EVE'S SONG (1000 metres.	G Rooke) - Raced wide in the early stages before improving forward to sit outside the leader near the		
JACK IN THE E	BOX (T Mitchell) - Contacted and forced wider near the 600 metres.		
	W Kennedy) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the straight.		

N Parmar (VERISMO) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of JACK IN THE BOX which was contacted and forced wider near the 600 metres.

ALL SHOOK UP (T Newman) - Slow to begin.

TALENTOSO (T Mitchell) - Knuckled on jumping away.

TO CATCH A THIEF (K Myers) - Steadied over the concluding stages when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of TALENTOSO which shifted in. T Mitchell was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had failed to respond when placed under pressure in the final straight.

DIMAGGIO (M Cartwright) – Held up until near the 200 metres.

Race 3 LODGE PROPERTY MANAGEMENT MAIDEN 1200

OUT OF EXILE (W Kennedy) – Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages. Raced greenly entering the final straight, running wider then continued to race greenly when placed under pressure. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

M Walker & S Bergerson (PARAVANE) - Issued with a Minor Infringement and fined \$50 after presenting PARAVANE to race with unnotified gear (noseband and tongue-tie).

Race 4 PRINT HOUSE 1400

KEEGAN (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

SIR STERLING (G Rooke) - Slow to begin. Held up rounding the final bend.

LEROY BROWN (M Cartwright) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

TALISKER (A Lawson-Carroll) - Shifted out contacting TANGANYIKA passing the 300 metres.

TANGANYIKA (M Hashizume) – Contacted and forced wider passing the 300 metres. Lay in over the concluding stages when placed under pressure.

Race 5 LODGE REAL ESTATE 1200

LOVACI (C Barnes) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

REGAL WARRIOR (L Satherley) - Lay outwards rounding the final bend.

BILLY BUNTER (B Jacobson) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight before attempting a marginal run to the inside of LA ROSA LEE passing the 200 metres having to be restrained when placed in restricted room.

Race 6 NATIONWIDE LIVESTOCK MILE MAIDEN 1600

PERSPECTIVE (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin.

CHIVALROUS (T Mitchell) – Knuckled on jumping away.

SOUTHERN COMFORT (N Parmar) - Hampered leaving the barriers losing ground.

TEMPEST MOON (A Lawson-Carroll) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages from the outside barrier.

LAST SOUVENIR (S Spratt) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

ALAVISTO (M Hashizume) - Held up early in the final straight. Shifted in and away from the heels of JUST CALL ME JONNY passing the 150 metres making contact with GOLD CURRENCY becoming unbalanced having to be steadied.

C Barnes (JUST CALL ME JONNY) - Issued with a warning for permitting her mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of ALAVISTO which shifted in and away contacting GOLD CURRENCY becoming unbalanced having to be steadied passing the 150 metres.

Race 7	DAM DOORS 2100
DEEBEE BELLFER	(A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow to begin.

ABOVE THE CLOUDS (M Cartwright) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Held up rounding the final bend and early in the straight.

MALDINI (K Myers) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Improved onto heels having to be steadied near the 400 metres. Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

EL NYMPH (L Satherley) – Co-trainer N Elliott advised that the mare would not be persevered with as a racing proposition from their stable.

Race 8LODGE COMMERCIAL MILE 1600DON PAULY (S Spratt) - Slow to begin.

CRACKERCOL (V Colgan) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that after beginning poorly the gelding had never travelled comfortably. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

PHANTOM DRAGON (A Lawson-Carroll) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

GOD OF EROS (N Parmar) – Held up rounding the final bend and early in the straight.

INCREDIBLE (M Cartwright) - When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had travelled comfortably throughout, however had failed to respond when placed under pressure. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.
