Race 6 AUCKLAND CO-OP TAXIS MAIDEN 1600m

JUST A KARIN (L Satherley) - Trainer A Morley reported to Stewards the mare underwent a veterinary examination on Thursday 7 November, which revealed muscle soreness to the right hind leg and underwent chiropractor treatment for overall general soreness. A Morley further advised it is his intention to carry on with JUST A KARIN'S current preparation.

Race 6 TAB MAIDEN 1400m

PROUDTOBEHERE (W Kennedy) – Trainer A Forsman reported to Stewards he was satisfied with the post-race condition PROUBTOBEHERE, however, will look to apply a tongue tie prior to the mare's next race day start.

Race 2 IMPACT OFF ROAD 1400m

BOXMOSS (W Kennedy) – Trainer C Wood reported to Stewards he was satisfied with the post-race condition of BOXMOSS, and it is his intention to carry on with the gelding's current preparation.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 IXOM 3YO 1400

VERMELHO (R Goyaram) - Began awkwardly.

BRADLEY (N Parmar) - Knuckled at the start. Contacted passing the 200 metres.

WIND RUSH (G Rooke) - Began awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early stages. Had to shift out approaching the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

ARUNDEL CASTLE (A Lawson-Carroll) - Shifted in and away from PROSEGUR making brief contact with BRADLEY passing the 200 metres.

Following this race the track was upgraded to Soft 7.

Race 2 DEVAN PLASTICS MAIDEN 1600

YOU BID YOU BUY (R Goyaram) - Slow to begin.

GEETEE FORTY (D Danis) - Slow to begin then hampered shortly after. Shifted in approaching the 100 metres making contact with the hindquarters of PRIVATE TREATY which was unbalanced.

PENNINE WAY (J Riddell) - Slow to begin. Over-raced in the early stages.

PRIVATE TREATY (W Kennedy) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Contacted and unbalanced approaching the 100 metres.

MUSTANG (M Sanson) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

SANTA CATALINA (D Mansour) - Lay out rounding the final bend.

Race 3	TAURANGA HARDWARE & PLUMBING 1200
<p>NEW MILLENNIUM (T Mitchell) – Over raced in the early stages.</p> <p>I’MUNSTOPPABLE (A Lawson-Carroll) - Raced wide without cover in the early stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the mare to have a slower than normal recovery.</p> <p>FANCYPANTS (J Chung) – Over-raced through the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding over-racing during the running had been detrimental to its chances and was of the opinion it would be better suited to more rain affected footing.</p> <p>KIVA HAN (J Nishizuka) - Rider dropped his whip passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>A Lawson-Carroll (I’MUNSTOPPABLE) - Defended a charge in that he failed to ride his mount out to the end of the race when there was a reasonable chance of finishing in fifth position. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee found the charge proven and imposed a fine of \$300.</p>	
Race 4	DOMINATOR GARAGE DOORS TAURANGA 1200
<p>WHISKEY N' RYE (U Holmquist) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>MISS BO BEEP (M Hashizume) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>MARKET PLACE (J Nishizuka) - Began awkwardly. Went off stride passing the 200 metres when racing close to the running rail.</p> <p>KAI MOANA (N Parmar) - Slow to begin. Raced three wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the mare would benefit from some easing of the ground.</p> <p>INCA BELLE (V Colgan) – Over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>AMAZONIA (D Mansour) - Rider reported that the mare had felt indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the mare to be 3/5 lame in the right foreleg. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.</p> <p>Following this race the track was upgraded to Soft 6.</p>	
Race 5	O’CONNOR WARREN INSURANCE BROKERS 2100
<p>SPECTRIER (A Lawson-Carroll) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>JACK IN THE BOX (M Sanson) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>TE ATATU MEMPHIS (L Satherley) – Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>KHUTULUN KHAN (D Danis) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>MAGICAL ROAD (U Holmquist) - Had to be steadied off heels when racing keenly approaching the 1200 metres.</p> <p>KING KHAN (J Nishizuka) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the straight.</p> <p>NORTHERN RAIDER (B Jacobson) - Lay outwards rounding the final bend forcing PACIFICO wider on the track.</p>	

PACIFICO (R Goyaram) - Forced wider on the track rounding the final bend.

Race 6 LASER PLUMBING WAIHI BEACH 1400

MAKE TIME (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow to begin.

HARLECH (J Nishizuka) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Inconvenienced when weakening passing the 100 metres by STONYBRECK which was dictated outwards by SUMI.

SAINT BATHANS (M Hashizume) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

GEE CEE (D Mansour) - Held up for the majority of the final straight.

SUMI (S Mxothwa) - Held up for clear running until the 100 metres.

STONYBRECK (V Colgan) – Dictated wider passing the 100 metres. STONYBRECK underwent a post-race veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination which found the gelding to have experienced an episode of bilateral Epistaxis. STONYBRECK shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any race or trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian.

IMPENDABELLE (G Rooke) - When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the mare had hung outwards throughout and was of the opinion that it would be better suited to racing left-handed. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

P Gerard (HARLECH) - Issued with a warning for presenting HARLECH late to the parade ring.

S Mxothwa (SUMI) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of STONYBRECK which was dictated into the line of HARLECH which had to be steadied to avoid heels passing the 100 metres.

A Sharrock (SUMI) - Issued with a Minor Infringement and fined \$50 for presenting SUMI to race without the notified blinkers.

Race 7 GARTSHORE TAURANGA STAKES WFA 1600 (G2)

ENRIGHT (N Parmar) - Blundered leaving the barriers losing ground. Lay out rounding the final bend resulting in MALI STON becoming awkwardly placed on heels and shifting inwards to obtain clear running resulting in LADIES MAN having to be steadied after attempting to improve into a marginal run near the 300 metres.

PEARL OF ALSACE (J Riddell) – Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

BELLA WATERS (W Kennedy) - Held up early in the final straight. Received veterinary attention post-race after suffering a laceration to the right knee.

LADIES MAN (M Hashizume) – Held up rounding the final bend before attempting to improve into a marginal run being denied clear running when not fully established into the run passing the 300 metres and as a result was held up until shifting inwards approaching the 100 metres.

MALI STON (A Lawson-Carroll) - Lay out when placed under pressure over the concluding stages.

D & B Weatherley (MALI STON) - Issued with a warning for presenting MALI STON late to the parade ring.

Race 8	BOOTH'S LOGISTICS 1600
<p>LADY MOANA (R Goyaram) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>TOMMY PERFECT (A Lawson-Carroll) - Knuckled leaving the barriers.</p> <p>ROSETOWN PRINCESS (W Kennedy) - Improved onto heels having to be steadied near the 1100 metres inconveniencing POLAMALU.</p> <p>POLAMALU (U Holmquist) – Inconvenienced near the 1100 metres.</p> <p>BASSOROC (G Rooke) - Checked near the 375 metres.</p> <p>J Nishizuka (GIGI) – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift outwards when insufficiently clear of BASSOROC which was checked near the 375 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of J Nishizuka's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 24 November up to and including racing on Sunday 1 December, 5 national riding days.</p>
