## **SUPPLEMENTARY**

Race 8 SCENIC HOTEL GROUP 1200m

**ARDROE (L Sutherland)** - Trainer Ms. L Latta advised Stewards, she was satisfied with the post-race condition of the gelding, however, in her opinion ARDROE failed to handle the Heavy 8 track conditions. L Latta further advised it is her intention to carry on with ARDROE'S current preparation.

Race 10 ODT SOUTHERN MILE QUALIFIER 1600m

**SAY SATONO (K Williams)** - Trainer Mr. A Carston reported to Stewards, that upon return to the stable the mare underwent blood tests which revealed no abnormalities. A Carston further advised SAY SATONO has had a quiet week, and he intends to continue with her current preparation. A Carston puts the disappointing performance of the mare down to the Heavy 8 track conditions.

#### **RACE COMMENTS**

#### Race 1 LES FRISBY & VETCO EDENDALE MAIDEN 2000m

MISS ENZED (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin.

ARCTIC OCEAN (K Kalychurun) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

**MY BOY SWAYZEE** (Y Atchamah) - Raced wide early. Gave ground from the 600 metres finishing in a distant last placing. Trainer K Tyler advised Stewards he would be reassessing the racing future of the gelding.

## Race 2 TITIROA TRANSPORT & BEATTIES COLLISION REPAIR MAIDEN 1200m

LUDDZZ (R Beeharry) - Slow to begin. Hampered near the 400 metres when an inside runner shifted out.

**SNOW BRAINER** (K Kalychurun) - Over-raced in the early stages getting its head up. Near the 450 metres improved into a run that had not fully developed to the outside of CECIL'S LAD then lay outwards near the 400 metres hampering NIGEL and LUDDZZ.

NIGEL (B Rogerson) - Hampered near the 400 metres when an inside runner shifted out.

**INTERLAGOS** (A Najib) - Held up rounding the final bend until obtaining clear racing room passing the 250 metres.

FUGAZI (B Murray) - Reported to have lost the off fore racing plate during the running.

**K Kalychurun (**SNOW BRAINER) – Issued with a warning after allowing his mount SNOW BRAINER to improve into a run that had not fully developed near the 450 metres resulting in both NIGEL and LUDDZZ being hampered and forced wider near the 400 metres.

Following the race rider **B Murray** (FUGAZI) reported to Stewards that his mount may have lost its footing between the 800 metres and the 600 metres. Following protocol Stewards convened a meeting of the riders from Race 2 after which a delegation of Stewards and senior riders inspected the area of the track with no evidence of slipping apparent. A decision from a subsequent meeting of all riders was unanimous that the race meeting continue as scheduled.

## Race 3 THREE RIVERS HOTEL FIRESIDE CUP 1200m

**ICE COLD GOLD** (K Kalychurun) - Anticipated the start and reared getting its head caught between the gates. Removed from the barriers and following a veterinary examination was declared a late scratching at 1.31pm. Connections were advised the gelding must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next. Rider K Kalychurun was examined by the on-course St John Ambulance personnel and cleared to fulfil his remaining riding engagements.

VANTAANA (T Jonker) - Slow to begin.

CANNY MAN (T Moseley) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

**INDUSTRIALIST** (C Campbell) - When asked to comment on the performance rider advised the gelding had never travelled well and had been disappointing.

## Race 4 DONALD ENG & BWF ENGINEERING MAIDEN 1335m

**THE PIRANHA** (L Callaway) - Very slow to begin (5L) and tailed the field throughout. Connections were advised the gelding must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next. Co-trainer N White reported it was their intention to retire THE PIRANHA as a racing proposition from their stable.

CAPTAIN DAVO (T Moseley) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

SATONO MAGIC (T Comignaghi) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**NAKED SPIRIT** (R Mudhoo) - Briefly held up near the 500 metres. When asked to comment on the performance rider advised the gelding had never travelled at any point of the race and had been very disappointing.

JESSIE JAY (Y Atchamah) - Lost the near hind racing plate during the running.

## Race 5 K2 KONTRACTING & BRIDGESTONE GORE MAIDEN 1335m

**CENTRAL GOLD** (C Campbell) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after being kicked around at the start area and was cleared to race.

LETS GO BARBIE (K Kwo) - Slow to begin.

INDIE ARDIE (K Kalychurun) - Slow to begin.

**DE RUSSIAN ROCKET** (R Mudhoo) - Slow to begin. Lay in at stages throughout the run home having to be corrected.

**CALLMEGINGER** (B Murray) - Race three wide without cover throughout.

THE BRIGHT ONE (Y Atchamah) - Lay in over the concluding stages having to be corrected.

#### Race 6 ENTAIN/NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES 1335m

**SMALL TOWN BELLE** (G Jogoo) - Blundered badly leaving the barriers unbalancing the rider who briefly lost the use of his inside iron with the mare losing considerable ground as a result.

FOREIGN AFFAIR (K Kalychurun) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**MARYWEKA** (Y Atchamah) - When asked to comment on the performance rider advised that after travelling comfortably in the lead the mare had failed to respond when placed under pressure and proved disappointing.

#### Race 7 HILLSIDE METALS PINE BUSH CUP 2000m

**PEACHY KEEN** (R Beeharry) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Contacted near the 100 metres.

**OCEAN LIGHT** (T Comignaghi) - Slow to begin.

**GENTLE BEN** (D Bothamley) - Slow to begin.

**SUTHERLAND** (B Rogerson) - Raced three wide without cover through the early stages.

**SHORT** (T Jonker) - Raced four wide without cover through the early stages before improving forward to lead near the 1200 metres. When questioned regarding the tactics she adopted rider advised that the gelding had raced best previously when handy, however from the outside gate she had to work hard to get forward and when runners to her

inside improved at the same time she was obliged to use her mount to get the lead and was a beaten runner passing the 600 metres. Stewards noted Miss Jonker's explanation.

LILY OF THE VALLEY (K Kwo) - Raced three wide without cover from the 1400 metres.

MONTE CIVETTA (R Mudhoo) - Over-raced through the middle stages.

QUICK CALL (A Najib) - Over-raced through the middle stages as the pace of the race eased.

**THREE NINETY** (Y Atchamah) - Over-raced through the middle stages as the pace of the race eased. Lay inwards in the run home and near the 100 metres made contact with PEACHY KEEN which had improved into a run to its inside. Rider dismounted the mare on pulling up with the veterinarian and Horse Ambulance immediately deployed. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a suspected left front tendon injury. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior THREE NINETY racing next.

**KING PALM** (A Balloo) - Under pressure passing the 500 metres eventually finishing a distant last with the rider advising the gelding may not have handled the step up in distance from its previous start.

MONTE KHAN (T Moseley) - Had to shift ground inwards near the 200 metres to find clear racing room.

#### Race 8 CALDWELL CONTRACTING WYNDHAM CUP 2000m

PRINCE ALBY (A Najib) - Slow to begin.

FIRODEN (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin.

LOVELOCK (L Callaway) - Raced three wide without cover through the early stages.

**PROSERVE** (T Comignaghi) - Raced three wide without cover from the 1200 metres. Inconvenienced near the 50 metres.

**SACRED DREAM** (A Balloo) - Lay in under pressure near the 50 metres inconveniencing PROSERVE.

**STOLEN MAGIC** (Y Atchamah) - When asked to comment on the performance rider advised he had received a good run in front however the mare had failed to respond when placed under pressure over the concluding stages and was disappointing.

**BURNVUE** (B Murray) - Returned to the birdcage enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding had not experienced an episode of Epistaxis but to have abrasions to its nose area consistent with having banged its head on the front of the starting gate which was confirmed on Stewards video footage.

**G Jogoo** (KOYAMA) - Issued with a warning after he used his whip on KOYAMA when the horse was out of contention.

#### Race 9 SOUTHLAND FORESTRY & HERBERT TRANSPORT 1335m

SAVIOUR (D Bothamley) - Began awkwardly.

**LEROY** (R Beeharry) - Blundered at the start losing ground.

**CANDIDATE** (T Comignaghi) - Blundered at the start losing ground. When asked to comment on the performance rider advised that after missing the start and getting back in the field the gelding had too much work to do however did run on fairly in the run home.

**STYGIAN** (K Kwo) - Slow to begin.

**NEPTUNE** (A Balloo) - Slow to begin. Shifted in under pressure in the run home.

**SYMPATHIQUE** (G Jogoo) - Steadied away from heels when over-racing near the 700 metres. When asked to comment on the apparent improved performance connections advised that the mare had raced on pace today from a favourable draw and has always raced well at Gore.

**MEGALOMANIAC** (A Najib) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.
