### Race 4 ON TRACK 1200m

**REIGN IT IN (J Chung)** – Trainer Mr. R Bergerson reported to Stewards that on Monday 4 November, REIGN IT IN underwent a veterinary examination which revealed a virus, receiving appropriate treatment. R Bergerson further advised once treatment has finished, REIGN IT IN, will be sent for a spell.

#### Race 2 PENINSULAR BEACHFRONT RESORT MAIDEN 1200m

**OUR TIME (L Sutherland)** - Trainer Mr. P Lock reported to Stewards, upon return to the stable, OUR TIME, underwent an endoscopic examination which revealed mucus in the trachea, which has been treated accordingly. P Lock further advised it is his intention to carry on with OUR TIME'S current preparation.

#### **RACE COMMENTS**

#### Race 1 LAMB PETERS PRINT MAIDEN 1000m

**AGENT BLACK HAND** (J Chung) - Slow to begin. Crowded near the 75 metres having to steady when racing in restricted room to the inside of WILD THYME, which was taken inwards by PRINCESS SENECA.

**SHEZAHAPPYONE** (C Lindsay) - Jumped awkwardly crowding WILD THYME.

WILD THYME (K Hercock) - Crowded at the start. Crowded and had to steady near the 75 metres.

VITACI (K Chowdhoory) - Slow to begin.

**UNCLE BARRY** (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout. Lay inwards throughout the run home and near the 100 metres shifted inwards before being straightened by its rider. Again, shifted inwards near the winning post. L Sutherland was advised to exercise care and straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion.

BRAZEN AFFAIR (M McNab) - Slow to begin.

**PRINCESS SENECA** (T Davies) - Raced greenly in the home straight, laying inwards badly near the 150 metres and shifted in and away from UNCLE BARRY, crowding inside runners. T Davies, in the presence of the Apprentice Mentor, was shown a replay of the incident near the 150 metres and advised that if her mount it laying inwards, she should not be drawing the whip. Continued to lay inwards and near the 75 metres, shifted inwards despite the efforts of the rider, crowding AGENT BLACK HAND and WILD THYME. Had to steady off the heels of UNCLE BARRY near the 50 metres when that runner lay inwards before being straightened.

Track further Downgraded to Heavy 9, retrospective to Race 1.

# Race 2 JOHNSON BROTHERS 1000m

**HELLO MY DEAR** (K Hercock) - Improved on to heels having to be steadied near the 650 metres.

**CARSOLIO** (M McNab) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout. Shifted inwards under pressure near the 100 metres having to be straightened by its rider. Rider reported the colt had never been comfortable in today's Heavy track conditions.

# Race 3 LIQUORLAND MASTERTON MAIDEN 1000m

WHOOSHKA (K Chowdhoory) - Slow to begin.

**JUST A DROP** (T Allan) - Restrained shortly after the start to obtain cover.

**THE GOLDEN BOY** (L Kauri) - Began awkwardly shifting inwards, crowding ALCARAZ. Dictated outwards near the 200 metres when WHOOSHKA (K Chowdhoory) shifted ground looking for clear racing room. K Chowdhoory was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

**ALCARAZ** (J Riddell) - Contacted and crowded at the start, losing ground. Held up rounding the final bend gaining clear racing near the 300 metres.

**TESTING** (M McNab) - Shifted outwards at the start, hampering OSCAR.

**OSCAR** (C Barnes) - Crowded at the start, losing ground.

SWEET AS TAVI (T Davies) - Raced greenly near the 800 metres and shifted away from inside runners.

LA DULCIN'EE (C Lindsay) - Raced wide throughout.

Track further Downgraded to Heavy 10 retrospective to Race 3.

#### Race 4 AUTOGROOM-KOOL TINTZ 1000m

**GEE STRING** (J Riddell) - Slow to begin. Held up early in the straight, and when angling for a run near the 100 metres was dictated outwards by DIOMEDES, which was taken wider by FASHION ICON which lay away from an inside runner, making contact with the tiring HAVARTI.

**HAVARTI** (K Chowdhoory) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Steadied of heels near the 700 metres. Contacted near the 100 metres when tiring. Rider reported the gelding had not handled today's Heavy track conditions.

**DIOMEDES** (C Butler) - Raced wide throughout.

FASHION ICON (T Davies) - Held up entering the straight.

**BEDTIME STORY** (L Sutherland) - Held up rounding the final bend.

IMA BRAZEN ONE (M Hashizume) - Rider reported his mount was not comfortable in today's Heavy track conditions.

#### Race 5 WAIBUILD 1600m

**DANJURO** (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly, losing ground.

**UP THE WAHS** (K Hercock) - Raced three-wide without cover. Rider advised the gelding had not been comfortable in today's Heavy track conditions.

**CALL A FRIEND** (M Hashizume) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages, getting its head up.

**NO BIZZ** (T Davies) - Lay outwards over the concluding stages shifting ground outwards and could not be ridden to full advantage having to be continually straightened.

#### Race 6 BOND ST BAR 1600m

**INMYSHADOW** (C Lindsay) - Restrained from a wide draw to obtain cover.

MCKHAN (L Kauri) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

SWEET JINEEN (M McNab) - Raced three-wide before taking the mare forward to lead near the 1200 metres.

**FLYING CELEBRATION** (J Chung) - Raced wide throughout.

**OPAWA JACK** (L Sutherland) - Lay outwards in the run home.

**THE UGLY SISTER** (K Hercock) - Rider could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing effort.

#### Race 7 WRIGHT CABINS MAIDEN 1300m

There was a delay of approximately 3 minutes to the start of this race due to LINARA becoming fractious in its barrier, having to be removed to undergo a veterinary examination, being cleared to run.

**THE PHANTOM FOX** (E Sole) - Jumped awkwardly, crowding outside runners.

**PRESTISSIMO** (J Chung) - Crowded at the start. Raced wide into the first bend before improving to lead near the 1000 metres. Lay outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

**PIXIE CARAMEL** (L Kauri) - Crowded and buffeted at the start, losing ground. Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

**DON PEDRO** (L Sutherland) - Crowded at the start, losing some ground.

**DENDO** (T Davies) - Steadied racing into the first bend near the 1100 metres.

WAL (M McNab) - Had to be steadied away from heels near the 1100 metres when crowded for room.

**LINARA** (K Chowdhoory) - Rider advised the gelding had failed to handle today's Heavy track conditions.

**J Chung** (PRESTISSIMO) - Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift inwards, taking DENDO inwards on to WAL, which had to be steadied racing into the bend near the 1100 metres.

#### Race 8 MITRE 10 MEGA MASTERTON 1300m

**PLATINUM DESIGNS** (J Riddell) - Bounded at the start, losing ground.

MAKKALDEE (K Hercock) - Restrained to obtain cover after jumping from a wide draw.

WAITUI ROSE (L Kauri) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

**SAY I DO** (K Williams) - Raced keenly in the early stages and near the 1200 metres had to be steadied away from the heels of VICTORTHEINFLICTOR (T Davies). T Davies was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

**BEAN A PLEASURE** (C Barnes) - Steadied away from heels as the field made the bend near the 900 metres when racing keenly.

**FONSI** (J Chung) - Steadied when improving onto the heels of VICTORTHEINFLICTOR near the 900 metres. When asked to comment on the performance of a favoured runner, rider advised the gelding was not comfortable in today's Heavy track conditions.
