FOXGLOVE (G Rooke) – Co-trainer A Scott reported to Stewards the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of FOXGLOVE, and it is their intention to carry on with the gelding's current preparation where they may look to nominate FOXGLOVE for the Matamata RC meeting on Saturday 15 February.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | AUCKLAND CO-OP TAXIS MAIDEN 3YO 1600

GUIPAGO (G Rooke) - Slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear running before improving onto heels passing the 200 metres being held up until near the 100 metres.

ANDIAMO (S Spratt) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

PROBOY (K Stott) - Restrained shortly after the start to obtain cover.

SHARP ENOUGH (R Hutchings) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Ran off passing the 800 metres being pulled up by its rider. Connections were advised the gelding would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

WHO ROX THE HOUSE (W Pinn) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Held up until near the 100 metres.

Race 2 | BARFOOT & THOMPSON 1200

MISS ROCKETTE (G Rooke) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

GOLDBURG (K Stott) - Slow to begin.

DANCING DREAM (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin.

OH NO NO NO (N Yuen) - Slow to begin and was then contacted shortly after the start.

NICCONI COUNTY (T Moodley) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

LITTLE STIRRER (W Kennedy) - Over-raced through the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the filly had travelled comfortably throughout but had failed to respond when placed under pressure. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

SCREAMIN EAGLE (R Hutchings) - Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to have experienced an episode of bilateral Epistaxis. SCREAMIN EAGLE shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any race or trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian. Connections indicated that the gelding would now be retired.

Race 3 | COLIN JILLINGS 2YO CLASSIC 1200 (G3)

DARE TO PROISIR (K Stott) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early stages.

TAJANA (S Spratt) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

RETURN TO CONQUER (W Pinn) - Raced three wide without cover until near the 700 metres.

VITTORIA (G Rooke) - Held up until near the 200 metres. Lost the off front plate during the running.

<p>THE YES GIRL (T Newman) - Slow to begin and was then steadied when placed in restricted room shortly after the start.</p> <p>BECAUSE (W Pinn) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>ALL SHOOK UP (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>SANTA CATALINA (R Hutchings) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.</p> <p>YOU KNOW (J Fawcett) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in its mouth which upon veterinary inspection, was found to be coming from a minor laceration to the mouth.</p> <p>DEEBEE BELLFER (T Moodley) - Improved onto heels approaching the 1400 metres having to be steadied.</p> <p>AYTEEM (S Spratt) - Steadied when placed in restricted room approaching the 200 metres.</p> <p>T Moodley (DEEBEE BELLFER) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of AYTEEM which had to be steadied when placed in restricted room approaching the 200 metres. Also contributing was slight inward movement from SANTA CATALINA.</p>

<p>TALENTOSO (T Moodley) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>WILLYDOIT (K Stott) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>KING OF THE NORTH (G Rooke) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>PURE DELIGHT (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>NO SECRET (K Myers) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.</p> <p>GIGI (J Nishizuka) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from a wide barrier.</p> <p>GIACOMO (J Fawcett) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.</p> <p>DIMAGGIO (R Hutchings) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.</p> <p>J Fawcett (GIACOMO) - Issued with a warning after using her whip in two consecutive strides on GIACOMO near the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 7	FULTON FAMILY STAKES 1500 (Listed Race)

MEANINGFUL STAR (K Stott) - Slow to begin.

TERRA MITICA (W Kennedy) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Improved onto heels passing the 150 metres being held up for the remainder of the race.

NOT IDEAL (N Yuen) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

COGNITO (W Pinn) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. Had difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the final straight.

CHEVRON (J Fawcett) - Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight. Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 100 metres.

UDERZO (N Parmar) - Was unable to obtain clear running throughout the final straight.

SON OF SUN (A Goindasamy) - Briefly steadied after improving onto heels passing the 150 metres.

KELLY COE (C Barnes) - When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the mare travelled well throughout but had failed to respond when placed under pressure and was of the opinion that the mare may not have been suited to the right-handed way of going.

MERCHANT QUEEN (S Spratt) – Received veterinary attention post-race to a laceration on the left hind leg.

Race 8

TRELAWNEY STUD 1600

BERENHARD (J Doyle) - Began awkwardly and was then contacted losing ground.

LAGISQUET (N Parmar) - Slow to begin.

GAMEPLAY (S Spratt) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

MONDAY MELODY (K Stott) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Improved onto heels passing the 200 metres having to shift ground outwards approaching the 100 metres to obtain clear running.

LACHIE (T Moodley) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

PATSY SPIRIT (C Barnes) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LORD OF THE SEA (K Myers) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight before attempting to improve into a marginal run passing the 300 metres which did not eventuate when runners either side shifted ground. Then shifted outwards when placed in restricted room making contact with HE'S CLASSIC which became unbalanced near the 250 metres. K Myers was advised to exercise care.

HE'S CLASSIC (A Goindasamy) - Contacted and unbalanced passing the 250 metres.

MUSTANG MORGAN (W Kennedy) - Held up until near the 200 metres.
