Racing Te Aroha – Tuesday 12 November 2023 Race 7 RIVERSLEY PARK 1400

An adjourned hearing was held prior to Race 1 today

K Stott (ALAVISTO) - Defended a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of STAPHEE which clipped a heel and fell dislodging its rider near the 350 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee found the charge proven and imposed a suspension of K Stott's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 23 November up to and including racing on Saturday 14 December, 3 weeks.

Race 1	MACMILLAN ACCOUNTANTS MAIDEN 1950
<p>DENZEL (U Holmquist) – Slow to begin. Had to be straightened by its rider passing the 300 metres after shifting in slightly. Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>THE YES GIRL (T Newman) – Slow to begin. Attempted to improve into a marginal run approaching the 300 metres having to be steadied when runners either side shifted ground. Improved into restricted room just prior to the winning post.</p> <p>SATOMI (J Riddell) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>LINKIN PARK (M Hashizume) – Over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>MOON (R Goyaram) – Raced wide without cover in the early stages.</p> <p>MONGOLIAN JUBILEE (K Myers) - Over-raced through the early and middle stages.</p>	
Race 2	CAMPBELL INFRASTRUCTURE 1230
<p>TEARS OF VICTORY (M Sanson) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>GLORAFILIA (R Elliot) – Over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>ROSES N’ BEAUS (L Sutherland) – Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>NOIVERN (R Goyaram) – Lay out rounding the final bend.</p> <p>RUM AND RUMOUR (B Rogerson) – Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room near the 300 metres when racing to the outside of NOIVERN which lay out, and inside of GLORAFILIA which had shifted in slightly. R Goyaram and R Elliot were both advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.</p> <p>SILKDEGREES (C Grylls) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse. Trainer P Stevens advised that it was now his intention to spell the mare.</p> <p>Following this race the track was upgraded to Good 3.</p>	
Race 3	ARAWA PARK HOTEL ROTORUA MAIDEN 1230
<p>CHLOE’S COMET (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly losing ground after being fractious in the barrier.</p> <p>MISS MADRIDISTA (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>ADELANTE (G Rooke) - Began awkwardly making contact with MALLOW.</p> <p>TITAN (J Riddell) - Hampered leaving the barriers, losing ground. Held up throughout the final straight.</p> <p>PENMAN (M Cartwright) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>SABRINA HALL (K Stott) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the straight.</p>	

Race 4	VAN DYKS MAIDEN 1560
<p>KUROKO (J Doyle) - Received farrier attention at the barriers. Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room near the 150 metres when runners on either side shifted ground.</p> <p>DANCIN IN THE DARK (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly in the middle stages.</p> <p>ZANZIBAR (K Stott) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>MOHI PLACE (T Mitchell) – Raced wide without cover through the early and middle stages.</p> <p>CAPTAIN ROY (M McNab) – Over-raced in the middle stages.</p> <p>LUCKY JUSTIFY (P Singh) - Raced greenly throughout making the final bend awkwardly.</p> <p>JUSTIFY THAT (R Elliot) - Inconvenienced when weakening passing the 200 metres.</p>	

Race 5	HAVE YOUR FUNCTION AT ARAWA PARK MAIDEN 1560
<p>ASTUCIA (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>REIMAGINED (M Cartwright) – Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover from the outside barrier. Shifted out passing the 250 metres making contact with DARREN MICHIE. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the slow pace in the early to middle stages had been detrimental to its chances and was of the opinion that the filly would be better suited to more rain affected footing. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the mare to have an elevated respiratory rate.</p> <p>ELOISE (K Stott) – Over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>ANIMUS (V Colgan) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>DARREN MICHIE (L Sutherland) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Over-raced in the middle stages. Contacted and forced wider passing the 250 metres.</p> <p>LADY GEORGIANA (J Doyle) – Over-raced through the early and middle stages. Lay out entering the final straight. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the filly would be better suited to more rain affected footing.</p> <p>ROMANIN (G Rooke) - Held up until near the 100 metres.</p> <p>M Cartwright (REIMAGINED) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of DARREN MICHIE which was contacted and forced wider near the 250 metres.</p>	

Race 6	ENTAIN/NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN 1400
<p>TRUE PROMISE (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>SETHITO (C Grylls) - Raced keenly in the early stages when leading.</p> <p>SKIPPING (M Hashizume) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>RIDGEVIEW VICKY (N Parmar) - Held up rounding the final bend. Shifted outwards making contact with MISS MANZOR near the 250 metres.</p>	

MISS MANZOR (W Kennedy) - Contacted near the 250 metres. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the filly had raced greenly throughout and was of the opinion that it would derive benefit from today's race.

BEST DRESSED (K Stott) - Lay out rounding the final bend. Eased down in the final straight when out of contention. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the mare had hung throughout and proved difficult to ride. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

MISELLABEL (V Colgan) - Received veterinary attention following the race to an abrasion on the left hind fetlock.

Race 7	SHERLOCK CONTRACTING MAIDEN 1400
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PINKER (J Riddell) - Became fractious in the barrier and was removed to undergo a veterinary inspection being late scratched at 4.10 pm. Connections were advised that the gelding would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

INSTINCT (J Doyle) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination at the barrier and was cleared to start.

CRACKERCOL (M Cartwright) - Slow to begin.

DEEP WATER BAY (M McNab) - Slow to begin.

WHY NOT ME (K Stott) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

LIVING IN HOPE (R Goyaram) - Raced wide in the early stages before improving forward to lead near the 1000 metres.

FURY'S DAUGHTER (T Newman) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

SUITED AND BOOTED (R Elliot) – Improved onto heels having to shift ground outwards near the 450 metres.

BLACK OPAL (B Rogerson) - Improved onto heels passing the 400 metres having to be steadied then raced in restricted room for a distance.

VIVACE (M Hashizume) – Held up until near the 150 metres. Lay out over the concluding stages.

L O'Sullivan & A Scott (CRACKERCOL) - Issued with a Minor Infringement and fined \$50 after failing to declare a rider for CRACKERCOL by the required time.

Race 8	GREENLIGHT INSURANCE BROKERS 1400
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SKAW VALLEY (G Rooke) - Slow to begin.

EPARAIMA (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin.

IRISH MISS (T Newman) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SUMMIT HEIGHTS (M Sanson) - Raced wide in the early stages.

SUPER WRAITH (L Sutherland) - Raced keenly in the middle stages.

KALLEDU THUNDER (J Riddell) - Had to be steadied off heels when racing keenly near the 700 metres. When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination which revealed a small wound to the left hind leg.

HASSTOBEAWINNER (R Goyaram) – Held up rounding the final bend and early in the straight. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to suffering from a suspected hoof abscess in the left fore hoof resulting in 3/5 lameness.

TOKO ONO (M Hashizume) - Held up until near the 200 metres.

SHE'LL BE RIGHT (B Rogerson) - Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 100 metres to the inside of SUPER WRAITH which shifted in, and outside of HASSTOBEAWINNER which shifted out slightly. L Sutherland was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

Race 9

NOVARA PARK 1950

DIVINE ESSENCE (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

OUR MILLY BEE (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

MOOD PAINTER (L Sutherland) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

WINDSOR CASTLE (S Weatherley) – Raced wide in the early stages before improving forward to lead near the 1200 metres.

EVE'S SONG (W Kennedy) - Improved onto heels rounding the final bend having to be steadied.

AUSSIE BETTY (T Mitchell) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running for the majority of the final straight.

APACHE BOY (M Hashizume) - When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding failed to handle today's track conditions. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination found the gelding to be coughing.
