RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 THE TELE OTAKI MAIDEN 1400m

OUR ALI (M Singh) - Slow to begin.

WHOOSHKA (L Sutherland) - Raced keenly in the early stages, getting its head up near the 1200 metres. Held up early in the home straight.

PATRIOT (N Parmar) - Raced keenly through the early stages. Improved onto heels passing the 400 metres and was steadied. Steadied near the 250 metres when IT'S AMELIA was angled inwards.

QUIET ACCLAIM (J Fawcett) - Raced wide throughout. J Fawcett reported the mare hung throughout.

IT'S AMELIA (L Hemi) - Awkwardly placed on heels passing the 300 metres. Held up until near the 200 metres.

GEE FORCE (L Allpress) - Lay outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

NOBLE LEE (M Hudson) - Finished towards the rear. When questioned, rider could offer no excuse.

TIMMY (T Davies) - Lost the near hind plate during the running.

L Hemi (IT'S AMELIA) - Issued with a warning after angling her mount inwards near the 250 metres, with PATRIOT having to be steadied.

Race 2 HARCOURTS OTAKI THREE YEAR OLD MAIDEN 1600m

VANRIO (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly, hampering GOLDEN LINING. Raced wide throughout. When questioned, rider was of the opinion the gelding, which was having its first race-day start, would derive benefit from the race.

GOLDEN LINING (A Riddell) - Hampered at the start, losing ground.

PICCOLINO (M Singh) - Restrained to the rear from its wide draw.

DIAMONDSANDPEARLS (T Davies) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Hampered near the 350 metres when I PARK shifted outwards.

RITHIM (L Hemi) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

I PARK (M Lerner) - Angled outwards near the 350 metres, briefly hampering DIAMONDSANDPEARLS. Lay outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

M Lerner (I PARK) - Issued with a warning after angling his mount outwards near the 350 metres when not clear of DIAMONDSANDPEARLS, which was briefly hampered.

Race 3 AR PAINTERS THREE YEAR OLD MAIDEN 1200m

BULLFER GROVE (M Hudson) - Began awkwardly, coming together with MELTEMI and losing ground.

MELTEMI (K Hercock) - Began awkwardly, coming together with BULLFER GROVE

TURN IT UP (L Sutherland) - Began awkwardly, losing ground. Raced greenly through the middle stages.

Race 4 McMILLAN EQUINE FEEDS MAIDEN 1200m

PIKO BISQUIT (C Dell) - Slow to begin.

ROSEMARY FIZZ (U Holmquist) - Slow to begin.

FLIGHT JAZZ (L Allpress) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

TOLSTOY (M Singh) - Lay inwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

JAMAICA BAY (M Lerner) - Rider advised the gelding could not be ridden out fully due to its tendency to hang.

Race 5 NEW WORLD OTAKI MAIDEN 2100m

SKIPPERS CANYON (K Hercock) - Slow to begin.

TAUPO DANCER (M Lerner) - Raced wide through the early and middle stages. Lost its footing near the 1500 metres.

COLIN THE FOX (E Sole) - Raced wide through the early and middle stages.

DUBAI'S POTIKI (C Dell) - Raced keenly when leading. Lay outwards passing the 150 metres, having to be straightened.

SIDE PIECE (M Hudson) - Improved on to heels passing the 1200 metres and again near the 800 metres, having to be steadied on both occasions.

Following the running of Race 5, Rider M Lerner reported that his mount had lost its footing near the 1500 metres but was unsure if it was track related. A subsequent track inspection by Stewards, Track Staff and Riders was conducted with no evidence of movement being found with the decision being made to continue the meeting.

Race 6 CAVALLO FARMS CHRIS RUTTEN BLOODSTOCK HANDICAP 2100m

VESPACIAN (L Allpress) - Slow to begin. Finished towards the rear. When questioned, rider was of the opinion there may be something amiss with the mare. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

MOSSRAAJ (M Hudson) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

THE BELVOIR (J Fawcett) - Raced wide throughout.

MANZOR BLUE (K Hercock) - Held up early in the home straight.

SABOTS D'OR (L Sutherland) - Lay inwards near the 400 metres. Finished towards the rear. Rider could offer no excuse.

Race 7 VETS ON RIVERBANK HANDICAP 1600m

TITICACA (M Hudson) - Slow to begin.

KNICKERLESS (L Hemi) - Slow to begin.

TRANZED (E Sole) - Slow to begin and then raced wide.

STRINGLINE (K Hercock) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

BETTERBEYOU (L Sutherland) - Hampered near the 250 metres when KNICKERLESS was angled outwards. When questioned into the disappointing run, L Sutherland advised that although the mare raced mid-field, she was of the opinion BETTERBEYOU is better suited to being ridden further back. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the mare to be in season.

KNICKERLESS (L Hemi) - Angled outwards near the 250 metres, hampering BETTERBEYOU. Held up until passing the 200 metres.

L Hemi (KNICKERLESS) - Issued with a warning after angling her mount outwards near the 250 metres, hampering BETTERBEYOU.

Race 8 ENTAIN/NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES 1400m

STIPULATOR (M Lerner) - Began awkwardly, hampering DENDO and HAYATE. Lay outwards over the concluding stages.

DENDO (M Hudson) - Hampered at the start. Finished last. When questioned, M Hudson could not offer any tangible excuse other than the 59kg impost today. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which was clear.

HAYATE (L Allpress) - Hampered at the start. Contacted passing the 400 metres. Lay inwards under pressure over the concluding stages. Finished towards the rear. When questioned, L Allpress confirmed that after receiving contact passing the 400 metres, the mare had failed to respond.

GET FUNKY (C Dell) - Began awkwardly.

FREYJA'S GODDESS (E Sole) - Raced wide throughout.

SAY I DO (J Fawcett) - Lay outwards near the 400 metres, contacting HAYATE.

STONE THE CROWS (L Douglas) - Finished towards the rear. When questioned, L Douglas advised that in his opinion the filly was better suited to 1200 metres as this point in its preparation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a slow recovery rate.
