GENERAL

Race 3 – DEBBIE HENDERSON & PETER KENNEDY ENGAGEMENT MAIDEN 1200m

The handicapped weight for #1 RED MOON RISING was incorrectly shown in some publications as 58.8kg instead of the correct weight of 58.5kg with this information being disseminated through the appropriate channels.

Race 8 – DRUMMOND & ETHERIDGE OAMARU 1400m

Stewards granted permission for B Murray to ride #8 MISS ONAKI 1kg over the handicapped weight at 55kg.

RACE COMMENTS**Race 1 OAMARU SCAFFOLDING MAIDEN 1600m**

PAY BACK (C Campbell) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Co-trainer S Anderton advised that the gelding would now be sent for a spell.

SALACIA PRINCESS (M Hudson) - Began awkwardly. Shied away from SURPRISE INSIDE which shifted out to improve passing the 200 metres.

BLUE LINES (O Najib) - Slow to begin.

MADELEINE MARIE (T Moseley) - Slow to begin.

IMPERIAL THINKER (B Jacobson) - Raced three wide without cover through the early stages.

LATER BOY (T Comignaghi) - Raced wide without cover through the early and middle stages.

JUSTASIP (A Riddell) - Made the bend near the 950 metres awkwardly. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding had raced greenly throughout and would derive benefit from the run. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no abnormality. Co-trainer S Anderton advised that JUSTASIP would now be sent for a spell.

Race 2 ONE SMART COFFEE MAIDEN 1400m

MANIFEST (C Campbell) - Shifted out at the start making contact with and crowding BLACK GALLIANO losing some ground as a result.

SHES SO FLASH (M Hudson) - Began awkwardly shifting out and contacting TIVACI DIVA.

TIVACI DIVA (O Najib) - Contacted at the start losing ground.

TAIHORO (T Comignaghi) - Contacted at the start losing ground.

BLACK GALLIANO (B May) - Crowded at the start losing ground when runners either side shifted ground. Tailed the field throughout despite the efforts of its rider.

Race 3 DEBBIE HENDERSON & PETER KENNEDY ENGAGEMENT MAIDEN 1200m

RED MOON RISING (R Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

CORCAIGH (A Strawbridge) - Slow to begin.

SORORITY (T Moodley) - Slow to begin.

FORSETI (B Murray) - Steadied to take a trailing position near the 1000 metres, getting its head up briefly.

LETHAL ROC (T Comignaghi) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

FASHION ROYALE (M Hudson) - Raced four wide without cover throughout.

TAIMATE WARRIOR (K Williams) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home.

T Moodley (SORORITY) - Issued with a warning after striking his mount SORORITY forward of the shoulder with the whip.

Race 4	HARBOUR ST BAKERY OAMARU HANDICAP 1200m
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LISE PAREE (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin.

THE GOOD SHEPHERD (A Strawbridge) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

EXPRESS COUP (O Najib) - Lay outwards rounding the bend and continued to lay out throughout the run home.

LA BELLA NERA (A Balloo) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running through the middle stages of the run home.

ANNIA AURELIA (T Comignaghi) - When questioned regarding the performance rider could offer no explanation however advised that the mare would take benefit from the fresh up run.

Race 5	THE LOCAL LAUNDROMAT 1200m
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SATIN DOLL (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin.

LET ME LOOSE (B May) - Restrained from a wide barrier to obtain cover shortly after the start.

MAGNASTAR (A Strawbridge) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay in over the concluding stages and near the 50 metres made contact with SHAMEL EXPRESS and as result shifted out hampering MOMENTO.

SHAMEL EXPRESS (B Murray) - Shifted ground outwards to find clear racing room passing the 100 metres then made contact with MAGNASTAR becoming briefly unbalanced passing the 50 metres when that runner lay inwards. Also contributing to this incident was some slight movement from MIS SPEAKS.

MOMENTO (C Campbell) - Hampered in the shadows of the post having to steady.

Following the race connections of the 2nd placed SHAMEL EXPRESS and 4th placed MAGNASTAR viewed Stewards replays of the concluding stages before electing not to proceed with protests.

Race 6	KUROW HOTEL 2200m
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SINCERE (Y Atchamah) - Slow to begin.

LA EVITA (A Strawbridge) - Slow to begin.

AVORIAZ (C Campbell) - Very slow to begin. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the run home. When asked to comment on the performance of a favoured runner rider advised that after beginning slowly the

mare had never travelled well and had been disappointing. Stewards will follow up with connections in the coming days.

ROCA MILE (K Bakker) - Lay outwards shortly after the start crowding runners to its outside.

OREPUKI GEM (T Moseley) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

OUR PRINCESS BOOT (A Balloo) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

MONTE KHAN (B May) - Restrained from a wide barrier to obtain cover shortly after the start.

ON THE RIVET (L Hemi) - Steadied passing the 1500 metres to avoid the heels of SECRET WISH.

LILY OF THE VALLEY (A Riddell) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

EL ULTIMO (S Mxothwa) - Lay out under pressure in the run home having to be straightened by its rider.

Race 7	OJC CUP DAY 19TH JULY 2200m
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ATAAHUA PIPEDREAM (O Najib) - Slow to begin.

PROSERVE (A Riddell) - Slow to begin. Lay out rounding the final bend.

VINO VALENTINO (A Strawbridge) - Had to steady near the 2100 metres.

INCREDIBLE (L Hemi) - Placed in restricted room having to steady passing the 1500 metres when MARELLA MISS was taken in by CALIFORNIA GOLD (K Kwo). K Kwo was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

CALIFORNIA GOLD (K Kwo) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

K Williams (CHERRYVILLE) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount CHERRYVILLE to shift ground inwards near the 2100 metres when not fully clear of VINO VALENTINO which had to steady.

Race 8	DRUMMOND & ETHERIDGE OAMARU 1400m
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There was a slight delay to the start of this event when the tongue tie had to be replaced on ABIT SASSY.

GO LOTTE (A Strawbridge) - Slow to begin.

EIGHT LUCKY PRAWNS (K Bakker) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly through the early stages and had to be steadied near the 900 metres. Angled wider on the track near the 200 metres to find clear racing room.

ZADANE (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin. Dictated outwards and obliged to race wider on the track in the run home when EIGHT LUCKY PRAWNS (K Bakker) shifted out. K Bakker was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

TYCOON PRINCE (T Comignaghi) - Raced keenly through the early stages.

INDUSTRIALIST (S Mxothwa) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

FRENCH DOLL (A Riddell) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

ABIT SASSY (O Najib) - Lay in under pressure in the run home having to be straightened by its rider.

Race 9	DUNSTAN FEEDS WAIMATE CUP 1600m
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There was a delay to the start of this event when **SIR STERLING** proved difficult to load.

HE'S TUNZA GRUNT (B May) - Slow to begin.

VAGUE (A Balloo) - Slow to begin.

TRALEE BAY (T Moseley) - Slow to begin.

MEGALOMANIAC (M Hudson) - Raced keenly when sitting outside the leader through the early to middle stages.

SIR STERLING (A Strawbridge) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

TUMUCH (S Mxothwa) - Lay inwards in the run home having to be straightened by its rider.

IFFIN DOUBT DANCE (G Jogoo) - Had to be steadied near the 550 metres when racing keenly.

Race 10	OAMARU CLUB 1600m
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GLOBAL JEWEL (L Hemi) - Late scratching at 4.19pm after refusing to load into the barriers. Connections were advised the mare was now required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards on one occasion prior to racing next.

MAWKEB (A Riddell) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Over-raced through the middle stages.

DIVINE SPIRIT (D Bothamley) - Slow to begin.

LUCKY FERRANDO (Y Atchamah) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

ALBAZINGA (K Bakker) - Raced wide throughout.

BEAVER FEVER (T Moseley) - Held up rounding the final bend by a tiring runner.

SPEED DIAL (S Mxothwa) - Shifted ground outwards passing the 300 metres dictating LUCKY FERRANDO out on to WAY OUT WEST which also had to shift ground outwards, resulting in ROYAL SOVEREIGNS being hampered.

ROYAL SOVEREIGNS (T Moodley) - Hampered near the 300 metres.

LADY BANKSIDE (B May) - Dismounted on pulling up and was immediately attended to by the oncourse Veterinarian. A subsequent examination revealed the mare to have a suspected tendon injury to the right front leg. Connections were advised a Veterinary Clearance was required prior to LADY BANKSIDE racing or trialling next.

S Mxothwa (SPEED DIAL) - Issued with a warning, assisted by T Moseley, after permitting his mount SPEED DIAL to shift ground outwards dictating LUCKY FERRANDO out on to WAY OUT WEST which had to shift out hampering ROYAL SOVEREIGNS passing the 300 metres.
