## RACE COMMENTS

**Race 1** | **PAEWAI MULLINS SHEARING MAIDEN 2100m**

**LADY'S SECRET** (T Moodley) - Began awkwardly hampering JOHNNY'S SISTER and RED NED.

**SUBTLE IMAGE** (T Newman) - Began awkwardly hampering JOHNNY'S SISTER and RED NED.

**JOHNNY'S SISTER** (L Kauri) - Hampered at the start when runners either side shifted ground.

**RED NED** (L Sutherland) - Hampered at the start when runners either side shifted ground.

**TUKITUKI** (K Kalychurun) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Made the first bend awkwardly.

**STANMORE** (C Dell) - Raced wide throughout.

**TOWROPE** (M Hashizume) - Raced keenly through the early stages. Shifted outwards under pressure in the home straight, bumping with VERARDINO inside the final 100 metres resulting in both runners becoming unbalanced. M Hashizume was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

**VERARDINO** (J Riddell) - Shifted inwards under pressure inside the final 100 metres simultaneously as TOWROPE shifted outwards, with contact being made for several strides with both runners becoming unbalanced. Connections of the 2<sup>nd</sup> placed runner, TOWROPE, (M Hashizume) viewed footage of the final stages but elected not to proceed with an objection. J Riddell (VERARDINO) was shown footage of his ride and reminded of his obligations when shifting ground and advised that he is expected to straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.

**SUBTLE TEASE** (T Newman) - Began awkwardly.

**ZIGGY KHAN** (T Moodley) - Hampered at the start losing ground.

**NUN SO BAD** (K Chowdhoo) - Restrained to the rear from its wide draw.

**CONEY ISLAND** (C Dell) - Raced keenly through the early stages.

**SHE'S SO RELIABLE** (J Chung) - Raced wide throughout.

**MASSO** (L Hemi) - Placed in restricted room near the 1600 metres, contacting the rail and became unbalanced.

**LIBRERO** (T Moodley) - Began awkwardly. Raced keenly near the 1000 metres, having to be steadied.

**ELEGANT ELLE** (A Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>TUESDAY TRADIES MAIDEN 1200m</b>

**TAKE IT** (L Hemi) - Fractious in its barrier delaying the start. Began awkwardly. Lost the off-hind plate during the running.

**BULL PAKI** (K Hercock) - Began awkwardly, settling at the rear.

**TOLSTOY** (J Chung) - Began awkwardly, settling towards the rear. Raced greenly in the home straight. When questioned into performance, rider was of the opinion the gelding had not been comfortable in today's heavy track conditions.

**SUGAR LIPS** (C Butler) - Raced ungenerously through the early stages.

**PRINCESS BARBIE** (A Lawson-Carroll) - Over-raced through the early stages.

**CUBA STREET** (L Kauri) - Raced wide throughout.

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>HULLO 1400m</b>

**PADDY GIFT** (J Doyle) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**BARBIE DOLL** (K Hercock) - Hampered at the start, losing ground. Raced keenly, having to be steadied on several occasions through the back straight.

**NADHEEMA** (T Taiaroa) - Finished back. When questioned, T Taiaroa had no excuse but was of the opinion the mare may be better suited to the synthetic track.

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>WOODVILLE SERVICE CENTRE MAIDEN 1400m</b>
<p><b>SHAWSHANK</b> (L Sutherland) - Trainer K Myers was given permission to remove the vizer blinkers from SHAWSHANK. Lay inwards in the home straight.</p> <p><b>JACKS PRIDE</b> (A Lawson-Carroll) - Restrained to the rear from its wide draw.</p> <p><b>HIPS DON'T LIE</b> (J Chung) - Began awkwardly, then raced greenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>CHAMPAGNE LINDA</b> (M Hashizume) - Over-raced in the early stages. Briefly held up entering the home straight. Trainer advised Stewards it is his intention to spell the mare.</p> <p><b>DOWNTROU</b> (K Hercock) - Over-raced having to be steadied near the 900 metres.</p> <p><b>GUZZLER</b> (J Riddell) - Held up until inside the 200 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>TARARUA ALLIANCE 1600m</b>
<p><b>BATTLE SECRET</b> (M Hashizume) - Slow to begin. Lay outwards over the concluding stages.</p> <p><b>LILLY LAGUNA</b> (J Chung) - Restrained to the rear from its wide draw. When questioned, J Chung was of the opinion the mare would derive benefit from today's race and is better suited to racing over more distance.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>J JENKINS JEWELLER MAIDEN 1600m</b>
<p><b>COBBA</b> (K Kalychurun) - Restrained to the rear from its wide draw.</p> <p><b>TISSE</b> (T Moodley) - Slow away. Lay inwards over the concluding stages. T Moodley was shown footage of his ride in the presence of the Apprentice Mentor and advised he is expected to straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.</p> <p><b>ROSA</b> (A Mudhoo) - Over-raced through the middle stages.</p>
