PING (K Mudhoo) – Trainer Ms. L Young reported to Stewards, PING was examined by the stable's veterinarian on Friday 7 February, with no abnormalities being detected. L Young further advised it is her intention to continue on with the mare's current preparation and may look to nominate PING for the Ashburton RC meeting on Sunday 23 February.

Race 3 POSITIVE SIGNS + PRINT 1600m

CLUEDO LANE (B Murray) – Trainer Ms. K Hodgson advised Stewards, CLUEDO LANE, underwent a veterinary examination on Monday 11 February which revealed the gelding to be showing signs of jarring up. K Hodgson further advised CLUEDO LANE has been sent for a brief spell.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | OLPHERT CONTRACTING MAIDEN 1200m

EX AYE (K Kalychurun) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

THE BRIGHT ONE (B Jacobson) - Blundered at the start.

LETS GO BARBIE (L Callaway) - Slow to begin. When being angled inwards shortly after the start made contact with the running rail.

NIGEL (B Rogerson) - Stood flat footed as the start was effected and as a result lost ground (5L). Tailed the field throughout despite the efforts of the rider.

DE RUSSIAN ROCKET (R Mudhoo) - Crowded then hampered at the start when runners either side shifted ground and got back as a result.

Race 2 | HEINEKEN MAIDEN 1600m

PINX (T Jonker) - Slow to begin.

ACESANJACKS (Y Atchamah) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

RAY'S AWAKE (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin. Held up for several strides rounding the final bend.

ARCTIC OCEAN (K Kalychurun) - From its wide barrier draw was restrained to obtain cover shortly after the start.

AUREOLA (A Balloo) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

ALI NEL (K Mudhoo) - Over-raced through the early and middle stages.

T Jonker (PINX) – Spoken to advisedly regarding her whip action over the concluding stages.

Following the race rider **K Mudhoo** advised Stewards he was feeling unwell and after an examination by the oncourse St John Ambulance personnel was found to be suffering from dehydration. Mr Mudhoo was replaced on his remaining riding engagements as per the Summary above.

Race 3	WHITE ROBE LODGE HANDICAP 1400m

ADIKTIV PASSION (C Campbell) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

TIGER FIRE (T Comignaghi) - Began awkwardly losing ground and tailed the field throughout. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised the gelding will take natural benefit from its first up run in over a year.

WHINY MEOW (B May) - Slow to begin and was then ridden with urgency to recover. Commenced to race keenly through the early and middle stages.

LEMON CURD (D Cooper) - From its wide barrier draw was restrained to obtain cover shortly after the start.

COCKAHOOP (A Goindasamy) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained to obtain cover through the early stages. Continued to over-race for the majority of the event.

HAKADECREE (R Muniandy) - When racing keenly improved on to heels having to be firmly restrained near the 1100 metres. Continued to over-race through the middle stages.

GO LOTTE (A Najib) - Dropped its head as the start was effected and as a result lost ground.

BUOYANT (B Jacobson) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

ROCHELLO (A Balloo) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

ICE COLD GOLD (B Rogerson) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LA BELLA NERA (A Mudhoo) - Lay in throughout the run home.

THE RADIANT ONE (D Cooper) - Lay outwards over the concluding stages and near the winning post made contact with TIKKI.

TIKKI (T Comignaghi) - Contacted near the winning post.

A Najib (GO LOTTE) - Spoken to advisedly regarding his whip use in the run home.

Race 5	HOUSE OF TRAVEL INVERCARGILL HANDICAP 2200m

OMINOUS (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Treated post-race for minor abrasions to a hind leg consistent with having been being galloped on during the running.

QUICK CALL (A Najib) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Made the bend near the 1700 metres awkwardly.

XRATED (T Jonker) - Crowded at the start losing ground when runners to either side shifted ground.

GENTLE BEN (D Bothamley) - Slow to begin.

ZABORACI (A Balloo) - Slow to begin. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

HAKAHARRY (R Muniandy) - Slow to begin. Improved on to the heels of OMINOUS near the 300 metres clipping that runner's heel and blundering.

HAAST RULER (A Mudhoo) - Over-raced into the first bend.

THREE NINETY (Y Atchamah) - Held up in the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 75 metres.

ZA BEAUTEOUS (B Rogerson) - Returned to the birdcage enclosure with some lameness in the near foreleg. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have a suspected tendon injury to the left front leg. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

STRONG (B Jacobson) - When questioned rider advised the gelding was looking for tracks with more moisture in them.

Race 6	BAILLIE & LEWIS PHARMACY INVERCARGILL GOLD CUP 2600m

PRINCE ALBY (Y Atchamah) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

KOYAMA (K Williams) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

THE TUI TOILER (T Jonker) - Slow to begin. Improved three wide from the 2000 metres to sit outside the leader near the 1400 metres.

LOCHNABERRY (B Rogerson) - Slow to begin. Crowded and had to steady when PAR TEE shifted inwards under pressure near the 50 metres.

SMOOTH OPERATOR (T Comignaghi) - Got its head up when being steadied off heels near the 1900 metres and continued to over-race for a distance through the early stages. Held up passing the 450 metres only gaining clear racing room near the 250 metres. Lost the off front plate during the running.

EXCHANGE (C Campbell) - Held up by a tiring runner from the 500 metres and was unable to gain clear racing room until late in the race.

C Campbell (EXCHANGE) - Spoken to advisedly regarding his whip use in the run home.

R Muniandy (PAR TEE) – Issued with a warning after allowing his mount PAR TEE to shift inwards near the 50 metres resulting in LOCHNABERRY being crowded and having to steady.

Following this race the track conditions were upgraded to Good 4.

Race 7	ILT ASCOT PARK HOTEL SOUTHLAND GUINEAS 1400m

The start was delayed when **LOOSE SALLY** refused to load before being declared a late scratching at 3.37pm. Connections were advised the filly will be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

BELARDO ACE (R Mudhoo) - Stood flat footed as the start was effected losing ground. Failed to stride out in the early stages despite the efforts of its rider.

PIVOTAL TEN (S Wynne) - Jumped away awkwardly.

LITTLE BUT FIERCE (A Balloo) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SIGHT TO SEE (K Kalychurun) - Slow to begin.

FREDDIE TIME (K Williams) - Slow to begin. Over-raced getting its head up for a distance passing the 1200 metres. Over-raced in the early stages getting its head up for a distance passing the 1200 metres.

MAMAEA (C Campbell) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

LADY DIVA (Y Atchamah) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

LEONA (B May) - Improved onto heels near the 1300 metres shifting out abruptly dictating PRETTY FLY wider on the track.

PRETTY FLY (B Jacobson) - Dictated wider on the track near the 1300 metres. Raced wide without cover throughout.

S Wynne PIVOTAL TEN – Spoken to advisedly regarding performing a celebratory gesture with Stewards taking into account the horse's nose had reached the winning post just prior to the gesture being performed.

S Wynne PIVOTAL TEN – Admitted a charge under Rule 648(5) in that she weighed in 0.9kg in excess of the weight at which she had weighed out and was fined \$200 under the Minor Infringement Schedule.

Race 8	BELLEW & CO @ BAYLEYS SRE HANDICAP 1400m

K Selvan (STYGIAN) - Issued with a warning when presenting his runner STYGIAN late into the birdcage.

CANDIDATE (D Cooper) - Shifted outwards abruptly at the start crowding MAXIMUS AUGUSTUS then shifted inwards shortly after dictating MEGALOMANIAC inwards resulting in AMIINIT having to be steadied.

MAXIMUS AUGUSTUS (B May) - Crowded at the start losing ground. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

REDFORD (B Jacobson) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

STYGIAN (R Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

PETE'S PRIDE (D Bothamley) - Slow to begin. Held up for a distance passing the 400 metres and near the 300 metres had to be steadied away from the heels of LUCIENNE which shifted away from the tiring MEGALOMANIAC.

AMIINIT (A Goindasamy) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied when outside runners shifted in.

BLEAKHOUSE BURTIE (T Jonker) - Buffeted and unbalanced shortly after the start.

MOVE ON (C Campbell) - Buffeted and unbalanced shortly after the start. Rider advised the mare had not been suited by today's turning track.

THE KINGS GIRL (S Wynne) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

HARRY GEE (K Williams) - From its wide barrier draw was restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

LUCIENNE (T Comignaghi) - Briefly steadied near the 1300 metres when MEGALOMANIAC (K Kalychurun) improved forward to lead. K Kalychurun was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground. Raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 500 metres with the rider reporting she had difficulty steering her mount at this point of the race.

B Jacobson (REDFORD) - Spoken to advisedly regarding his whip use in the run home.
