D Tait advised Stewards prior to race day that she was unwell and would not be attending the meeting today. **Miss** Tait was replaced on her riding engagements as per the Summary above.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 TRAVELLERS REST TAVERN & MUDD & DAGS (2215m)

LOVELOCK (L Callaway) - Began awkwardly and jumped outwards hampering outside runner.

LOCHNABERRY (B Rogerson) - Hampered leaving the barriers when LOVELOCK jumped outwards.

GENTLE BEN (T Comignaghi) - Steadied to avoid the heels of CEE ARE EL which shifted inwards near the 2000 metres when not fully clear.

CEE ARE EL (T Moseley) - Held up rounding the final bend until obtaining clear running passing the 200 metres.

T Moseley (CEE ARE EL) – Issued with a warning after allowing his mount CEE ARE EL to shift inwards near the 2000 metres crowding GENTLE BEN which had to be steadied.

Race 2 TOP PUB & JOHNNY PHILLIPS LIFE MEMBER MAIDEN (1200m)

TIGER SATIN (D Montes de Oca) - Connections were advised a barrier manners warning has been placed against the gelding which proved difficult to load. Slow away. Rider reported that the gelding had raced very greenly throughout. **THE BRIGHT ONE** (T Comignaghi) - Connections were advised a barrier manners warning has been placed against the filly which was unruly behind the barriers and fractious in the barriers once loaded. Jumped away awkwardly.

AUREOLA (B May) - Connections were advised a barrier manners warning has been placed against the mare which proved difficult to load. Checked shortly after the start when JIKON shifted inwards. Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of RATATOUILLE which lay in near the 900 metres. Rider reported the mare had overraced and raced greenly throughout.

COURTE XENA (R Mudhoo) - Rider reported the filly had raced very greenly throughout.

B Rogerson (RATATOUILLE) – Issued with a warning after allowing her mount RATATOUILLE to shift ground inwards near the 900 metres crowding AUREOLA which had to steady.

A Najib (ICE COLD GOLD) - Issued with a warning after using his whip with an action which raised the rider's arm above shoulder height on one occasion just short of the finish.

R Muniandy (JIKON) - Admitted a charge of careless riding (assisted by K Selvan) in that he permitted JIKON to shift ground inwards shortly after the start when not sufficiently clear of AUREOLA which was checked. After hearing submissions, the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of Mr Muniandy's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 01 December until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 11 December 2024, 6 national riding days.

Race 3 AB LIME & COUNTRY JEWEL (1200m)

MEGALOMANIAC (A Najib) - Jumped away awkwardly hampering LILY OF THE VALLEY which lost ground. Steadied near the 700 metres going back on to MARYWEKA.

LILY OF THE VALLEY (B May) - Hampered leaving the barriers losing ground.

CHOUX MACHER (D Montes de Oca) - Slow away.

ALBAZINGA (L Callaway) - Raced three wide without cover. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised the mare had been disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormality.

TOMASINA (K Williams) - Lay outwards rounding the bend.

MARYWEKA (T Comignaghi) - Had to be firmly restrained to avoid the heels of MEGALOMANIAC near the 700 metres.

MONAGHAN BOY (S Khetoo) - Restrained to obtain cover after jumping from the outside barrier. Raced wide when attempting to improve forward from the 700 metres.

Trainer **K Shearing** – Issued with a warning after being late to present her runners CHOUX MACHER and CHOUX IN to the birdcage enclosure.

Race 4 HEN BATT & SON & FARMERS DIPPING (1200m)

HAZEL MAY (B Rogerson) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact with ATAAHUA PIPEDREAM losing ground.

ATAAHUA PIPEDREAM (S Khetoo) - Hampered when contacted leaving the barriers losing ground.

VANTAANA (K Williams) - Checked when crowded leaving the barriers losing ground.

LEISURE DOLLAR (C Campbell) - Slow away. Hung outwards throughout. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised the gelding had raced very greenly throughout.

IDEAL DREAMS (R Jaun) - Raced three wide without cover.

RADIANT ROSIE (T Moseley) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that he had got further back than intended and struggled to recover after being held up from the 500 metres until inside the final 150 metres.

Race 5 ADVANCE AGRICULTURE & SINCLAIR TRANSPORT MAIDEN (1400m)

OREPUKI GEM (B May) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

SIGNWRITER (K Mudhoo) - Slow away. Commenced to over-race near the 1200 metres.

STORMY BELLE (D Montes de Oca) - Shifted inwards making contact with THE REAL TREASURE near the 1250 metres and ducked outwards hampering BONSAI BOB.

BONSAI BOB (B Rogerson) - Hampered near the 1250 metres. Crowded and buffeted near the 250 metres and was unable to obtain clear running for the remainder of the race.

THE REAL TREASURE (K Williams) - Unbalanced when contacted near the 1250 metres. Hung out rounding the final bend crowding BONSAI BOB then continued to hang throughout the run home and was unable to be fully ridden out. Rider advised she had difficulty steering the mare and that the connections were considering making gear changes.

STYGIAN (R Mudhoo) - Raced greenly near the 1200 metres. Had to be shifted off heels passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

Race 6

HYDE LANDSCAPING & WASH RITE WINTON CUP (1400m)

THE GREY GOOSE (R Mudhoo) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after incorrect information was published and shared on social media regarding the mare tying up. Had a tendency to over-race in the middle stages.

THE GOOD SHEPHERD (L Callaway) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination behind the barriers after striking itself being passed to fit to run.

WILLIS (T Comignaghi) - Slow to begin after being fractious in the barriers.

HASSTOBEYOU (A Goindasamy) - Over-raced when being restrained in the early to middle stages and raced three wide without cover.

MIDNIGHT RUNNER (R Muniandy) - Raced four wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

Race 7 WINDSOR NEW WORLD MAIDEN (1600m)

TRALEE BAY (D Montes de Oca) - Jumped away awkwardly.

MATAKANA PERKYNANA (A Goindasamy) - Jumped away awkwardly then raced keenly in the early stages.

CHANCE (D Bothamley) - Slow away and continued to lose ground in the early stages. When questioned the rider advised that the gelding had felt reluctant to hit out in the early stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slow rate of recovery. Stewards will follow up with connections in the coming days.

POLLY'S GURU (R Mudhoo) - Slow to begin then being further hampered by MATAKANA PERKYNANA which jumped outwards. Rider advised that the gelding would be sent for a spell.

THE COOL ONE (T Moseley) - Raced ungenerously getting its head up on a number of occasions passing the 1400 metres.

EMPRESS SUIKO (L Callaway) - Rider dropped his whip near the 200 metres.

Race 8 WREYS BUSH FARM & NIGHTCAPS CONTRACTING (1600m)

JIBBITY (D Montes de Oca) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

DAVID MOSS (K Mudhoo) - Jumped outwards at the start hampering BEAVER FEVER.

BEAVER FEVER (R Jaun) - Hampered leaving the barriers when DAVID MOSS jumped outwards. Rider dropped his whip near the 75 metres.

HUGS (T Moseley) - Held up rounding the final bend then placed in restricted room near the 125 metres only obtaining clear running passing the 100 metres.

LINED SATIN (A Goindasamy) - Held up near the 150 metres having to shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running.

HAKAHARRY (C Campbell) - Hampered near the 125 metres.

A Goindasamy (LINED SATIN) - Issued with a warning after angling his mount LINED SATIN outwards across heels hampering HAKAHARRY which was dictated outwards placing HUGS in restricted room near the 125 metres.

C Campbell (HAKAHARRY) - Issued with a warning after using his whip with an action which raised the rider's arm above shoulder height early in the run home.

Race 9 RYAL BUSH TRANSPORT & WAYNE "OX" MCEWAN MEMORIAL (1600m)

K Mudhoo (MAOLLA MISS) - Admitted a charge under Rule 346(3) in that he failed to make the contracted weight for his ride on MAOLLA MISS with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$200 under the Minor Infringement Schedule. Mr Mudhoo was replaced by L Callaway.

LEO'S HIPPO (B May) - Crowded and buffeted between runners leaving the barriers losing ground.

MONTE KHAN (R Mudhoo) - Slow away.

ZA BEAUTEOUS (Y Atchamah) - Slow away.

THREE NINETY (B Murray) - Held up for a distance passing the 600 metres.

MAOLLA MISS (L Callaway) - Held up by a tiring runner rounding the final bend.

GINTYS GIRL (K Williams) - Not persevered with over the final 200 metres with the rider advising she felt something maybe amiss with the mare. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Stewards will follow up with the mares recovery in the coming days.
