy) - Slow to begin.

**FIRE 'N REIGN** (D Subramaniam) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Improved wide from the 700 metres.

**PURE FICTION** (B Murray) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

**ZAMBEZI ZIPPER** (S Khetoo) - Rider lost his whip passing the 500 metres.

**KAAPTIVATING** (T Comignaghi) - Rider reported abnormal breathing noises during the running. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed after undergoing an endoscopic examination the mare to have upper respiratory inflammation, which will be treated accordingly.
