RACE COMMENTS	
Race 1	HELENSBROOK PROPERTIES/TEMUKA TRANSPORT MAIDEN 1600m
DANIELLISH (A Riddell) - Began awkwardly and was then buffeted shortly after losing ground when runners to either side shifted ground. MOOR (Y Atchamah) - Shifted outwards at the start hampering PERCIVAL. FAH RONG (D Bothamley) - Shifted inwards abruptly at the start making contact with DANIELLISH losing ground. PERCIVAL (C Campbell) - Hampered and forced wider at the start then made contact with DANIELLISH and as a result lost ground. Held up rounding the final bend until obtaining clear running passing the 350 metres. JUST A BROWN HORSE (K Bakker) - Slow to begin. WARRIOR BOY (B May) - From a wide barrier draw was restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. CAMBALACHE (M Hudson) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. JOT DOWN (K Kwo) - Over-raced for a distance passing the 1400 metres. LOOSE KNICKERS (T Moodley) - Raced three wide without cover until improving forward to lead passing the 800 metres. Lay out passing the 100 metres having to be corrected by its rider. UNWOKE (D Cooper) - Lay in throughout the run home having to be corrected by its rider.	
Race 2	BOTTLE "O" MOSGIEL AND HILLSIDE ROAD MAIDEN 1200m
BILLY ADAMS (J Taplin) - Blundered at the start losing ground. Held up rounding the final bend. NATURE RESERVE (B Murray) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground. When racing keenly had to be steadied off heels through the early and middle stages. THE BLUE DIAMOND (D Cooper) - Shifted outwards shortly after the start inconveniencing LAST SONG. LAST SONG (A Najib) - Inconvenienced shortly after the start then had to be steadied away from heels losing ground as a result. RED MOON RISING (F Moerman) - Slow to begin. SACRED RAIDER (T Moseley) - Slow to begin. Steadied off heels near the 750 metres. MONEY MUNCHER (B May) - Slow to begin. Raced three wide without cover throughout. DEVILS MAGIC (R Muniandy) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.	

BRUTAL RIFF (L Hemi) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Lay in passing the 200 metres having to be corrected by its rider.

LADY MELL (Y Atchamah) - Hampered and steadied near the 750 metres. Improved onto heels having to steady near the 500 metres.

TAIHORO (D Bothamley) - Raced greenly in the run home.

R Muniandy (DEVILS MAGIC) - Issued with a warning, assisted by J Laking, for permitting his mount DEVILS MAGIC to shift ground outwards when not sufficiently clear of LADY MELL which was hampered and steadied near the 750 metres.

Race 3	EDINBURGH REALTY/PETER LYON SHEARING 2200m
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PULL THE PIN (B Murray) - Late scratching on veterinary advice at 12.38pm.

TIGER FIRE (A Riddell) - Stood flat footed as the start was effected, then jumped away awkwardly losing ground. Over-raced through the early and middle stages.

KOYAMA (K Bakker) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

KINDLING SPARK (L Hemi) - Slow to begin.

A MANDARIN (Y Atchamah) - Raced wide in the early stages.

MISS ENZED (C Campbell) - Lay in throughout the run home.

CAFFEINATED (R Mudhoo) - Raced greenly throughout the run home.

Race 4	HAWKESWOOD MINING AND WALTER PARKER MEMORIAL 1200m
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LINARA (T Moseley) - Turned its head as the start was effected losing ground and was then ridden with urgency to recover. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Held up rounding the final bend.

UNUSUAL AFFAIR (T Moodley) - Slow to begin.

PROUDTOBEHERE (L Hemi) - Slow to begin.

SACRED MIST (A Riddell) - Slow to begin.

KINGFISHER (C Campbell) - Had to steady off heels when over-racing passing the 700 metres.

BALZANO (B May) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MININJAGIRL (R Mudhoo) - Held up rounding the final bend.

IRISH BRIGADE (B Murray) - Rider advised that the gelding had been coughing on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination including an endoscopic procedure did not reveal any abnormality.

B May (BALZANO) - Spoken to advisedly regarding the manner in which he rode over the concluding stages.

Race 5	E.L. MOYLE MEMORIAL WITH GREEN ISLAND GRIZZILIES 1400m
GAME DUKE (D Cooper) - Stood flat footed as the start was effected losing ground. STYGIAN (K Kwo) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact with SUPER SINCERE losing ground and was then ridden with urgency to recover. CIMARRON (R Mudhoo) - Shifted outwards at the start contacting SUPER SINCERE. SUPER SINCERE (T Moodley) - Contacted at the start when runners to either side shifted ground and was then restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. When questioned regarding the performance rider could offer no explanation. WILD SECRETS (B May) - Slow to begin. Lost the off front plate during the running. BOWLER (C Campbell) - Slow to begin. Held up early in the run home. AMERICAN CHEVAL (B Murray) - Raced keenly through the middle stages. Held up rounding the final bend. When questioned regarding the performance rider could offer no explanation. ELEGANT EXPLOSIVE (M Hudson) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. ENDEAN AFFAIR (K Bakker) - Held up rounding the final bend and throughout the run home.	
Race 6	MOSGIEL TAVERN BEAUMONT PUBLICAN'S CUP OPEN HANDICAP 1500m
MONAGHAN BOY (F Moerman) - Shifted outwards at the start making contact with CHAMPAGNE LINDA. CHAMPAGNE LINDA (T Moodley) - Buffeted at the start losing ground. DE RUSSIAN ROCKET (B May) - Slow to begin. GO LOTTE (A Riddell) - Slow to begin. THE HANGOVER (K Bakker) - Slow to begin. TELLME YOU LOVEME (D Cooper) - From a wide barrier draw was restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. O'RIORDAN (L Hemi) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. WILLIS (K Kwo) - Lay out rounding the final bend. JESSIE JAY (M Hudson) - Held up leaving the final bend and early stages of the run home.	
Race 7	ENTAIN/NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES 1600m
Trainer T Rae (LIFE OF RILEY) - Issued with a Minor Infringement Notice and fined \$100 after presenting LIFE OF RILEY without the notified pre-race ear covers. Trainer D Crozier (WARRIOR OF WAR) - Issued with a warning after presenting WARRIOR OF WAR without the notified pre-race ear covers.	

MAMAEA (F Moerman) - From a wide barrier draw was restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

MAWKEB (A Riddell) - From a wide barrier draw was restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

COURTE XENA (T Moseley) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

BEAUJOLAIS (B May) - Slow to begin.

SABOTS D'OR (R Muniandy) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

BLUSHING (L Hemi) - Held up rounding the final bend.

WARRIOR OF WAR (T Moodley) - Held up rounding the final bend.

OUR PRINCESS BOOT (K Bakker) - Held up rounding the final bend.

JIKON (Y Atchamah) - Lost the near front plate during the running.
