RACE COMMENTS

Race 1	TOTAL TRANSPORT 1400m
BOURBON FALLS (J Riddell) - Slow to begin. Raced in restricted room over the final stages.	
MOLASSES (C Barnes) - Slow to begin. Rider advised the mare had lugged throughout.	
RICH ATTITUDE (K Chowdhooory) - Made the final bend awkwardly. Had to be steadied approaching the home turn when improving to the outside of DANJURO (T Davies), which shifted outwards. T Davies was shown footage of her ride in the presence of the Apprentice Mentor with Stewards accepting her explanation that her mount had shifted outwards further than intended. T Davies was issued with a warning.	
OFF TO THE NUNNERY (K Hercock) - Steadied near the 250 metres when BLACK ORLOV (R Goyaram) shifted inwards. R Goyaram was issued with a warning.	
MORE TO BE WRITTEN (E Sole) - Lay outwards rounding the final bend and throughout the straight.	
T Davies (DANJURO) - Issued with a warning for allowing her mount to shift outwards near the 400 metres when not clear of RICH ATTITUDE, which had to be steadied.	
R Goyaram (BLACK ORLOV) - Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift inwards near the 250 metres when not clear of OFF TO THE NUNNERY, which had to be steadied.	

Race 2	SUMMIT ELECTRICAL MAIDEN 1400m
The start of this race was delayed approximately 2 minutes when several runners proved difficult to load.	
YOU BID YOU BUY (K Myers) - Slow to begin.	
DUBAI'S POTIKI (H Grace) - Slow to begin. Raced greenly throughout, laying outwards in the final straight.	
FELUCCA (T Davies) - Made the first bend awkwardly	
ANIMUS (R Goyaram) - Steadied near the 1200 metres.	

ONLY THE LONELY (J Chung) - Raced keenly near the 1200 metres and improved up on to the heels of CLASS, having to be steadied abruptly, going back on to ANIMUS, which was checked. Shifted inwards under hard riding near the 200 metres prior to being taken outwards into clear running.

PALMAROW (K Hercock) - Hung throughout and had to be steadied near the 600 metres when improving on to heels.

SKIPPERS CANYON (J Riddell) - Performed poorly finishing well back. J Riddell had no excuse. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

LA KWIK (C Grylls) - Rider had no excuse, adding that his mount may improve with the run.

Race 3 | **WAVERLEY HARVESTING/BIG BLADE MAIDEN 1200m**

The start of this race was delayed approximately 4½ minutes after DOCTOR ASKAR escaped from behind the barrier prior to being recaptured and BLUE RATA WAREA proved slow to load. The Starter was spoken to by Stewards.

DOCTOR ASKAR (C Butler) - Dislodged rider during the preliminary and galloped some distance prior to being recaptured. Underwent and passed a pre-race veterinary inspection.

THE BIG PICTURE (N Parmar) - Slow to begin. Held up rounding the home turn.

TENSCAPE PRINCE (K Hercock) - Steadied when improving on to heels approaching the 900 metres and again near the 500 metres after over-reacting when being steadied.

BLUE RATA WAREA (J Chung) - Restrained when improving on to heels approaching the 800 metres.

Race 4 | **ENTAIN/NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN 1650m**

BELLE LAUREL (R Goyaram) - Slow to begin.

ZARAVELA (K Hercock) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

ELIVABER (N Parmar) - Got its head up when being restrained near the 1400 metres. Came together with LADY'S SECRET when both runners shifted ground near the 150 metres.

LADY'S SECRET (H Grace) - Came together with ELIVABER when both runners shifted ground near the 150 metres.

LEDAGO (K Chowdhury) - Had to stop riding when placed in restricted room when tiring near the 350 metres. A post-race veterinary examination was clear.

ZENAZED (L Sutherland) - Checked near the 1400 metres when LEICA ACE (C Grylls) shifted inwards when insufficiently clear.

LEICA ACE (C Grylls) - Shifted inwards near the 1400 metres when insufficiently clear of ZENAZED, which was checked.

C Grylls (LEICA ACE) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted LEICA ACE to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of ZENAZED which was checked near the 1400 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Monday, 28 October until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday, 6 November, 5 national riding days.

Race 5 | **CHRIS GRACE/TONY WILSON LIVESTOCK 1650m**

BEAVERTOWN BOY (K Myers) - Restrained shortly after the start to obtain cover from a wide draw.

TEXTBOOK (C Grylls) - Steadied when improving on to heels near the 1200 metres.

BENEFACTOR (H Grace) - Lay inwards, having to be straightened near the 150 metres. H Grace advised the mare would be better suited to a rain-affected track.

INMYSHADOW (L Kauri) - Hung throughout finishing very wide on the track. A post-race veterinary examination was clear.

TSHIEBWE (S Mxothwa) - Rider was of the opinion the gelding would derive benefit from today's race. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 6 | **TOM ANDREW CONTRACTING/MARK NEIL PGG MAIDEN 2200m**

The start of this race was delayed approximately 2½ minutes when PRIMO ATTITUDE proved difficult to load.

SATOMI (J Riddell) - Slow away.

JACKS PRIDE (H Grace) - Restrained from a wide draw to obtain cover. Angled outwards shortly after entering the final straight to obtain clear running.

PREDECESSOR (K Chowdhoooy)- Clipped a heel and blundered shortly after the start when KEEN ON BUBBLES (R Goyaram) shifted inwards.

KEEN ON BUBBLES (R Goyaram) - Shifted inwards shortly after the start into the line of PREDECESSOR, which clipped a heel.

PRIMO ATTITUDE (K Myers) - Over-raced in the early stages and dropped out, finishing last. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which found the gelding to have suffered an episode of Epistaxis. PRIMO ATTITUDE shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any race or trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian.

MADAM PELE (E Sole) - Raced three-wide in the early and middle stages.

R Goyaram (KEEN ON BUBBLES) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted KEEN ON BUBBLES to shift inwards shortly after the start when not sufficiently clear of PREDECESSOR, which clipped a heel and blundered. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday, 27 October until the conclusion of racing on Tuesday, 5 November, 5 national riding days.

Race 7 | **STEELFORMERS WAVERLEY CUP 2200m**

URENUI (E Sole) - Began awkwardly.

CANHEROC (K Chowdhoooy) - Issued with a warning after he angled his mount inwards inside the 100 metres when not fully clear of VERRY FLASH, which had to steady.

VERRY FLASH (A Riddell) - Steadied inside the 100 metres.

MEHZEBEEN (L Sutherland) - Momentarily hampered over the final stages when BATTLE SECRET shifted outwards sharply when shying at the winning post.

BATTLE SECRET (C Grylls) - Shifted outwards sharply under pressure inside the final 50 metres when shying at the winning post. This resulted in MEHZEBEEN, which was improving to its outside being hampered. Rider dropped his whip near the 100 metres.

Following the running of this race the rider of the 2nd placed MEHZEBEEN, L Sutherland, lodged a protest with the Adjudicative Committee alleging interference over the concluding stages by the 1st placed BATTLE SECRET. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee dismissed the protest with the placings standing 1st BATTLE SECRET, 2nd MEHZEBEEN, 3rd CANHEROC.

K Chowdhoo (CANHEROC) - Issued with a warning after permitting CANHEROC to shift inwards inside the 100 metres hampering VERRY FLASH, which had to steady.

TUTIN CANS (J Riddell) - Declared a late scratching at 3.27pm on veterinary advice.

TITICACA (K Chowdhoo) - Declared a late scratching at 5.00pm after dislodging the rider when parading then galloping some distance. K Chowdhoo sustained an injury to his ankle and will require a medical clearance prior to his next race-day ride.

MR TWINKELTOES (K Myers) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Held up for some distance in the home straight having to be angled outwards near the 150 metres.

VERISMO (C Barnes) - Made the bend near the 400 metres awkwardly. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which was clear.
