Race 1	TRACKSIDE.CO.NZ MAIDEN 1200
<p>ZENZERO GIRL (L Satherley) - Slow away.</p> <p>BERNIE'S EGO (J Fawcett) – Restrained to obtain cover after jumping from a wide barrier. Briefly steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 400 metres.</p> <p>AMIRA D'ARGENTO (B Rogerson) - Restrained to obtain cover after jumping from a wide barrier. Lay out rounding the final bend. Steadied to avoid the heels of SMART TIP which lay out near the 250 metres.</p> <p>OUT OF EXILE (T Moodley) - Over-raced in the lead through the middle stages.</p> <p>PIZARRO (A Lawson-Carroll) - Steadied to avoid the heels of ROLLING STONE when that runner shifted ground near the 900 metres. C Grylls was advised to exercise care. Held up only obtaining clear running near the 250 metres.</p> <p>SMART TIP (M Sanson) - Lay outwards throughout making the final turn awkwardly, running wide.</p> <p>VIBES AND TIDES (N Yuen) - Held up through the early stages of the final straight having to shift ground inwards approaching the 250 metres to obtain clear running.</p>	
Race 2	AUCKLAND CO-OP TAXIS MAIDEN 1200
<p>GOLDEN WINGS (A Lawson-Carroll) - Jumped away awkwardly hampering TAINTED LOVE.</p> <p>TAINTED LOVE (K Myers) – Hampered leaving the barriers losing ground.</p> <p>LADY SOLITAIRE (C Barnes) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>SACRED ZED (M Hashizume) - Hampered shortly after the start.</p> <p>GONE FISSION (J Fawcett) - Hampered shortly after the start. Hampered when forced wider near the 700 metres.</p> <p>KARYON (B Rogerson) - Raced ungenerously getting its head up when being steadied off heels near the 800 metres. Continued to race ungenerously and when being restrained near the 700 metres hampered GONE FISSION which was forced wider.</p> <p>MISS FLADGATE (G Rooke) – Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.</p> <p>LOTUS (M Cartwright) - Held up rounding the final bend and through the early stages of the final straight having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>SHAVASANA (M McNab) – When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that it had not been his intention to lead but could otherwise offer no excuse advising that the filly had been disappointing.</p>

<p>SNEAK PEEK (C Barnes) – Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.</p> <p>MISS MANZOR (M Cartwright) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>THE BOSS GIRLS (G Rooke) - Steadied to avoid the heels of TENFOOT TALL which shifted inwards near the 1400 metres when not fully clear. A Lawson-Carroll was advised to exercise greater care.</p>	

SHAMWARI (C Grylls) – When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.

Race 4 | **STELLA ARTOIS MAIDEN 2200**

VENT DIVIN (C Barnes) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact.

PORTRAIT (M Cartwright) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact.

LADY KHAN (A Strawbridge) - Jumped away awkwardly.

PORTRAIT (M Cartwright) - Checked near the 2100 metres.

KAIMAI WARRIOR (T Moodley) – Checked when crowded near the 2000 metres hampering SIX FLAGS. Checked near the 250 metres.

SIX FLAGS (C Grylls) - Hampered near the 2000 metres having to be restrained to avoid heels.

RICHARD FARRELL (K Myers) - Checked to avoid heels near the 2000 metres. Held up early in the straight shifting ground inwards to obtain clear running then being checked when crowded near the 250 metres. Inconvenienced near the 150 metres.

LAGOBEE (L Satherley) - Lay out rounding the final turn.

SARRACINA (J Fawcett) – Was inclined to shift ground under pressure in the straight.

K Myers (RICHARD FARRELL) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of PORTRAIT which was checked near the 2100 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of K Myers' licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 13 April up to and including racing on Monday 21 April, 4 national riding days.

L Satherley (LAGOBEE) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of RICHARD FARRELL which was checked and forced inwards into the line of KAIMAI WARRIOR which was checked near the 2000 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of L Satherley's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 19 April up to and including racing on Wednesday 30 April, 6 national riding days.

J Fawcett (SARRACINA) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of RICHARD FARRELL which was checked near the 250 metres with KAIMAI WARRIOR also being checked as a consequence. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of J Fawcett's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 19 April up to and including racing on Saturday 26 April, 4 national riding days.

Race 5 | **SISTEMA MAIDEN 1400**

LAGARDE (M McNab) - Escaped riderless from the start then after being recaptured was reluctant to parade back to the start being late scratched at 2.56 pm.

MITONIC (T Moodley) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground. Lost the near hind plate during the running.

ORPHAN ANGEL (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow away.

TEMPSFORD (J Fawcett) – Raced wide in the early stages before improving forward to lead then racing keenly through the middle stages.

GRACES GIFT (L Satherley) - Was not persevered with over the concluding stages with the rider reporting the mare had been making abnormal breathing noises undergoing a post-race veterinary examination which found the mare to be 1/5 lame in the left hind leg and suffering from a respiratory infection/discharge with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing next.

Race 6 | **HORIZON BY SKYCITY 1600**

STARRY EYED (A Lawson-Carroll) - Stood flat footed as the start was effected losing considerable ground. Connections were advised a warning would be placed against the mare's barrier manners.

CAST OF DIAMONDS (W Pinn) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. When questioned regarding performance rider advised he had been instructed to ride the gelding back today, but in his opinion CAST OF DIAMONDS is better being ridden more forward.

GOLDILUXE (M McNab) - From a wide barrier draw was restrained behind runners to obtain cover.

REINSTATEMENT (T Moodley) - From a wide barrier draw was restrained behind runners to obtain cover.

ELTON ROCKS (B Rogerson) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

HANALEI STAR (J Fawcett) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the final straight.

Race 7 | **EAGLE TECHNOLOGY 1200**

SISTER PING (T Mitchell) - Late scratched at 4.07 pm after refusing to load. Trainer C Ormsby was advised the filly would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

JURISPRUDENCE (T Moodley) - Slow away.

NAVY CHIEF (M Cartwright) - Jumped away awkwardly. Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight and was inclined to hang inwards.

REVUELTO (M McNab) - Hampered leaving the barriers then being restrained to obtain cover. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding would appreciate a step up in distance and more rain affected footing.

OVERSTATE (A Lawson-Carroll) - Hampered leaving the barriers then being restrained to obtain cover.

MIRIAM (C Grylls) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SHOCKATILLATAP (C Barnes) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

BERBIZIER (L Satherley) – Checked when crowded near the 300 metres and was unable to obtain clear running for the remainder of the race.

N Yuen (CALLADA) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of BERBIZIER which was checked near the 300 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of N Yuen's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 19 April up to and including racing on Wednesday 30 April, 6 national riding days.
