WHERE'S ANGE (E Nicholas) – Co-trainer Ms H Fannin reported to Stewards, that the filly underwent a
veterinary examination on Saturday 1 August, with no abnormalities detected. WHERE'S ANGE has now been
sent for a short spell.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1	EGMONT RACING CLUB 144 YEARS OLD MAIDEN 1600m
ENA SHARPLES (L Allpress) - Slow to begin. TOR MENT TOR (M Hudson) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout. NOBLE LEE (L Hemi) – Restrained shortly after the start to obtain cover. FLAGSHIP (A Riddell) – Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Lay out under pressure and bumped with MALLEABLE rounding the home turn and continued to hang outwards in the home straight.	
Race 2	FIL DAIRY COW CARE & HYGIENE MAIDEN 1400m
RUSTY NAIL (T Davies) - Slow to begin. BREAKER BAY (K Chowdhoory) – Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover from a wide barrier. Steadied near the 800 metres. Lay inwards when placed under pressure becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of SIGHT UNSEEN over the concluding stages. UNDERTHEBOARDWALK (T Wigram) - Disappointed finishing well back. T Wigram was of the opinion that the mare was unsuited by today’s Heavy 9 track conditions. T Wigram (UNDERTHEBOARDWALK) - Issued with a warning for permitting his mount to shift outwards near the 800 metres when not the required distance clear of BREAKER BAY which had to steady. T Wigram was shown footage of his ride in the presence of the riding mentor.	
Race 3	RACING ON THIS SITE SINCE 1889 1400m
SANDOKU (L Allpress) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Inconvenienced near the 100 metres when SOTIRIO lay outwards under pressure.	
Race 4	GREEN THUMB GARDENER 1200m
BRIGIT (K Myers) - Slow to begin. HEY HEY BABY (A Strawbridge) – Raced keenly when being restrained through the early stages. Lay out over the concluding stages. AMAZING SON (J Doyle) – Went off stride near the 800 metres in the heavy going. Club officials advised that the area would be monitored and tapped back by track management prior to the next and remaining races. PROCUL BOY (J Chung) – Dipped near the 800 metres.	
Race 5	HAWERA RACECOURSE DUAL CODE SINCE 1911 1200m
ELITE CHOICE (T Wigram) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Finished some distance last. T Wigram could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the mare to be showing signs of being in season. MISS DIXIE (F Moerman) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover from a wide barrier. CLASSY BRAHMA (K Chowdhoory) – Raced keenly in the early stages.	

ALIYANA BELLE (M Hudson) – Lay inwards under pressure over the concluding stages despite the efforts of its rider.	
Race 6	CHILLCO REFRIGERATION 2100m
COMEDY (T Wigram) - Slow to begin. THOMAS AQUINAS (J Chung) – Raced keenly when being restrained shortly after the start. Commenced to give ground rapidly rounding the home turn and finished a distant last. J Chung could offer no excuse. Connections were advised that a warning is placed against the gelding's competitiveness with Stewards being advised that the gelding is destined for a jumping career. SEMPER MAGICO (A Riddell) – Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. STELLA SUCCESS (J Doyle) – Hampered and lost considerable ground near the 600 metres when unable to avoid the heels of the weakening THOMAS AQUINAS. T Wigram (COMEDY) - Spoken to regarding his whip use in the home straight on a runner out of contention.	
Race 7	LA NUOVA 1600m
TOWROPE (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin. DEE VEE PEE (T Wigram) - Began awkwardly losing ground. LAZY (E Nicholas) – Commenced to give from near the 800 metres and was not persevered with, finishing a distant last. HOLLABCK GIRL (A Riddell) - Lay out under pressure over the final stages. WILLOUGHBY WHITE (J Chung) – Had to change ground near the finish when HOLLABACK GIRL shifted out under pressure. OUR LADY BROOKE (L Allpress) – Disappointed, finishing well back. When questioned L Allpress was of the opinion the mare was better suited to a more rain-affected track. CRAFTY COLIN (C Dell) - Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the left nostril. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to have experienced an episode of Epistaxis. CRAFTY COLIN shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any race or trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian.
