Race 8 - RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE 2000m

DIORESSENCE (C Campbell) - Co-trainer S Smith advised Stewards that following the disappointing performance blood tests taken subsequently had revealed a high white cell count. DIORESSENCE has been treated accordingly, with S Smith further advising she would have further tests taken before returning to the races.

Race 1	RURAL MERCHANTS PALMERSTON MAIDEN 1600m

THE REAL TREASURE (D Cooper) - Reared over in the birdcage dislodging the rider who was uninjured. Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was cleared to race.

ACESANJACKS (T Moseley) - Fractious in the barriers prior to the start. Raced ungenerously in the early stages getting its head up on a number of occasions. Hampered near the 250 metres.

MISS ENZED (R Mudhoo) - Very slow to begin (8 lengths). Connections were advised the mare would be placed on a barrier manners warning. In assessing this Stewards took into account the fractious nature of the runner in the adjacent stall.

KASHIPURA (K Kalychurun) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

PULL THE PIN (R Muniandy) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

IT'S MARLIN (Y Atchamah) - Lay out rounding the final bend and in the run home, shifting wider on the track hampering ACESANJACKS and IMPERATIVE near the 250 metres. Continued to lay out in the run home and could not be ridden to any advantage. Connections were advised the gelding would be placed on a racing manners warning. Connections advised Stewards they would consider sending IT'S MARLIN for a spell.

IMPERATIVE (L Callaway) - Hampered near the 250 metres.

Race 2	WAIHEMO LODGE HOTEL MAIDEN 1300m

QUEEN OF KINGS (B May) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

MAIN EVENT (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin. Over raced for a short distance passing the 1000 metres having to be steadied.

CHAKA (C Campbell) - Began awkwardly shifting in crowding MISS BEAR and VALDISIR.

MISS BEAR (A Goindasamy) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

VALDISIR (S Wynne) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

STOUT (N Parmar) - Rider dropped his inside rein near the 200 metres, with the gelding shifting out abruptly before being straightened.

THE BRIGHT ONE (D Cooper) - Shifted in abruptly near the 200 metres having to be straightened when struck with the whip.

Race 3	HOPE & SONS MAC CHAPLIN MEMORIAL 1200m

EX AYE (Y Atchamah) - Slow to begin.

RAPID (K Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

CHARI (N Parmar) - Raced in restricted room to the inside of JIKON near the 1000 metres and when being steadied over reacted and became briefly awkward in its stride.

NEPTUNE (A Goindasamy) - Held up rounding the final bend and was inclined to lay inwards throughout the run home.

L Callaway (JIKON) - Issued with a warning after allowing his mount JIKON to shift inwards crowding CHARI which had to be steadied passing the 1000 metres. In assessing this Stewards took into account the greenness of both runners.

Race 4 | **CARGILL CONTRACTING 1200m**

BOOBOO BOOGIE (Y Atchamah) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after kicking out at the back gates when placed in the barrier and was declared a late scratching at 1:19pm.

TRADER (A Goindasamy) - Over raced in the early stages getting its head up on a number of occasions before being restrained to the rear to obtain cover. Had some trouble finding clear racing room through the middle stages of the run home.

Race 5 | **MEENANS LIQUORLAND & OTAGO TYRES 1600m**

ATAAHUA PIPEDREAM (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

SAVABOURBON (N Parmar) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

MOVE ON (T Moseley) - Crowded at the start losing some ground.

LUCIENNE (D Cooper) - Shifted in at the start crowding some inside runners.

ZADANE (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SACRED MIST (R Muniandy) - Restrained from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

AMERICAN CHEVAL (A Goindasamy) - Over raced when leading through the early stages.

PATRAINE (C Campbell) - Raced in restricted room early in the run home.

ABRUZZI (L Callaway) - Gave ground in the run home finishing a distant last, with the rider advising he had been disappointed with the effort today. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed the gelding to have suffered cardiac arrhythmia. Trainer S Prince was advised that ABRUZZI will not be permitted to start in any race or trial until a veterinary certificate declaring the horse free of any cardiac arrhythmia following a gallop of at least 1000 metres.

Race 6 | **PROPERTY BROKERS 1200m**

ATOMIC (R Muniandy) - Slow to begin.

FULL MOON FEVER (K Williams) - Blundered leaving the barriers losing some ground.

HAKADEGREE (N Parmar) - Had to be briefly steadied when MADAM DUBAI was taken in by ON SONG shortly after the start.

EYE SPY (A Goindasamy) - Over raced in the early stages and got its head up when being steadied to take a trailing position near the 900 metres. Rider could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance.

ON SONG (D Cooper) - Raced wide without cover from the 900 metres. When questioned regarding performance, rider could offer no tangible excuse.

LEMON CURD (Y Atchamah) - Denied a marginal run near the 200 metres having to shift ground outwards to find clear racing room.

D Cooper (ON SONG) - Issued with a warning after allowing his mount ON SONG to shift inwards dictating MADAM DUBAI inwards onto HAKADECREE which had to be steadied near the 1100 metres.

Race 7 | **WAE WAIKOUAITI CUP 2200m**

THE TUI TOILER (B Murray) - Slow to begin.

LEAVE IT TO ME (T Moseley) - Slow to begin.

COMPLICATE (Y Atchamah) - Attempted to buck for several strides shortly after the start losing some ground. Connections were advised that a racing manners warning would be placed against the mare's record.

HUMBUCKER (K Williams) - Over raced when leading through the early to middle stages. Gave ground from the 600 metres eventually finishing a distant last. Rider advised that the gelding had hung throughout and over raced in the early to middle stages, and had been under pressure a long way from home and been very disappointing. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed a possible knee issue which will require follow up attention. Stewards will follow up with connections in coming days.

Race 8 | **ODT SOUTHERN MILE QUALIFIER 1600m**

A MANDARIN (K Kalychurun) - Fractious in its barrier beginning awkwardly and losing ground.

PEACHY KEEN (B May) - Slow to begin. Held up near the 150 metres only gaining clear racing room inside the final 75 metres.

STYGIAN (R Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

OMINOUS (S Wynne) - Very slow to begin.

CIMARRON (N Parmar) - Got its head up when over racing in the early stages.

FUNFETTI (U Holmquist) - Raced wide without cover through the early stages.

PETE'S PRIDE (D Bothamley) - Over raced in the early to middle stages. Had some trouble obtaining clear racing room in the run home.

BOWLER (C Campbell) - Inclined to lay inwards early in the run home having to be straightened near the 200 metres.

LINED SATIN (A Goindasamy) - Had some trouble obtaining clear running through the middle stages of the run home.

Race 9 | **BRENT LUCAS BUILDERS 1400m**

K Mudhoo (EXCHANGE) - Fined \$200 under the Minor Infringement Schedule after being unable to make the contracted weight and being replaced by N Parmar.

TUMUCH (U Holmquist) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection at the barriers and was cleared to race. Slow to begin. Held up rounding the final bend by a tiring runner and continued to have trouble gaining clear racing room until passing the 150 metres.

FIRODEN (C Campbell) - Slow to begin.

MASTER MARKO (Y Atchamah) - Crowded at the start.

EXCHANGE (N Parmar) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up rounding the final bend. Briefly held up passing the 50 metres.

TAP 'N' GO (T Jonker) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

RIVIERA REBEL (K Williams) - When asked to comment on the performance of this favoured runner, rider advised she had been taken on when leading throughout which took its toll on the gelding in its second up run.

Race 10

ODT SOUTHERN MILE QUALIFIER 1600m

ANTICIPATE (R Muniandy) - Dislodged its rider during the preliminary and escaped riderless for some distance, being late scratched at 4:40pm by order of Stewards. R Muniandy was uninjured in this incident. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed minor abrasions to both left legs which did not require treatment.

INDUSTRIALIST (U Holmquist) - Began awkwardly shifting inwards making contact with LETSBRINGTHEBLING and losing ground as a result. Ridden forward to sit three wide outside the leader near the 1000 metres. Was inclined to shift ground throughout the run home when placed under pressure.

LETSBRINGTHEBLING (Y Atchamah) - Contacted at the start. Contacted near the 225 metres.

SESTINA (S Wynne) - Slow to begin. Lay inwards near the 225 metres being immediately straightened by its rider.

THE CLUSTER (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin.

SAY SATONO (K Williams) - Slow to begin. Dictated inwards becoming awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 225 metres.

REPROBATE (K Kalychurun) - Over raced in the early stages.

ROYAL VALOUR (L Callaway) - Held up rounding the final bend. Held up from the 200 metres and was unable to gain clear racing room and went to the line not fully tested by its rider.

QUINTABELLE (C Campbell) - Held up rounding the final bend. Shifted away from SESTINA which lay inwards near the 225 metres resulting in LETSBRINGTHEBLING being dictated inwards onto SAY SATONO which then became awkwardly placed on the heels of the runner in front.
