Race 7 SISTEMA 1300m

MY ANNIE BELLE (M Hashizume) – Co-trainer K Kelso reported to Stewards that on Monday 21 October, MY ANNIE BELLE, underwent a veterinarian examination which included blood tests with no abnormalities been detected. K Kelso further advised it is the stables intention to continue on with the mare's current preparation and may look to nominate MY ANNIE BELLE at the Waikato Thoroughbred Racing meeting on Saturday 9 November.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1	ARMORY STANDING AT MAPPERLEY STUD 3YO 1200
<p>DETRIMENTAL (J Riddell) – Began awkwardly. Over-raced in the early stages. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that he had been disappointed in the run, however, could offer no excuse.</p> <p>FILLYGIZALOOK (J Nishizuka) – Contacted and forced wider entering the final straight.</p> <p>BRADLEY (J Doyle) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Had to be steadied off heels near the 1150 metres.</p> <p>ARUNDEL CASTLE (A Lawson-Carroll) - Shifted out making contact with FILLYGIZALOOK entering the final straight which was forced wider. A Lawson-Carroll was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.</p> <p>S Marsh (FILLYGIZALOOK) - Issued with a Minor Infringement and fined \$50 for failing to declare a rider for FILLYGIZALOOK by the required time.</p> <p>Following this race the track was upgraded to Good 4.</p>	
Race 2	SADDLERY WAREHOUSE CAMBRIDGE & TAURANGA MAIDEN 1600
<p>PENNINE WAY (J Riddell) – Slow to begin. Held up rounding the bend before shifting out entering the final straight making contact with BAMBOOZLE. Lost the left front plate during the running.</p> <p>URLAR (G Rooke) – Knuckled at the start unbalancing its rider.</p> <p>ISLAND LIFE (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly. Held up until approaching the 300 metres. Shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages.</p> <p>FOUR SQUARE PETE (R Elliot) – Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance the rider could not offer any excuse, however recommended to connections that the gelding would benefit from the removal of ear covers.</p> <p>BAMBOOZLE (J Doyle) - Slow to begin. Contacted entering the final straight.</p> <p>LADY LIZZO (B Jacobson) - Over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>KING WILLIAM (T Newman) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>ST VINCENT (A Lawson-Carroll) – Over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>J Riddell (PENNINE WAY) - Issued with a warning after weighing in 0.5 kgs over the weight at which he weighed out at.</p>	
Race 3	EPIC JOURNEYS USA WITH GEORGE & WHEELS TOUR 1600
<p>ASGARD (G Rooke) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>ABOUT TIME (W Kennedy) – Began awkwardly. Raced wide without cover through the middle stages. Shifted out passing the 200 metres inconveniencing BOURBON EMPRESS then continued to lay out passing the 100 metres forcing BOURBON EMPRESS wider.</p> <p>NOVAK (T Newman) – Crowded shortly after the start.</p> <p>TRIGON LAD (S Fisher) – Raced three wide rounding the final bend. Stewards questioned the riding tactics in particular the reasons why she continued to ride her mount forward from near the 1000 metres when racing outside the lead rounding the final bend. S Fisher in the presence of her employer M Rogers explained that her instructions</p>	

had been to lead and not to allow the gelding to switch off. When she had been unable to obtain the lead, she had elected to continue to urge TRIGON LAD as per her instructions. Stewards noted her comments however under [Rule 356(2)] S Fisher was referred to the Rider Skills Review panel.

STILL BANGON (S Spratt) - Raced wide through the middle stages. Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 200 metres when runners either side shifted ground.

KHAFRE (J Fawcett) - Lay out rounding the final bend.

BOURBON EMPRESS (M McNab) – Inconvenienced passing the 200 metres then forced wider passing the 100 metres.

BLUE SKY AT NIGHT (T Mitchell) - Improved onto heels passing the 200 metres having to be firmly restrained.

W Kennedy (ABOUT TIME) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift out when not sufficiently clear of BOURBON EMPRESS which was inconvenienced passing the 200 metres before being forced wider passing the 100 metres.

Race 4

NEW WORLD 1300

OH NO NO NO (J Nishizuka) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

EL BANDOLERO (T Newman) - Slow to begin. Had to shift inwards passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

QUEEN ZOU (M McNab) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that he had been satisfied with the run and in his opinion the mare would derive benefit from today's race.

LOHNAGAN (J Riddell) – Lay in becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 200 metres having to be straightened.

CLEAT (M Hashizume) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

Race 5

BAYLEYS TAURANGA 1300

THERAPEUTIC (J Nishizuka) - Slow to begin.

ELECTRIC ZOU (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly.

SALTNESSE (J Fawcett) - Raced wide without cover through the early and middle stages.

HIGHLY ANTICIPATED (W Kennedy) – Raced wide through the middle stages. Lost the right plate during the running.

NO AGENDA NIGEL (B Rogerson) - Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 800 metres to the inside of MY BOY ZAC which shifted in slightly away from LIVE ON AIR (M Hashizume) which was awkwardly placed inside the heels of HIGHLY ANTICIPATED (W Kennedy). W Kennedy and M Hashizume were both advised to exercise care. Held up for a distance passing the 200 metres.

LIVE ON AIR (M Hashizume) - Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

P Mirabelli (SALTNESSE) - Issued with a Minor Infringement and fined \$50 for failing to declare a rider for SALTNESSE by the required time.

<p>ROCKBURN (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>TWAIN (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p>SCREAMIN EAGLE (A Lawson-Carroll) - Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground.</p> <p>JOSHUA BROWN (L Satherley) - Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground. Rider dropped her whip near the 350 metres. Improved into restricted room passing the 100 metres having to be steadied.</p> <p>TANGANYIKA (M Hashizume) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages from the outside barrier.</p> <p>SCOUSER (M McNab) – Lost the near front plate during the running.</p>	
Race 7	BAYLEYS MOUNT MAUNGANUI 2100
<p>BRIAN LAMONT (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>HOT SALSA (D Danis) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>TAKEITEASY (T Newman) – Knuckled leaving the barriers. Raced wide in the early stages. Crowded when weakening passing the 500 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>NORTHERN RAIDER (B Jacobson) – Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.</p>	
Race 8	AZTECH SIGNS 2100
<p>THE ODYSSEY (C Barnes) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover from the 1500 metres.</p> <p>FLY MY WEY (J Fawcett) – Held up for a distance rounding the final bend.</p> <p>KHAN HUNTER (M Sanson) - Lay out rounding the final bend forcing NOT IDEAL wider.</p> <p>NOT IDEAL (G Rooke) - Forced wider rounding the final bend.</p> <p>DIONYSUS (M Hashizume) - Inconvenienced passing the 50 metres by JOLTED which shifted in when not fully clear. V Colgan was advised to exercise greater care.</p>	
Race 9	FINANCIAL SERVICES 1300
<p>NAVIGATOR (M McNab) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up passing the 500 metres before improving into a marginal run between LUX LIBERTAS and MALI STON with NAVIGATOR being crowded outwards onto LUX LIBERTAS which was contacted and forced wider crowding DIGGER which had to be steadied when weakening approaching the 350 metres. Also contributing to this incident was slight outward movement from MALI STON. M McNab was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.</p> <p>BELLA WATERS (W Kennedy) - Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground. Held up rounding the final bend and again passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>MARY SHAN (G Rooke) – Restrained in the early stages from an outside barrier.</p> <p>DIGGER (L Satherley) - Raced three wide without cover through the early and middle stages. Crowded when weakening entering the final straight.</p>	

LUX LIBERTAS (M Hashizume) – Contacted having to be steadied passing the 350 metres.

Stewards withheld payment until they had spoken to all riders regarding a dog walker which had entered the track during the running near the 800 metres with all riders advising that this had no effect on their horse's performance. Stewards spoke to the Club regarding this with the Club undertaking to ensure that systems would be implemented to prevent unauthorised personnel entering the track in future.

Race 10

MILLS REEF WINES 1600

WREN (K Stott) - Reared as the start was effected, losing ground. Contacted and unbalanced approaching the 300 metres.

COMMANDING ASPECT (M Hashizume) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the mare had failed to handle today's track conditions.

JUJU POP (A Lawson-Carroll) - Raced three wide without cover through the early and middle stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the mare to have experienced an episode of bilateral Epistaxis. JUJU POP shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any race of trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian.

OUR MILLY BEE (D Danis) – Held up rounding the final bend before improving into a marginal run inside of THE DIVINER approaching the 300 metres with THE DIVINER then laying in crowding OUR MILLY BEE. When being corrected by its rider OUR MILLY BEE shifted outwards making contact with the hindquarters of WREN.

THE DIVINER (G Rooke) – Lay in passing the 300 metres then when being corrected by its rider shifted outwards becoming awkwardly placed inside of WREN having to be steadied.
