RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 VALE TOM FRASER FJC LIFE MEMBER MAIDEN 1600m

AUTUMN BEAUTY (T Davies) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact with DOWNTROU losing ground. Raced keenly through the early stages having to be steadied. Raced in restricted room near the 400 metres, then being held up having to be steadied away from the heels of the weakening TOWROPE and did not obtain clear running until near the 200 metres.

DOWNTROU (L Sutherland) - Contacted leaving the barriers. Steadied near the 1400 metres. Held up early in the final straight.

EL TAJIN (E Sole) - Jumped away awkwardly.

LATER BOY (C Lindsay) - Commenced to weaken from the 600 metres and was not persevered with finishing a distant last. When questioned rider advised that the mare had appeared to change stride when placed under pressure and failed to respond to her riding. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

TOWROPE (H Grace) - Finished towards the rear. Rider was unable to offer any excuse advising that the gelding had been quickly beaten once placed under pressure and may have found today's conditions too testing. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to have a slow rate of recovery, with a high heart rate along with a minor wound to the right hind.

Race 2 RATANUI DEVELOPMENT COMPANY 2200m

COMEDY (L Kauri) - Slow to begin. Held up early in the final straight.

AIN'T BAD (M Singh) - Slow to begin.

MONKEY TOWN (D Cooper) - Began awkwardly.

SANDOKU (L Sutherland) - Raced keenly through the middle stages. When questioned rider advised that the mare had not helped its chances by over-racing and had then been unable to finish the race off in its first attempt at todays distance.

COCKTAIL LAD (J Chung) - Raced wide without cover in the early stages before being allowed to improve forward outside the leader near the 1400 metres. Finished towards the rear. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

RUFFHOUSE ROSIE (T Davies) - Raced keenly through the middle stages.

MASSO (L Hemi) - Raced in restricted room passing the 900 metres then striking a heel of KEEN ON BUBBLES and blundering.

DICTATION (K Hercock) – Quickly beaten once placed under pressure dropping out to finished last. When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse other than the gelding having had a long preparation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 3 RACE CHARITY PARTNERS RIDING FOR THE DISABLED 1200m

MY FATHER'S GUN (L Kauri) - Lay outwards shortly after the startcontacting FLORIN. Rider dropped his whip passing the 150 metres.

FLORIN (L Sutherland) - Contacted shortly after the start. Held up rounding the final turn, having to angle outwards to obtain clear racing room.

THATZ DAISY (T Bau) - Raced keenly in the lead in the early to middle stages then was quickly beaten once placed under pressure entering the home straight, weakening out to finish a distant last. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the mare to be displaying a poor rate of recovery. Stewards advised trainer A Davies that they held concerns regarding the poor overall performance record of the mare over the previous 12 months, advising her that THATZ DAISY was stood down from any further racing for an indefinite period.

Race 4 ON TRACK 1200m

REIGN IT IN (J Chung) - Slow to begin. Commenced to over-race shortly after the start. Was a beaten runner early in the straight finishing a distant last. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to be displaying a poor rate of recovery.

IVY DAZZLER (M Singh) - Slow to begin.

Race 5 SOUTHERN DEMOLITION 1400m

The reason for the late declaration of rider for DOLLYBIRD was accepted.

LINCOLN TOWERS (T Comignaghi) - Began awkwardly contacting LATEST MODEL. Commenced to weaken near the 600 metres dropping out to finish a distant last. Rider reported that the gelding had failed to handle todays track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

LATEST MODEL (M Singh) - Contacted at the start losing ground.

FLIGHT PLAN (J Chung) - Improved onto heels having to be steadied near the 600 metres.

Race 6 COURTESY FORD RED CRAZE BOWL 1400m

TANZANITE ROSE (C Butler) - Slow to begin. Checked and contacted the outside running rail passing the 400 metres unbalancing the rider.

MAROTIRI MOLLY (K Hercock) - Held up rounding the final bend.

OUR JUMALA (H Grace) - Held up entering the final straight then becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of MASTER MARKO (D Cooper) when attempting to shift to the outside of that runner, having to be steadied and shift back to the inside. OUR JUMALA was again held up near the 150 metres then unable to obtain clear running for the remainder of the race.

FONTEYN (T Davies) - Crowded passing the 400 metres.

MASTER MARKO (D Cooper) – Shifted outwards under pressure early in the straight, D Cooper was advised that he must make more of an effort to straighten his mount than he had on this occasion.

CHANTILLY LACE (L Sutherland) - Held up near the 150 metres.

H Grace (OUR JUMALA) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted OUR JUMALA to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of FONTEYN which was dictated outwards onto TANZANITE ROSE which was checked passing the 400 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Tuesday 5 November until the conclusion of racing on Tuesday 12 November, 5 national riding days.

Race 7 MODE TECHNOLOGY FEILDING CUP 2100m

PRINCE ALBY (D Cooper) - Began awkwardly.

VERRY FLASH (L Sutherland) - Raced keenly through the early stages.

DROP OF SOMETHING (C Butler) - Hung inwards in the final straight and then could not be ridden out fully over the concluding stages.

Race 8 FEILDING HOTEL 1600m

ARJAY'S FLIGHT (T Comignaghi) - Slow to begin. Contacted approaching the 800 metres when TISSE (S Mxothwa) shifted outwards. S Mxothwa was advised to exercise care.

TISSE (S Mxothwa) - Inclined to lay inwards early in the straight.

SHELBYROCK'N (E Sole) - Lay outwards over the concluding stages having to be straightened briefly inconveniencing FOOTLOOSE approaching the 100 metres.

FOOTLOOSE (T Davies) - Briefly inconvenienced 100 metres.

HERBERT (L Douglas) – Failed to respond when placed under pressure in the straight dropping out to finished last. When questioned rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle todays track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

C Butler (MARGHERITA VELOCE) - Reminded of her obligation to ride her mounts out fully to the finish when relaxing her ride over the concluding stages.
