RACE COMMENTS	
Race 1	SHACKELL ELECTRICAL MAIDEN 1150
OUT OF EXILE (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly contacting CHAHOO. Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages. Had to be firmly restrained off heels near the 600 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider confirmed that the filly raced ungenerously throughout which proved detrimental to its chances. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.	
CHAHOO (A Lawson-Carroll) - Contacted at the start.	
NOBLE BOY (R Goyaram) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Lay outwards when placed under pressure passing the 350 metres inconveniencing DUA DANCE.	
DUA DANCE (M Hashizume) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Inconvenienced passing the 350 metres.	
Race 2	BAYLEYS COUNTRY MAIDEN 2200
OUT OF SIGHT (B Rogerson) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Not persevered with in the final straight when well out of contention. When questioned, rider advised that the mare felt indifferent in its action. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.	

ANIMUS (J Doyle) - Had to be steadied off heels when racing keenly near the 1700 metres.

POINTER (C Barnes) - Raced three wide without cover through the early and middle stages.

ZANZIBAR (M Cartwright) - Lay outwards when placed under pressure having to be corrected by its rider near the 150 metres inconveniencing **JUST A KARIN** and **DIAMONDS FOR JEN**.

DIAMONDS FOR JEN (N Parmar) – Inconvenienced near the 150 metres.

JUST A KARIN (L Satherley) - Inconvenienced near the 150 metres.

P & S McKay (**DIAMONDS FOR JEN**) - Issued with a warning for presenting **DIAMONDS FOR JEN** late to the enclosure.

Following this race the track was upgraded to Good 4.

Race 3	NEVILLE JACQUES @ BAYLEYS MAIDEN 1600
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ORANGE RIVER (B Rogerson) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

CASEMIRO (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow to begin.

FAST IMPACT (T Newman) - Raced keenly through the middle stages. Then raced three wide without cover from the 1200 metres.

VADANOVA (S Spratt) – When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the filly failed to hit out on the good track conditions and would appreciate a softer track surface.

REAL CLASS (V Colgan) – When questioned regarding the seemingly improved performance trainer J Mahoney advised that the filly derived benefit from its debut effort along with a step up in distance.

Race 4	MARK WYBORN MAIDEN 1400
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BEETLEGEUSE (C Grylls) - Slow to begin. Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 600 metres.

EMBOSSSED (S Spratt) - Slow to begin.

NORTHEASTERLY (M Cartwright) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Had to be steadied off heels when racing keenly near the 900 metres.

COINCIDENTAL (T Newman) – Raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight, running wider on the track with the rider being unable to ride the filly out fully to the finish. Trainer B Kennedy was advised that a warning would be placed on the filly's racing manners.

DEADLY DESIRE (M Hashizume) – When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the filly had got further back in the running than intended and was satisfied with the debut effort.

V Colgan (**HAKKINEN**) - Reminded of his obligations to ensure he rides his mounts out fully to the end of the race when circumstances permit.

Race 5	TEAM WEALLEANS MAIDEN 1400
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BAK DA ANGEL (J Doyle) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages when wide without cover.

EKSTATIQUE (M Sanson) – Made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly having to be steadied.

ANDORRA (V Colgan) - Improved onto heels having to be steadied near the 700 metres.

VIVACE (M Cartwright) - Lay outwards rounding the final bend.

EZELLOHAR (R Goyaram) - Raced greenly when placed under pressure having to be corrected by its rider near the 200 metres.

Race 6

J SWAP CONTRACTORS 1600

BOXMOSS (A Lawson-Carroll) – Removed from its barrier stall after being fractious to undergo a veterinary examination being cleared to start. Began awkwardly losing ground.

OCEANS OF STANIMA (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin.

EL BANDOLERO (T Newman) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages from the outside barrier.

ROSETOWN PRINCESS (J Doyle) - Shifted ground outwards when not fully clear making contact with SKAW VALLEY which was unbalanced near the 400 metres. Shifted ground inwards to obtain clear running near the 200 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the mare would benefit from a step up in distance.

SKAW VALLEY (N Parmar) - Contacted becoming unbalanced near the 400 metres.

MA BAKER (J Nishizuka) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Checked when weakening near the 200 metres.

SUAVETTA (V Colgan) - Checked losing ground passing the 50 metres.

J Doyle (ROSETOWN PRINCESS) - Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift ground outwards when not fully clear making contact with SKAW VALLEY which was unbalanced near the 400 metres.

M Cartwright (LERADO) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift outwards when insufficiently clear of BOXMOSS which was forced outwards crowding and checking MA BAKER near the 200 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of M Cartwright's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 14 December up to and including racing on Friday 20 December, 4 national riding days.

R Goyaram (CHOOSE 'EM BIG) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift outwards when insufficiently clear of SUAVETTA which was checked losing ground passing the 50 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of R Goyaram's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Friday 13 December up to and including racing on Sunday 22 December, 7 national riding days.

Connections of the 4th placed runner SUAVETTA viewed Stewards video footage of the concluding stages before electing not to proceed with a protest against CHOOSE 'EM BIG.

Race 7

MIKE FRASER-JONES @ BAYLEYS MILE 1600

IRISH MISS (M Cartwright) - Slow to begin.

DEEBEE BELLFER (C Grylls) - Slow to begin.

CUPID'S ARROW (M Hashizume) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

SUNSET BOULEVARD (S Spratt) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

AKENEHI (V Colgan) - Had to be steadied after improving onto the heels of FLAMBOYANCE which shifted in when not fully clear passing the 1300 metres. L Satherley was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

TROUVAILLE (O Bosson) - Held up passing the 300 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding failed to hit out on the good track conditions and would appreciate a softer track surface.

VISTOWN (J Fawcett) - Held up until near the 250 metres.

Race 8

MANCO MAIDEN 1600

HOT LINE BLING (R Goyaram) - Slow to begin. Improved into restricted room passing the 300 metres shying away from the rail.

LEBASSO (J Doyle) - Over-raced when being restrained for a distance passing the 1400 metres then continued to race ungenerously through the middle stages.

CHUCKLE'S DAUGHTER (V Colgan) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

MCCLLENAGHAN (B Jacobson) - Lay out rounding the final bend. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding felt indifferent in its action in the final straight. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to be 3/5 lame in the right foreleg. Connections were advised a clearance would be required prior to racing next.

S Marsh (EPSILON) - Issued a Minor Infringement notice and fined \$100 for being late to declare a rider for EPSILON.
