RACE COMMENTS				
Race 1	GRANGEWILLIAM STUD MAIDEN 1400m			
L Kauri (MOOLOC) – Issued with a warning after being unable to make the contracted weight and was replaced by A			
Riddell.				
SANDOKU (K Myers) - Slow to load. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed on the mare's barrier				
manners. Raced k	eenly in the early stages. Received a bump shortly after entering the home straight.			

SLICE O' PARADISE (J Chung) - Slow to begin.

RICH ATTITUDE (K Chowdhoory) - Jumped away awkwardly shifting ground inwards. Lay inwards over the concluding stages.

REDANA (C Dell) - Held up rounding the home turn until near the 350 metres and bumped with SANDOKU shortly after entering the home straight. Could not be ridden out fully over the concluding stages when racing in restricted room between WAZA DREAM which lay out marginally near the finish and SANDOKU.

WAZA DREAM (R Goyaram) - Shifted out when under pressure over the final stages. R Goyaram was advised to exercise care.

Following the running of Race 1, the connections of the fourth placed horse REDANA viewed video footage of the final stages alleging interference by the second placed horse WAZA DREAM prior to electing not to proceed with a protest.

Following this race the track was upgraded to Heavy 9.

Race 2 KENT MYERS PROGRESSIVE LIVESTOCK 1400m

BLACK BETTY (E Sole) - Slow away.

BRUNO (L Douglas) - Slow away.

VIOLETSRBLUE (A Mudhoo) - Raced wide in the early stages.

MCKHAN (L Kauri) - Had to be restrained near the 1200 metres when over racing.

TRIGGER HAPPY (K Hercock) - Finished some distance last. Rider was of the opinion the gelding was not suited to the tongue tie. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

THE ENTERTAINER (K Myers) - Rider advised that the mare was unsuited to today's heavy track conditions.

Race 3 FOREST 360 NZB MEGA MAIDEN SERIES 1200m

DONATE (K Chowdhoory) - Slow to load. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed on the mare's barrier manners.

KYBOSHE (E Sole) - Began awkwardly shifting outwards.

C Dell (LEINSTER) - Reminded of his obligations to ensure he rides his mount out fully to the finish after noticeably relaxing his ride over the concluding stages.

Race 4 JOHNNY NEIL BUILDING MAIDEN 2200m

MADAM PELE (K Kalychurun) - Began awkwardly and shifted outwards.

SOVEREIGN ZED (L Douglas) - Began awkwardly then raced keenly. Was not persevered with in the home straight and finished a distant last. Rider L Douglas had no excuse for the disappointing performance. Trainer B Lammas was advised that the mare must trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to next racing. Connections advised that the racing future of the mare will be reassessed.

CHARIVARI (K Hercock) - Over raced in the early stages and made the first bend awkwardly.

KEEPZ OCCURRING (L Hemi) - Over raced in the early stages and made the first bend awkwardly.

TOUCH O'PARADISE (T Davies) - Made contact briefly with the rail near the 1900 metres. Rider dropped the whip passing the 300 metres.

KEEN ON BUBBLES (E Sole) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

ACORN (M Singh) - Raced wide in the back straight before being taken forward approaching the 600 metres.

ELIVABER (K Myers)- Held up for a short distance entering the home straight, with the rider gaining clear running near the 250 metres.

Race 5 JACK ROPER AGRICULTURE 2200m

OUR DAYMO (M Singh) - Slow away.

MASSO (A Mudhoo) - Restrained shortly after the start to obtain cover. Lay inwards over the concluding stages.

OUR LADY BROOKE (K Myers) - When questioned regarding performance rider had no excuse, advising that the mare had only battled over the concluding stages.

M Singh (OUR DAYMO) - Spoken to regarding use of the whip on a runner that is clearly winning the race.

Race 6 MATTY NEIL BUILDING MAIDEN 1650m

JACKS PRIDE (L Douglas) - Slow away. Hung throughout and had to be continuously straightened in the home straight.

POINTER (K Chowdhoory) - Raced greenly in the home straight.

NAKI LAD (K Kalychurun) - Rider reported the gelding raced keenly and hung throughout.

JUST LOOKING (K Hercock) - Trainer advised that the gelding was not suited to today's track conditions and will look for a firmer track.

CYNDI'S TRUCOLOURS (C Lindsay) - Rider advised that the mare would appreciate a more rain affected track.

Race 7

NZB AIRFREIGHT ROAD TO THE JERICHO 3200m

N Quinn (DOROTHY'S DAUGHTER) - Issued with a warning after presenting runner with incorrect gear (ear covers instead of pre-race ear covers).

COUNTRY BUMPKIN (R Goyaram) - Raced wide early so was taken forward.

MOMENTS LIKE THESE (J Chung) - Over raced in the early and middle stages and had little left at the finish.

SPLIT (T Davies) - Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

QUID (K Myers) - Momentarily held up near the 700 metres.

WHAT A CHARMA (L Douglas) - Did not see out the 3200 metres.

Race 8 ULTRA-SCAN MIKE O'KEEFE 1650m

BILLY BOY (A Riddell) - Restrained to obtain cover at the start.

QUEEN OF SPADES (R Goyaram) - Over raced in the early stages. Hung outwards under pressure throughout the home straight.

PUKE PARK (C Butler) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LADY MOANA (L Hemi) - Momentarily held up on the point of the home turn and had to be angled outwards to improve.
