Race 3 WATER SERVICES NZ 1400m

RUE DE RIVOLI (R Hutchings) - Te Akau Racing Manager R Trumper advised Stewards the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of the mare, however, has now been retired as a racing proposition from their stable.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1	JOSH SMITH BAYLEYS COMMERCIAL 1150
<p>NO AGENDA NIGEL (B Rogerson) - Slow away.</p> <p>RUNNINWITHTHEDEVIL (V Colgan) - Got its head up and raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p>GOLDILUXE (S Spratt) - Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room when MI BELLA shifted outwards simultaneously to BERBIZIER shifting inwards near the 100 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the mare had travelled well during the running, however failed to respond as expected when placed under pressure.</p>	
Race 2	SADDLERY WAREHOUSE MAIDEN 2200
<p>WHOSHE'S BOY (V Jalalkuncha) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Commenced to give ground from the 700 metres becoming tailed off in the straight and not being persevered with over the final 200 metres. Connections were advised the gelding would require a veterinary clearance prior to a satisfactory barrier trial prior to racing next. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.</p> <p>SARRACINA (U Holmquist) - Had to be firmly restrained when improving onto the heels of WHOSHE'S BOY near the 1600 metres.</p> <p>LAGOBEE (K Stott) - Raced three wide without cover until near the 1200 metres.</p> <p>ARKADUS (L Satherley) - Underwent a post-race veterinary and endoscopic examination which found the gelding to be 2/5 lame in the right foreleg and moderate mucus in the trachea. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.</p> <p>D Wilson (WHOSHE'S BOY) - Issued with a warning for presenting WHOSHE'S BOY late to the enclosure.</p>	
Race 3	ENTAIN/NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN 1150
<p>OUT OF EXILE (T Moodley) - Bumped with WITHALLMYSOUL leaving the barriers. Had to be steadied off heels when racing keenly approaching the 800 metres. Required post-race veterinary treatment after pulling up 3/5 lame in the left foreleg. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.</p> <p>WITHALLMYSOUL (J Fawcett) - Bumped with OUT OF EXILE leaving the barriers. Steadied when improving onto the heels of ZAHTAR near the 1000 metres then over-racing for a distance. Rider reported that the filly had made abnormal breathing noises. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.</p> <p>JUST FAITH (M Sanson) - Raced greenly when placed under pressure near the 300 metres.</p> <p>BEST IN BLACK (S Spratt) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the filly would appreciate a step up in distance combined with a softer track surface.</p>	
Race 4	BLUE PACIFIC MINERALS MAIDEN 1150
<p>SHARP ENOUGH (R Elliot) – Jumped away awkwardly making contact with MONTANA BAY then shifted inwards crowding SHARP DEFENSE which was checked losing ground. Raced keenly through the early stages.</p> <p>MONTANA BAY (T Newman) – Contacted leaving the barriers. Had to be steadied when inconvenienced by PIZARRO which was being dictated wider on the track near the 200 metres. Lost the near front plate during the running.</p> <p>SHARP DEFENSE (T Mitchell) - Jumped away awkwardly then having to be checked when crowded between SHARP ENOUGH and KATASHI.</p>	

KATASHI (K Stott) - Began awkwardly shifting outwards. Shifted outwards when placed under pressure over the final 200 metres dictating PIZARRO wider on the track. K Stott was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

PIZARRO (A Lawson-Carroll) - Over-raced for a distance through the early and middle stages. Dictated wider on the track over the final 200 metres.

MALLISTER (K Myers) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Rider A Lawson-Carroll viewed Stewards footage of the final straight before electing not to proceed with a protest against the first placed runner KATASHI.

Race 5 | **RYAN BRADLEY BAYLEYS COMMERCIAL 1400**

ROCHMIE RAY (K Stott) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

BRIAN LAMONT (S Spratt) - Slow away. Checked near the 75 metres.

SKIDDLYDOO (W Pinn) - Shifted outwards contacting MANAWA near the 300 metres. Rider dropped his inside rein near the 150 metres.

MANAWA (K Myers) – Contacted near the 300 metres. Was inclined to lay inwards under pressure in the final straight.

KIVA HAN (V Colgan) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the mare had felt a little indifferent in its action. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.

T Moodley (ANTON) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards when insufficiently clear of BRIAN LAMONT which had to be checked near the 75 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of T Moodley's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 12 March up to and including racing on Friday 21 March, 6 national riding days.

Trainer J Bell viewed Stewards footage of the final straight before electing not to proceed with a protest against the first placed runner SKIDDLYDOO.

Race 6 | **ECOLAB 1600**

EL ZORO (U Holmquist) - Slow away.

HUZZAH (V Colgan) – Jumped away awkwardly.

HENRY ROBIN (M Hashizume) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 1400 metres. Lost the near front plate during the running. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to be 2/5 lame in the near front leg. Co-Trainer M Van Lierde was advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

STAPHANOS QUEEN (A Lawson-Carroll) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LACHIE (T Moodley) – Lay outwards when placed under pressure over the concluding stages.

COGNOSCENTI (S Spratt) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding never travelled throughout. Underwent a post-race veterinary and endoscopic examination which revealed the gelding to have suffered cardiac arrhythmia. Co-trainer S Bergerson was advised that COGNOSCENTI will not be permitted to start in

any race or trial until a veterinary certificate declaring the horse free of any cardiac arrhythmia following a gallop of at least 1000 metres. Co-trainer S Bergerson advised that the gelding would now be spelled.

Race 7

KAIMAI VETS MAIDEN 1600

AUTUMN BREEZE (K Stott) - Slow away.

REIKOVA (W Pinn) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

ANDORRA (S Spratt) - Raced wide in the early stages.

EARLY BIRD (B Rogerson) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

ROCTAVE (M Hashizume) - Held up for clear running until near the 300 metres.

PROTHEATRICS (J Doyle) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the filly had been shuffled back in the running which proved detrimental to its chances.

VICTORIOUS WARRIOR (K Myers) - When questioned regarding the improved performance Trainer D Wiles advised that the filly appreciated a step up in distance along with the addition of a tongue tie.

K Myers (VICTORIOUS WARRIOR) – Reprimanded and reminded of her obligation to ride her mounts out to the end of the race after narrowly holding first placing when relaxing her ride over the concluding stages.
