RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | **MYRACEHORSE MAIDEN 1200**

SALLY GEE (A Strawbridge) – Stewards granted permission for A Strawbridge to ride the filly 1kg over the handicapped weight.

SAFFRON (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

ROTTEN TOMMY (A Lawson-Carroll) - Ran off rounding the final bend forcing SOMBR wider on the track, then continued to run wider on the track throughout the final straight causing its rider difficulty. Connections were

advised the gelding must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards on one occasion prior to racing next. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

SOMBR (M Cameron) - Forced wider on the track by ROTTEN TOMMY rounding the final bend and continued to be forced wider on the track until near the 150 metres.

THREEZ COMPANY (G Rooke) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the filly had failed to handle today's Heavy 10 track conditions.

L Satherley (KALGARRY ALLY) - Admitted a charge in that she struck her mount KALGARRY ALLY 7 times prior to the 100 metre mark with a further 4 strikes inside the final 100 metres. After viewing replays and considering submissions on penalty the Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$250.

ASVAKAN (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly.

HOLLABACK GIRL (R Goyaram) - Began awkwardly.

WICKED TRICK (C Barnes) - Crowded leaving the barriers having to be steadied losing ground.

LA REINA (S McNab) - Slow to begin.

ACADEMY (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow to begin.

GO JOANNA (E Leighton) Shifted outwards when placed under pressure approaching the 200 metres inconveniencing ALL THAT I AM.

ALL THAT I AM (E Nicholas) - Inconvenienced near the 200 metres.

GREEK ANTHOLOGY (T Wigram) - Rider dropped his whip over the concluding stages.

ALMANHATTAN (M Cameron) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's Heavy 10 track conditions.

Following the running of Race 2, riders expressed concerns regarding the presence of surface water on the track primarily near the 700 metres where water was pooling due to the continued rainfall. The wet conditions were impacting visibility and posed safety risks for horses and riders. A Track Safety Review was convened involving Stewards, Club Officials, Riders and the Track Manager. The inspection confirmed that the deep hoof marks in the track near the 700 metres were filling up with water after a significant amount of rain had fallen following race 1. Riders convened to consider all options presented and were unanimous in their decision that the track was unsafe to continue racing. Accordingly, the Stewards made the decision to abandon the race meeting at 1.35 pm due to surface water and safety concerns with the track.
