THE SKY ABOVE (C Grylls) – Te Akau Racing Manager R Trumper advised Stewards the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of THE SKY ABOVE, however, the mare has now been sent for a brief spell.

Waikato Thoroughbred Racing @ Te Rapa, Saturday 12 October 24**Race 3 DON LOOKER – CELEBRATING 100 YEARS 2000m**

INVESTIGATE (S Weatherley) – Trainer T Pike reported to Stewards he was satisfied with the post-race condition of the gelding, however, INVESTIGATE has now been sent for a brief spell and will look to return to racing in December.

DODGY ONE (C Grylls) – Trainer D Hollinshead advised Stewards DODGY ONE underwent chiropractor treatment on 17 October for overall general soreness and it is his intention to continue with the gelding's current preparation.

Race 4 ALL THE NEWS @ TRACKSIDE.CO.NZ 1200m

SAKO (M Cartwright) - Stable representative R Mildon reported to Stewards that the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of SAKO, and it is their intention to continue with the gelding's current preparation. R Mildon further advised that the stable may to look to nominate SAKO for the Waikato Thoroughbred Racing meeting on Saturday 28 October.

RACE COMMENTS**Race 1** | **STELLA ARTOIS MAIDEN 1400**

PERMISSIVE (J Fawcett) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

BALLISTIC MISS (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.

ST VINCENT (A Lawson-Carroll) - Crowded at the start. Placed in restricted room passing the 1100 metres making contact with the running rail and blundered, losing ground.

WILD DREAMS (T Mitchell) - Contacted leaving the barriers.

AMAZING FLUKE (V Colgan) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Crowded near the 1100 metres. Lost the off hind plate during the running.

LUCA TIVA (D Mansour) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Crowded near the 1100 metres.

LOOSE CHANGE (W Kennedy) - Checked near the 1100 metres.

LADY GEORGIANA (J Doyle) - Steadied after improving onto heels near the 1100 metres shifting inwards placing ST VINCENT in restricted room which contacted the running rail and blundered, losing ground.

N Parmar (SHOOTING STRIDE) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of LUCA TIVA and AMAZING FLUKE which were crowded inwards onto LOOSE CHANGE

which was checked near the 1100 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of N Parmar's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Thursday 24 October up to and including racing on Wednesday 6 November, 8 national riding days.

S Ralph (WILD DREAMS) - Issued with a warning for presenting WILD DREAMS late to the birdcage.

Race 2 | **TAB MAIDEN 1400**

WYNDSONG (D Mansour) - Slow to begin. Had to be steadied to avoid the heels of TAUPO DANCER which shifted inwards when not fully clear passing the 1100 metres. N Hailey was advised to exercise care.

McCLENAGHAN (B Jacobson) - Slow to begin.

LANIKAI (V Colgan) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced keenly in the middle stages having to be steadied off heels near the 700 metres.

ACES IN LACES (W Kennedy) - Raced greenly for a distance passing the 1100 metres.

SONORAN (N Parmar) - Raced wide without cover from near the 800 metres.

URLAR (M Cartwright) - Held up rounding the bend and early in the final straight.

SANTA CATALINA (J Doyle) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

Race 3 | **HEAD TO TRACKSIDE.CO.NZ 1100**

BONIFLEUR (N Parmar) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from an outside barrier. Lost the near hind plate during the running.

ROCHMIE RAY (W Kennedy) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from the outside barrier.

TOOTIE (J Doyle) – Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a small laceration to the tongue.

TOSSUFORIT (N Hailey) – Raced keenly through the middle stages.

MARKET PLACE (A Lawson-Carroll) – Lay outwards when placed under pressure near the 300 metres forcing FERNANDEZ wider.

FERNANDEZ (J Fawcett) – Forced wider passing the 300 metres. Lost the near front plate during the running.

ELECTRIC ZOU (S Spratt) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding would derive benefit from today's performance and a step up in distance.

Race 4 | **AUCKLAND CO-OP TAXIS MAIDEN 1200**

BOURBON PROOF (M Cartwright) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up rounding the final bend. Raced in restricted room for a distance approaching the 300 metres.

CAPTAIN ROY (J Fawcett) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Made the final bend awkwardly. Shifted outwards early in the final straight when attempting to obtain clear running before improving onto heels passing the 250 metres having to be steadied.

MISTA STITCH (N Parmar) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

TYCOON PRINCE (J Doyle) – Raced wide in the early stages.

BEAST OF BURDEN (T Mitchell) – Had to be steadied off heels when racing keenly near the 750 metres.

BERENHARD (K Myers) - Held up early in the final straight.

HIGHGRASS (S Spratt) - Steadied when placed in restricted room to the outside of MONTANA BAY which shifted outwards abruptly despite the efforts of its rider passing the 800 metres. Also contributing was slight inward movement from SAILOR GIRL.

LA PARISIENNE (V Colgan) – Steadied after improving into restricted room passing the 300 metres.

WITHALLMYFAITH (A Lawson-Carroll) – Improved onto heels having to be steadied passing the 300 metres.

J Fawcett (CAPTAIN ROY) – Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of BOURBON PROOF which was forced outwards forcing REGAL WINGS into the line of LA PARISIENNE which had to be steadied after improving into restricted room passing the 300 metres.

S Wenn (MISTA STITCH) - Issued with a warning for presenting MISTA STITCH late to the birdcage.

Race 5

NZB READY TO RUN SALE TRAINERS SERIES 1200

MERILLIAN (W Kennedy) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from the outside barrier.

KAPALUA (J Doyle) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

LITTERAL (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly. Shifted out and away from KAPALUA which shifted out slightly near the 450 metres making the bend awkwardly.

DUPONT (K Myers) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LITTLE THIEF (M Hashizume) – Checked near the 1100 metres. Raced keenly in the middle stages. Had to shift outwards early in the final straight to obtain clear running.

MILLER’S POINT (D Mansour) - Hampered near the 1100 metres.

MAYA BAY (J Fawcett) - Steadied when racing in restricted room near the 1100 metres.

LEGALLY BINDING (W Pinn) – Lay outwards when placed under pressure in the final straight. Rider dropped his outside rein near the 200 metres.

KASUKEDO (L Satherley) - Raced in restricted room passing the 100 metres.

W Pinn (LEGALLY BINDING) - Defended a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of MANORBIER which was dictated inwards checking LITTLE THIEF near the 1100 metres. Hampered as a result was MILLER’S POINT. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee found the charge proven and imposed a suspension of W Pinn’s licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Monday 28 October up to and including racing on Sunday 10 November, 8 national riding days.

Following this race, connections of the fourth placed runner LITTLE THIEF lodged a protest alleging interference near the 1100 metres by the first placed runner LEGALLY BINDING. After considering submissions, the Adjudicative

Committee dismissed the protest with placings standing 1st LEGALLY BINDING, 2nd PINKY PIE, 3rd DUPONT, 4th LITTLE THIEF.

Race 6 | **ELSDON PARK 2100**

ARBY (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

NEST EGG (W Kennedy) – Slow to begin. Improved into restricted room having to be steadied passing the 100 metres.

BOSCH (K Myers) - Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages.

NOT IDEAL (M Hashizume) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

D Hollinshead (DODGY ONE) - Issued with a warning for presenting DODGY ONE to race without the notified blinkers.

M Cartwright (SPORTING CHANCE) - Issued with a warning for weighing in 0.5 kgs over the weight at which he weighed out at.

Race 7 | **SISTEMA 1300**

BLUE SKY AT NIGHT (T Mitchell) - Slow to begin.

SONNET (D Mansour) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from an outside barrier. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

PERICLES (V Colgan) – Raced keenly through the early and middle stages shifting inwards near the 900 metres placing TO CATCH A THIEF in restricted room. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had over-raced through the middle stages and had failed to respond when asked to quicken with the impost of 60 kgs.

MOVING MELODY (N Parmar) - Raced wide in the early stages.

TO CATCH A THIEF (W Kennedy) - Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of PERICLES near the 900 metres.

NO SECRET (J Nishizuka) – Raced wide throughout.

MY ANNIE BELLE (M Hashizume) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 8 | **BARFOOT & THOMPSON 1600**

FASHIONISTA (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.

ROSETOWN PRINCESS (G Rooke) - Contacted leaving the barriers.

JOLTED (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly contacting APACHE ANNE.

APACHE ANNE (K Myers) - Contacted leaving the barriers.

SIDE EYE (T Mitchell) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

OVERRATED (S Spratt) - Raced keenly through the middle stages.
