Race 2 - DRUMMOND & ETHERIDGE 1400m

PURE FICTION (B Murray) - Trainer Ms J Land reported to Stewards that on Monday 19 August PURE FICTION underwent a veterinary examination including x-rays to the right front fetlock and foot, with no abnormalities being detected. PURE FICTION was also examined by the stable farrier on Tuesday 20 August where the hoof pad was removed and revealed bruising to the left front sole. J Lang further advised it is her intention to continue on with the mare's preparation once the bruising subsides.

Race 3 - BARRY ROONEY MEMORIAL 1400m Maiden

MANZAPPEAL (A Balloo) - Stewards spoke with trainer Mr K Moore regarding the gelding hanging badly and being unable to be ridden out throughout the run home. K Moore advised he had been aware that MANZAPPEAL had proved a difficult ride at its previous start and he had elected to put a senior rider on for this race. K Moore subsequently advised that MANZAPPEAL has undergone dental treatment along with treatment for trauma to the inside of its mouth. K Moore added it was his intention to carry on with the current campaign, with a change of bit and a nose band being added to the gelding's raceday gear.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1	SPEIGHT'S SUMMIT ULTRA ON TAP MAIDEN 1400m
<p>RAGHALLAIGH (B May) - Slow to begin. Lay inwards in the run home and near the 200 metres shifted in placing LUV ROSAY in restricted room briefly before being straightened by its rider. B May was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>IFF I GET PAAID (Y Atchamah) - Slow to begin and further hampered when crowded. Had to be shifted outwards across heels passing the 250 metres to find clear racing room.</p> <p>LUV ROSAY (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin. Briefly raced in restricted room near the 200 metres.</p> <p>MACKENZIE RANGER (L Callaway) - Began awkwardly shifting out crowding outside runners.</p> <p>HEADING TO NOOSA (T Moseley) - Bounded at the start. Held up rounding the final bend and continued to be held up in the run home being denied a marginal run near the 300 metres and having to be heavily restrained when LEAR JET was straightened after initially shifting inwards and LUV ROSAY lay in marginally.</p> <p>LEAR JET (K Bakker) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p>	
Race 2	CJC STALLION TENDER OPEN NOW 1200m
<p>KINDRED SPIRIT (A Najib) - Reared as the start was effected and lay on the side of the barrier before beginning awkwardly losing considerable ground. Connections were advised that KINDRED SPIRIT must barrier trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next. Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages to the inside of THATS CHARMING which lay inwards and away from RED VIENNA (K Mudhoo) which also when inclined to lay inwards shifted in. K Mudhoo was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>RED VIENNA (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin. Lay inwards in the run home. Treated post-race for swelling to the left eye.</p> <p>THATS CHARMING (Y Atchamah) - Slow to begin. Lay inwards and away from an outside runner over the concluding stages and near the 75 metres had to be steadied to avoid heels.</p> <p>ANGELS WINGS (A Goindasamy) - Over raced in the early stages getting its head up on a number of occasions.</p> <p>JUSTANACE (L Callaway) - Over raced through the early stages.</p>	
Race 3	CHCH CASINO 27TH SOUTH ISLAND AWARDS 13 SEPTEMBER 1200m
<p>KING COUGAR (A Goindasamy) - Got its head up when over racing through the early stages before being allowed to lead passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>ZOULANDER (K Williams) - Restrained to take cover when LA BELLA NERA shifted out passing the 600 metres, with the rider explaining the gelding was not travelling well enough to keep the inside runner in and she did not wish to race three wide at this point.</p> <p>MORE THAN WORDS (L Hemi) - Lay inwards near the 150 metres when struck with the whip having to be straightened by the rider.</p>	
Race 4	CJC FEATURE NOMINATIONS CLOSE 27 AUGUST 3YO 1200m
<p>PORTHOUSE LADY (Y Atchamah) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p>SIR SIGARO (K Kwo) - Raced keenly in the early stages and had to be steadied away from heels near the 900 metres. Had to shift outwards across heels passing the 200 metres to find clear racing room. Rider reported the gelding had raced greenly throughout.</p>	

PEQUOT (K Bakker) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

OUR SALLYANN (T Comignaghi) - Got its head up for a distance when over racing passing the 700 metres.

DISNEY LADY (K Williams) - When questioned regarding performance, rider was of the opinion the filly may not have been suited to racing on the synthetic surface.

Race 5 | **CUP WEEK TICKETS ON SALE – SEPTEMBER 1 2200m**

RAARDY RAAR (K Bakker) - Slow to begin.

TAKE THAT (B May) - Slow to begin.

PROSERVE (L Sutherland) - Raced wide without cover until near the 1400 metres. Improved wide from the 600 metres. Was inclined to shift ground throughout the run home.

FLOAT (T Comignaghi) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home, having to be angled outwards across heels to gain clear racing room passing the 225 metres.

T Moseley (TIARA ROSE) - Issued with a warning after using his whip with an action which raised the rider's arm above shoulder height.

Race 6 | **GROUP 1 RACEDAY PARTY – 14 SEPTEMBER 1400m**

MITRE PEAK (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin and was then shifted inwards across runners' heels to obtain a position adjacent to the rail. Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home, having to be shifted inwards near the 300 metres to find clear racing room.

IN AWE (L Hemi) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

TURF WAR (T Comignaghi) - Briefly held up rounding the final bend.

WAR COURT (T Moseley) - When asked to comment on performance, rider advised he had had a comfortable enough run close to the pace in the early stages but had been under pressure in the home straight and only battled fairly over the concluding stages.

Race 7 | **TAB HANDICAP 1600m**

ANALYST (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin.

DA VINCI GIRL (A Najib) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

LIPPY (L Sutherland) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

DEEP BEAUTY (J Chung) - Briefly held up passing the 200 metres having to shift out passing the 150 metres to find clear racing room.

Race 8 | **RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE 1600m**

ANNELIESE (T Moseley) - Very slow to begin. Held up rounding the final bend only obtaining clear racing room passing the 150 metres.

EPILOGUE (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

IMABUSTER (J Chung) - Slow to begin. Raced wide throughout.

KOPUTAROA (L Callaway) - Over raced through the early and middle stages getting its head up on a number of occasions.

FAYTINA (K Bakker) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MOON ROCKET (L Sutherland) - Over raced for a distance passing the 1000 metres and had to be shifted outwards to avoid heels.

VAUDEVIRE (A Goindasamy) - Over raced for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

DENARAU (T Comignaghi) - Held up early in the run home only gaining clear racing room passing the 250 metres.

JUSTASKPERCY (D Tait) - Held up on entering the final straight and again passing the 100 metres.
